### Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain on the road and continue a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. It is the eighth-of-12 games between the teams this season and second-of-six at FNB Field. Harrisburg took the series between the teams from Apr. 29-May 4 in Reading, 4-2 and leads the season-series 5-2. Reading won the 2024 season-series over Harrisburg 7-5, including a 3-3 record in the Capital City.

### Game 50 Recap

The Fightin Phils dropped their third-straight game in heartbreaking fashion on Tuesday night, a 7-6, 10-inning loss to Harrisburg. The Senators tagged Chuck King for two runs over five innings of work on six hits, but King matched a season-high with five strikeouts. Down 2-0 in the sixth, the Fightin Phils chased Riley Cornelio from the game with four runs in the inning. The highlights of the frame were a two-run single from Aidan Miller and a RBI single from Keaton Anthony. With the Fightin Phils up 4-2, Travis Kuhn entered for the eighth, but he struggled with command and allowed two runs to even the game at four. After the teams traded zeroes in the ninth, the Fightin Phils took a 5-4 lead when Josh Breau doubled home Felix Reyes in the 10th. Then, Aidan Miller drove in his third run of the night with a single to make it 6-4. The lead did not last long as Nelson Alvarez entered for his second inning to work in the bottom of the 10th. A single made it a 6-5 game, then with two outs and two strikes to Carlos De La Cruz, the former Fightin Phil launched a no-doubter, two-run, walk-off home run to deep left field to give Harrisburg the 7-6 win in the series' lid lifter. The Fightin Phils turned a season-high four double plays in the loss.

### It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller had two hits, a run, three RBI and two stolen bases on Tuesday night. It was his first game as the leadoff hitter this season. When leading off an inning this season, Miller is slashing .321/.424/.500 (.924 OPS). After hitting just .203 in April, Miller posted a .284/.364/.432 (.796 OPS) slash line over 24 May games, along with 11 runs, four doubles, three home runs and eight RBI. Miller has proved to be a threat on the bases this season as well, as he ranks tied for second in the Eastern League with 18 stolen bases.

### Anthony Keeps Rolling

Keaton Anthony enters today with a team-best 11-game hit and 19-game on-base streak, the latter of which is a season-high and the former matches a season-best. Both of those streaks are the second-longest active in the Eastern League. His 19th-game on-base streak is the longest by a Fightin Phil since Otto Kemp's 20 from July 27-August 21 of last season, and Kendall Simmons' 19-games from May 21-June 18, of 2024. His two 11-game hitting streaks this season are the longest since Jose Rodriguez from May 16-June 2, last year. Anthony enters today with the best average amongst all qualifiers in the Eastern League at .338 and doubles with 20. His other Eastern League ranks are: 5th OBP (.391), 55th SLG (.516), 6th OPS (.907), T-3rd hits (53), 4th XBH (23) and 6th TB (81). Since May 1 (24 games), Anthony is slashing .395/.447/.605 (1.052 OPS), with 11 runs, 13 doubles, one triple, one home run and 13 RBI.

### Terrific Tommy

Since returning from Jersey Shore (A+) on May 1, Tommy McCollum has been excellent out of the bullpen. After two-perfect innings on Tuesday night, McCollum now has a 0.68 ERA (1 ER, 13.1 IP) over eight appearances. He has also struck out 10 and now issued a single walk yet. McCollum has not allowed a run over his last six outings (11.1 IP) and has allowed a run in just one of his eight appearances so far. Since May 1, McCollum has the fifth-lowest ERA amongst Eastern League relievers who have made at least eight appearances.

### Putting the Fight in Fightins

Reading's come-from-behind win on Friday night was the second time in five games, and fourth time this season the Fightin Phils won a game when trailing entering the ninth inning. The other instances were May 25 at Portland, along with April 8 and 13 at Somerset. It was the first time they won a game when trailing after eight innings at home this year. This comes after the R-Phils won just once in 2024 when trailing after eight innings. Ironically, that lone instance was Sept. 4, 2024, at home against Erie, when the Fightin Phils won on a catchers' interference call 6-5, when they trailed 5-2 entering the bottom of the ninth inning.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**June 4, 2023:** At New Hampshire, Reading fell behind 4-0, but battled back to win 6-4. Carlos De La Cruz had three hits, including a game-tying home run and the eventual game-winning double in the ninth. De La Cruz also extended his on-base streak to 21 games in the win.

### To the Capital City

Harrisburg enters tonight with a 25-27 record, which third in the Southwest Division and 10 games out of first place. The Senators were in Richmond last week and took four-of-six games at the league-worst Flying Squirrels. After this week, Harrisburg heads back south to take on the Chesapeake Baysox. Harrisburg's roster has five players on the Nationals' top-30 prospects list (MLB Pipeline): Jarlin Susana (2), Seaver King (4), Cayden Wallace (10), Tyler Stuart (14), and Kevin Made (26).

### Pitching for the Senators

Righty Hyun-il Choi makes the start tonight for Harrisburg. This season with the Senators he's 2-1, with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER, 39.0 IP) over seven starts. He's allowed 32 hits, eight walks and 42 strikeouts (9.69 SO/9.0 IP). Choi also made four appearances (three starts) for Rochester (AAA) this season, going 0-3, with a 15.12 ERA (14 ER, 8.1 IP). He last pitched last Thursday at Richmond, going five-scoreless innings, and allowing four hits, with one walks and seven strikeouts. At Reading on Apr. 30, Choi allowed three runs on six hits over 5.2 innings, with five strikeouts. Choi spent last season in the Dodgers' system, splitting 2024 between Tulsa (AA) and Oklahoma City (AAA), going 5-11, with a 4.92 ERA. Washington selected Choi in the Triple-A Phase of the Minor League Rule Five Draft this past offseason. The 25-year old signed with the Dodgers as an international free agent in 2018 out of South Korea.

Fausnaught suffered his third-straight loss against Erie last week. He allowed a run in the first and second innings, but settled in to post zeroes in the third and fourth innings. He did fall victim of a high pitch count due to some early jams, and only lasted four innings. He exited with Reading down 2-1, but three runs allowed in the fifth put the game out of reach to try and flip the decision. Fausnaught was relieved by Eiberson Castellano in the top of the fifth inning.
