### LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox lost their ninth consecutive game in a 7-5 defeat to Harrisburg. It's the first time Bowie has lost nine in a row since June 2017. Bowie hit three homers on the night, including two from **Dylan Beavers** and a 411-foot solo blast from **Creed Willems**. Bowie's three-run lead evaporated in the sixth after a four-run outburst from Harrisburg, led by Yohandy Morales' three hits and two RBI. Harrisburg scored in every inning beginning from the sixth onward to hold off the Bowie comeback bid.

### ELECTRIC ENRIQUE

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** has reached safely in 14 of his first 18 games at the Double-A level. Bradfield's 69 stolen bases this season are the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball. Bradfield has 17 games with multiple stolen bases overall this season and five multi-hit games already for Bowie.

### LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** registered his 13th and 14th homers of the season last night for his second multi-homer game this year and his first homers hit in almost a month. Beavers is second in the Eastern League in walks (63) and fourth in stolen bases (30). His .342 on-base percentage leads the team as the Orioles No. 6 prospect has reached base in 87 of 110 games played.

### CAN YOU TAKE ME HIGHER?

Last night, C **Creed Willems** hammered his third Double-A homer, which traveled an estimated 411 feet. In just his second Double-A game in Akron last Wednesday, the 21-year-old delivered his first Double-A homers with his first multi-homer game of his career. The Orioles No. 22 prospect has slugged 33 homers in his last two seasons, including 16 this year.

### TELL THE WHOLE PHAM

RHP **Alex Pham** has been one of the most dominant arms in the Eastern League since mid-Summer. In nine starts since July 11, Pham has posted a 2.06 ERA - third-best of any Eastern League pitcher in that span (min. 30 IP). During that stretch, Pham has held opponents to a league-low .161 batting average. Pham held a stretch of 19 consecutive innings without allowing a run from Aug. 1-18 - the longest streak by a Baysox pitcher this season. He went 4-1 with a 1.69 ERA in six August starts.

### WELCOME TO BOWIE

Three new players were added to the roster on Tuesday. IF **Carter Young** and C **Adam Retzbach** were added from High-A Aberdeen while IF **Luis Valdez** was added from FCL - Orioles. Young was a 17th round pick in 2022 out of Vanderbilt, where he was teammates with Enrique Bradfield and Pat Reilly. Retzbach is a 14th rounder in 2022 out of Lehigh. Valdez stole 71 bases two seasons ago, second-most in MiLB.

### THE NEED FOR SPEED

The Baysox stole 44 bases in the month of August - the most in a month by Bowie this season and the second-most among Eastern League sides. Since August 13, Bowie has stolen 39 bases, which is tied for third-most at the Double-A level during that stretch.

### THE SENATORS ARE HERE

Entering this week, the Harrisburg Senators are 23-34 in the second half and tied for fifth in the Southwest Division. The Double-A Affiliate of the Washington Nationals most recently split its six-game home series against Portland. Harrisburg's roster currently includes four of the Nationals' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com), including 1B/3B Yohandy Morales (No. 9), OF Daylen Lile (No. 12), RHP Andry Lara (No. 17) and RHP Marquis Grissom Jr. (No. 26).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Dustin Saenz makes his seventh start of the season for the Senators. Saenz missed the start of the season due to injury and was not activated until July 30. The southpaw is coming off his longest start of the year where he went six innings and allowed four runs on seven hits across five strikeouts and no walks to record the win against Portland. The last time he faced Bowie was on August 7 and the Baysox tagged him for seven runs on eight hits, including a **Ryan Higgins** grand slam.

**2024:** Posted 3rd-lowest ERA by an Eastern League starter in August (1.69 ERA) with minimum 25 IP. Leads O's system in IP (111.1) and is 2nd in K (130), 3rd in Eastern League and 6th in Double-A in strikeouts. 5th in all of Double-A in K/9 (10.51). Threw 19 consecutive scoreless innings from 8/1-8/18, which is longest scoreless streak by a Baysox pitcher this season. Holds a 2.63 ERA in second half after holding a 5.85 ERA in first half. Named EL Pitcher of Week for 7/9-7/14 for first time in career after dealing 6.0 shut-out IP with 6 K on 7/11 @ ALT. Retired 17 of final 18 batters faced. First Baysox player to receive weekly award this season. Baysox have won 14 of last 21 games that Pham has started in. Holds a 1.88 ERA in five career outings against HBG. Threw first scoreless start of season by matching, at time, career-high 6.0 IP and 0 BB over 6 K to record win on 6/11 @ HBG. Ended month of May with a 5.64 ERA. Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after dealing 5.0 IP with 6 K, matching season-high. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. Second season as full-time starter after beginning pro career in bullpen.

**2023:** Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

**2022:** Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings. Placed on IL for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season.

**2021:** Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

**Personal:** Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing 7th in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.
