

The Fightin Phils continue a series with the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is the ninth-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and third-of-nine at FirstEnergy Stadium. Reading and Somerset split the team's lone series in Somerset from Apr. 8-13. Following this week's split series, the Patriots return to Reading from Sept. 9-14 to finish off the 2025 season.

### Game 74/75 Recap

The Fightin Phils dropped both ends of Wednesday's doubleheader to Somerset, losing 9-4 and 8-5, respectively. In game one, Griff McGarry started and allowed six runs on five hits over 3.2 innings, with six strikeouts. Nelson Alvarez and Mitch Neunborn each tossed scoreless innings of relief. Jose Rodriguez had a RBI double and Alex Binelas drove in two runs with a single in the seventh inning. In game two, Koyo Aoyagi started and took the loss, allowing six runs on six hits over 2.1 innings of work, with three strikeouts. Hendry Mendez had a strong game, having three hits, a double and RBI. Aidan Miller had a hit and two runs, and Carson DeMartini had a double and three RBI.

The Fightin Phils have turned an impressive amount of double plays the last couple of weeks. Since the start of the Richmond series on June 24, Reading has turned nine double plays, which is second in the Eastern League over that stretch.

### The Ball was Flying in June

The Fightin Phils finished June with 29 home runs on the month, which was ranked as most in the Eastern League. Second place was this week's openent, Somerset, who hit 28 long balls. Reading racked up tons of extra-base hits in June, as they had the second-most doubles in the league at 50 and were tied for the

Newcomers Starting Strong
Both Dylan Campbell and Jose Rodriguez joined the Fightin Phils prior to last week's series in Richmond and had great starts to their Reading tenures. After goboth Dylan Campbell and 1968 Roddgriguez posted a .353 average (6-17) over the next five games of the week, which included a home run, three RBI and two stolen bases. Campbell had a hit in all five games he played in last week, and hit .313 (5-16) at Richmond, with two stolen bases and a RBI.

Alex Binelas continued his recent surge with a hit and two RBI on Wednesday. Since June 11 (17 games), Binelas is slashing .351/.403/.632 (1.035 OPS). He's added 12 runs, four doubles, four home runs and 19 RBI. Since June 11, Binelas holds the following Eastern League ranks: 5th AVG (.351), T-3rd HR (4), T-1st RBI (19), 10th OBP (.403), 4th SLG (.632), 5th OPS (1.035) and T-9th TB (36).

Felix Reyes' impressive 2025 season continued with a very strong month of June. Over 18 June games, Reyes slashed .324/.360/.620 (.980 OPS), along with 14 runs, five doubles, two triples, four home runs and nine RBI, along with two stolen bases. Reyes struck out just nine times over 75 plate appearances (12%). Reyes's June Eastern League rankings: 7th ABG (.324), T-6th HR (4), 4th SLG (.620), 4th OPS (.980), T-5th 3B (2), T-5th XBH (11) and T-7th XBH (44).

### It's Miller Time

After not playing much the two weeks prior, Aidan Miller reuturned to the lineup and played in the final five games at Richmond last week. Miller rode a 10-game on-base streak from June 7-29. Miller hit a season-high two doubles on Sunday, which marked the fifth two-double game of his career, and first since May 17, 2024, when he was with Clearwater against Daytona Beach. After another stolen base Wednesday, Miller sits at 28 stolen bases, which is alone in second place in both the Eastern League and Phillies organization.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

July 3, 2008: At Reading, a 6-2 victory gives the R-Phils a 4-game sweep of New Britain as they outscore the Rock Cats by a combined 35-15. Lou Marson reaches base 11 times in the series and scores five runs.

### Sup Somerset

Somerset enters tonight with a 39-38 overall record, and 4-4 record in the second half, which is tied for third in the Eastern League. The Patriots dropped four-of-six games against Erie last week to begin the second half, winning on Thursday and Saturday. Following this week, Somerset remains home and welcomes New Hampshire. The Patriots roster has eight of the Yankee's Top-30 prospects: George Lombard (1), Chase Hampton (7), Brock Selvidge (8), Rafael Flores (15), Carlos Lagrange (17), Trystan Vrieling (22), Roc Riggio (24) and Bredan Jones (29).

### **Patriots Pitcher**

Righty, and Yankees' No. 8 Prospect, Brock Selvidge makes the start tonight for Somerset. Over four starts with the Patriots this season, Selvidge is 1-1, with a 3.06 ERA (6 ER, 17.2 IP). He last pitched June 26 against Erie, allowing two runs (one earned) on one hit over five innings, with three walks and four strikeouts. Selvidge was placed on the injured list on July 23 of last season, and was activated prior to his start on June 7. He made rehab appearances with the FCL-Yankees (ROK) and Tampa (A). Selvidge spent all of last season with Somerset, going 7-6, with a 4.25 ERA over 16 starts. The 22-year old was a third round pick of the Yankees in the 2021 draft out of Hamilton High School in Chandler, Arizona.

King turned in his seventh-straight outing over five innings, as he proves to be a reliable arm in Reading's rotation. He tossed his third-straight quality start, all six innings and allowing three-earned runs or less. King struck out four Richmond hitters and did not issue a walk. After keeping the Flying Squirrels off the board for the first four innings, he was tagged for three runs in the fifth. King came back out and tossed a socreless sixth to end his night on a high note. He also tossed a season, and career-high, 90 pitches on the night. King was relieved by Gunner Mayer in the bottom of the seventh inning.

### 2025 Season:

- After not starting, nor pitching more than 2.0 IP in a game prior to this season, King has started 12-of-14 games this season and has gone over two innings in each outing
- First win of season came on Apr. 13 at Somerset when he pitched in relief (3.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 5 SO)
- Tossed a season and career-high six innings twice in back-to-back starts: May 22 at Portland and May 29 vs Erie
- On May 22 at Portland: 6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 3 SO
- Allowed a season and career-high 11 hits May 29 vs Erie over six innings
- Has allowed a career-high three home runs three times this season: May 2 vs HBG, May 17 vs NH and May 29 vs ERI
- Went five-shutout innings Apr. 24 at Portland
- Struck out a season/career-high five batters four times this season, including back-to-back starts on June 3 & 8 at Harrisburg
- Earned second win of season, while matching season-high with six innings and five strikeouts
  on June 14 vs New Hampshire
- Spun second-straight quality start, winning second-consecutive game June 21 vs Hartford (6 IP, 6 H, 2 ER, BB, 3 SO)
- Has tossed three-straight quality starts, most recently 6.0 IP, 3 ER June 27 at Richmond
- Has gone 5+ innings in his last seven starts and eight of his last nine starts on the mound
- Over seven away games, has a 3.23 ERA (14 ER, 39.0 IP), which is compared to a 7.06 ERA (23 ER, 29.1 IP) over six home contests; also 12-of-14 home runs have been allowed at home
- Posted a 3.60 ERA (6 ER, 15.0 IP) in four April outings and a 7.11 ERA (20 ER, 25.1 IP) across five May appearances (all starts); has a 3.54 ERA (11 ER, 28.0 IP) over four June starts With RISP, opposing hitters slashing .167/.171/.236 (.407 OPS)
- Has allowed the most home runs (14) of any pitcher in the Eastern League, leading second place by five home runs
- Ranks 12th in the Eastern League in innings pitched (68.1); since May 22 (seven starts), he is second in the league in IP (40.0)
