JUMBO SHRIMP BLANKED BY IRONPIGS 2-0

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp offensive woes continued on Wednesday as they dropped their second consecutive game to the Lehigh Valley IronPigs 2-0. Jumbo Shrimp (10-11) starter Ronald Bolaños (0-1) surrendered a solo home run to Dalton Guthrie (2) to put the IronPigs (11-11) in front 1-0 in the fifth. Lehigh Valley added to their lead in the eighth. Esteban Ouiroz walked to begin the inning and stole second. Two batters later, Jordan Osar knocked a base hit, scoring Quiroz for a 2-0. Robert Garcia was able to buckle down and tally three strikeouts to end the threat.

GO C.J., GO C.J., GO C.J., GO

On Jacksonville's slugging offense, perhaps no one has shined more than C.J. Hinojosa. Through 17 games thus far in 2023, Hinojosa is 24-for-73, slashing a robust 329/367/589/956 with two doubles one triple five home runs. 17 RBIs and 10 runs scored. The Houston native ranks tied for 17th in the International League in RBIs, 16th in batting average, 16th in slugging, 22nd in OPS and tied for 15th in hits. The Houston, Texas native has hits in eight of his last 12 games entering play on Thursday.

THE *START* OF SOMETHING?

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in 11 of their last 13 games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded 26 runs, 24 earned, on 59 hits in 66.0 innings for a 3.27 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registered just 46 punchouts (6.3 K/9). However, they have only issued 16 walks during this run, a rate of 2.2 per nine innings.

WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 67 free passes over the last 13 games since April 11, a figure that ranks sixth in the international League. During this stretch, 13.2 percent of their plate appearances. The MLB average is roughly 8.6 percent. The Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Jacksonville bested Nashville at home last week, winning three-of-five in the series, with all three coming by exaclty one run. Thus, of the team's first 10 victories in 2023, six have come by one run with an additional triumph by two tallies. Consequently, the Jacksonville's six wins in such games tops the league. The Jumbo Shrimp are 6-1 (.857) in one-run affairs after posting a 19-19 (.500) such record in those closely-decided games during the 2022 season.

BYE-BYE BURDICK

Coming into 2023. Pevton Burdick hadn't recorded a multi-homer game since bashing two in Biloxi on August 4. 2021 while playing for Double-A Pensacola. The Cincinnati native has already registered two multi-homer games this season, and his eight on the season are tied for second in the International League. Burdick is tied for fourth in the IL in extra-base hits (12), tied for sixth in hits (25), tied for ninth in RBIs (18), tied for sixth in runs scored (19), ninth in slugging (.654) and 13th in OPS (1.039). Without recording a hit last Friday, Burdick's team-leading 15-game hitting streak came to a close.

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

With George Soriano taking the mound for the Jumbo Shrimp today, that marks 10 different starting pitchers for the Jumbo Shrimp through 21 games in 2023. Last year, Jacksonville had a franchise-record 25 different pitchers take the mound in a starting role. At this current rate, 45.5% of Jumbo Shrimp games played this season have had a different starting pitcher, which puts Jacksonville on pace to start 68 different lid-lifters in 2023.

SHRIMP BITES

By taking three out of five games from Nashville in a rainshortened series last week, the Shrimp recorded their first home series win in 2023. They are 2-1-1 in their sets thus far... .. After being held scoreless last night, Jacksonville hasn't scored a run since the third inning on Tuesday. Their scoreless streak has now reached 15.0 innings... Over the last two games, Jacksonville is just 3-for14 (.214) with runners in scoring position. They have also combined for 20 strikeouts in this two-game span... The Shrimp have scored three or fewer runs in five straight contests.

-Signed in 2015 as a non-drafted free agent for just \$55,000, Soriano has risen to become the No. 27 prospect in the Marlins' organization according to MLB.com.

-Due to an injury that caused him to miss the 2017 season and the canceled 2020 minor league season because of the COVID-19 pandemic, Soriano had totaled just 307.0 innings in six years in the Marlins' organization entering the 2022 season. It took him four seasons to finally reach full season pro ball in 2019 with Low-A Clinton.
