Syracuse Mets News and Notes

Comeback Kids: Since June 2nd, Syracuse is 27-17, which is tied for the best record in the International League since that point with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. During that stretch the Mets have 14 come-from-behind wins and are second in the league with 249 total runs scored.

Turning It Around: Since May 24th, the Syracuse Mets are fourth in the International League with 285 runs scored in 52 games despite ranking 17th with a .245 batting average. From the beginning of the season to May 23rd, the Mets were last in the league with a .205 batting average and ranked second to last with 154 runs scored in 40 games.

Bullpen Bullseye: Since July 7th, Syracuse's bullpen has a 2.87 ERA (20 ER in 62.2 IP) with 66 strikeouts and only 25 walks in 12 games.

From the beginning of the season to July 6th, Syracuse's bullpen had a 4.59 ERA (195 ER in 382 IP) with 393 strikeouts (9.25 K/9) and 171 walks (4.03 BB/9) in 80 games.

Do the Palka: Since reaching a season-low batting average of .205 on May 28th, Daniel Palka has reached base in 26 out of the last 29 games. During this stretch, the 30-year-old is hitting .339 with 23 RBIs, seven home runs, seven doubles, 20 runs scored, ten walks and a .393 on-base percentage. Palka is tied for seventh in the International League with 17 home runs.

The Future Is Here: Francisco Álvarez and Mark Vientos played in the Futures Game at Dodger Stadium last Saturday. Álvarez went 0-for-1 plus a walk while Vientos went 0-for-2 plus a walk. They returned to Syracuse's lineup on Friday night and immediately dig damage. Álvarez crushed an RBI double in the sixth and Vientos had an RBI, pinch-hit single in the tenth that proved to be the game-winning hit. Then, on Saturday, Álvarez hit a go-ahead grand slam for his first Triple-A home run and his first-career grand slam. Meanwhile, Vientos went 2-for-4 with a double.

Álvarez, currently the top-ranked prospect in Minor League Baseball according to MLB Pipeline, joined Syracuse on July 4th after an electric start to the season with Double-A Binghamton. The 20-year-old smacked 16 doubles and 18 home runs in 67 games with the Rumble Ponies, including 10 home runs in the month of June alone.

Since May 2nd, Mark Vientos is hitting .297 with 39 RBIs, 15 home runs, six doubles, 20 walks and a .370 on-base percentage in 48 games. Vientos is tied for 11th in the International League with 16 home runs this season.

Heating Up: Since July 1st, Gosuke Katoh is hitting .317 (19-for-60) with 11 RBIs, six home runs, three doubles, and a .388 on-base percentage. Katoh was named the International League Player of the Week for his performance from July 4-10 in Buffalo where he hit .435 (10-for-23) with eight RBIs, four home runs, three doubles, and a .519 on-base percentage.

- Made his Major League debut on June 30, 2021: 1G, 3.2 IP, 7 H, 6 R, 6 ER, 3 BB, 4 K, 2 HR, 412 BAA
- Entered 2021 as the tenth-ranked prospect in the Mets' organization, according to MLB Pipeline...Not ranked entering 2022
- Split the 2019 season between Low-A Columbia, Advanced-A St. Lucie, and Double-A Binghamton
 - Made a career-high 21 appearances and pitched a career-high 61.2 innings while averaging 10.5 K/9

- Had committed to the University of Florida before signing with the Mets once he was drafted
- Grew up in Toms River, NJ before moving to Florida when he was ten years old
