LAST OUTING: Patrick went got his ninth quality start with six scoreless innings and eight strikeouts against Gwinnett on September 8.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's fourth start against Memphis. All three starts have come on the road and has allowed eight earned runs in 15.2 innings. In his most recent outing versus the Redbirds, he gave up one earned run across 5.2 innings and struck out six.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Clarke's fifth career start against Memphis. His first was a no-decision with Reno in 2018 where he allowed one earned run in 6.1 innings. In his starts on May 28 and June 2 he went 3.0 and 4.0 scoreless innings. His most recent appearance was on June 2 where he went 5.1 innings with four runs (three earned) given up.
