LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox pulled ahead late in the ninth on Thursday to defeat Erie 2-1 and take two of the first three games this week. Bowie and Erie were held scoreless through the first five innings as left-hander Jake Miller and right-hander **Peter Van Loon** exchanged five shutout innings with one another. **Heston Kjerstad** put the Baysox on top in the sixth with an RBI single. After Erie tied it in the bottom of the sixth, **Carter Young** delivered a go-ahead RBI double in the ninth to win the game for Bowie.

KJERSTAD ON THE COMEBACK

Orioles OF **Heston Kjerstad** continues his Major League rehab assignment with the Baysox this week in Erie. In three games this series, he is 4-for-12 with a double and three RBI. The former Baysox OF has been on the IL since Aug. 7 with a concussion. Kjerstad began his rehab assignment with High-A Aberdeen on Sunday. The former No. 2 overall pick in 2020 is slashing .261/.370/.420 with three homers and 12 RBI in 28 games with the Orioles.

ELECTRIC ENRIQUE

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** has reached safely in 19 of his first 24 games at the Double-A level. The Orioles No. 4 prospect stole his 71st base of the season on Tuesday, which is the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball. Bradfield has 17 games with multiple stolen bases overall this season and eight multi-hit games already for Bowie. Bradfield is hitting .417 (15-for-36) against the SeaWolves this season.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** is one of two players in the Eastern League with at least 15 homers and at least 30 stolen bases and one of four players to do so in all of Double-A. Beavers is also tied for second in the Eastern League in walks (67) and is fourth in stolen bases (30). His .345 on-base percentage leads the team as he has reached base in 93 of 116 games played.

CAN YOU TAKE ME HIGHER?

C **Creed Willems** is raking in his final series of the regular season. The 21-year-old is 6-for-13 (.462) with a double, homer and five RBI this week. On Wednesday, he delivered his first three hit and four RBI game at Double-A, going 3-for-5 with four RBI and a two-run homer. The Orioles No. 22 prospect has slugged 34 homers since the beginning of the 2023 season.

CAM THE MAN

RHP **Cameron Weston** makes his 14th and final start of the season. The 24-year-old is coming off arguably the best start of his career last Thursday against Harrisburg where he threw a career-high six shutout innings and matched his career-high with nine strikeouts. His 1.01 WHIP is the fourth-lowest in Double-A (minimum 80 IP).

MILESTONE WATCH

With three games remaining, the 2024 Baysox pitching staff is seven strikeouts away from setting a new Baysox single-season strikeout record in franchise history. The 2022 Baysox currently hold the all-time record (1304). Bowie and Portland share the Double-A lead in strikeouts (1298) this season.

SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

Entering this week, the first half Southwest Division champion Erie SeaWolves are 36-26 in the second half as they look to defend their title. The Double-A Affiliate of the Detroit Tigers most recently won four of six in Reading, including the last four in a row. Erie's active roster currently includes only one of the Tigers' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com), which is RHP Eric Silva (No. 29). Tigers No. 2 prospect Jackson Jobe was recently promoted to Triple-A Toledo.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Carlos Pena makes his 19th start of the season and his third against the Baysox this year. Pena has thrown the third most innings in the Tigers organization this season (114.2). The 26-year-old has allowed just one run and one walk over his last two starts against Richmond and Reading. In the second half, he has a 3.13 ERA. Pena has a 6.48 ERA in 8.1 IP in two career outings against the Baysox.
