TODAY'S GAME: After wrapping up their 12-game road trip, the Sugar Land Space Cowboys return home to Constellation Field to open their third six-game series of the season against the Oklahoma City Comets.

ABOUT SUNDAY AFTERNOON: Early runs put the Sugar Land Space Cowboys in an early hole as they fell 12-5 to the Round Rock Express on Sunday afternoon at Dell Diamond... Round Rock jumped out to a 7-0 lead before Sugar Land rallied for five runs in the fourth, highlighted by Trenton Brooks' two-RBI single and Cavan Biggio's bases-clearing triple... The Express answered with five runs over the final four innings to pull away.

ROSTER MOVES: 8/18 - RHP Ethan Pecko added to Houston's Taxi Squad... C Matt Thaiss reinstated from the Temporary Inactive List... INF/OF Trenton Brooks placed on the Development List... 8/16 - RHP Miguel Ullola recalled by Houston... RHP Ronel Blanco optioned to Sugar Land... 8/14 - RHP Mike Burrows assigned to Sugar Land on ML Rehab... 8/13 - INF Braden Shewmake reinstated from the Temporary Inactive List... 8/12 - OF Zach Dezenzo placed on the 7-day IL... 8/11 - OF Jake Meyers optioned to Sugar Land... INF Pascanel Ferreras reinstated from the IL... OF Zach Cole reinstated from the IL... C Collin Price reinstated from the IL... C César Salazar reinstated from the IL... C Garret Guillemette placed on the Development List.

HOW THE TEAM WAS BUILT: The Space Cowboys roster is comprised of 8 players drafted by Houston, 8 players signed as free agents, 2 international free agents, 3 non-drafted free agents, 3 players acquired in trades, 1 player claimed off waivers, 1 player selected in the Major League Phase of the Rule 5 draft and 2 player selected in the Minor League Phase of the Rule 5 draft.

PROSPECTING: Per MLB Pipeline, the Space Cowboys roster features four of the Astros' Top 30 prospects, including RHP Bryce Mayer (#8), OF Lucas Spence (#12), RHP Jackson Nezuh (#16) and RHP Alimber Santa (#17).

HOME SWEET HOME: Sugar Land returns to Constellation Field on Tuesday night for the first time since August 2 against Salt Lake... In Sugar Land's last homestand, they went 10-2, including a sweep of Salt Lake, and won each of their final three home games (July 31, August 1 and 2) in walk-off fashion.

The Space Cowboys have gone 20-4 at Constellation Field in the second half of the Pacific Coast League schedule dating back to June 23... Their 20 home wins in that span are the second most in Minor League Baseball, trailing only Daytona (21-6) in the Florida State League... Sugar Land also has the lowest home ERA as a pitching staff in that stretch, registering a 2.90 ERA in 214.0 innings as a staff.

STACKING QUALITY STARTS: RHP Bryce Mayer turned in a quality start on Saturday night in his second career appearance at Triple A, going 6.0 innings while surrendering just one run on four hits with a walk and two strikeouts... It was the third quality start in his last four appearances for Mayer dating back to July 25 with Corpus Christi.

AUGUST SHUT DOWN: RHP Michael Knorr made his sixth scoreless appearance of August on Sunday, tossing a scoreless inning with a hit and two strikeouts... His six appearances this month are tied for the second-most in the Pacific Coast League... Knorr has tossed 6.2 scoreless innings in August, allowing just two hits while walking three and striking out four.

CATCHING A RIDE: RHP Ethan Pecko was added to the Astros' Taxi Squad on Tuesday afternoon... If Pecko is added to the Astros roster and makes his debut, he would become the 53rd former Space Cowboy to make their Major League debut and fifth member of the 2026 Space Cowboys to debut with Houston.

SECOND HALF SURGE: Cavan Biggio went 2-for-3 with a double, triple, three RBI and a walk in Sunday's series finale, recording his third three-RBI game of the season... His other three-RBI performances came on April 3 at Jacksonville and May 14 at Tacoma... Since May 2, Biggio ranks first in the Pacific Coast League in walks (70), fourth in on-base percentage (.425), tied for fifth in home runs (15), tied for fifth in triples (6), tied for seventh in runs (58), tied for seventh in OPS (.934) and eighth in RBI (53).

CLEAN SHEET: Friday night's 1-0 victory over Round Rock marked Sugar Land's first 1-0 win since May 15, 2025 vs. Reno when the Space Cowboys won 1-0 in 10 innings... It also marked Sugar Land's first shutout victory since July 25, when the Space Cowboys shut out Nashville in game one of a doubleheader in a 4-0 victory.

ROAD TRIP RAKING: Raynel Delgado was hit by a pitch on Sunday afternoon, extending his on-base streak to 15 games... Over the Space Cowboys' 12-game road trip, dating back to August 4, Delgado tallied 17 hits, tied for the fourth-most in the Pacific Coast League during that span... He went 17-for-54 (.315/.373) with five doubles, a triple, 11 RBI, four walks and 10 runs scored on the trip.

CJ Alexander drew a walk and scored a run on Sunday afternoon, extending his on-base streak to 16 games... Over the 12-game road trip, Alexander hit four home runs, tied for the fifth-most in the Pacific Coast League, and drove in 16 runs, tied for the third-most... He ranked ninth in the PCL with a .696 slugging percentage, third with six doubles and led the league with 10 extra-base hits during the trip.

SIX STRAIGHT: During RHP Jason Alexander's 6.0 one-run innings on Thursday night, he struck out six consecutive batters, tying the Space Cowboys single-game franchise record for consecutive strikeouts, previously set by AJ Blubaugh (June 29, 2025 at El Paso), Brandon Walter (June 1, 2025 at Albuquerque) and Spencer Arrighetti (July 28, 2023 at Las Vegas).

HISTORIC TENTH: In the 10th inning on Friday, 8/7 @ ABQ, Sugar Land erupted for 11 runs as part of an 18-10 victory... It marked just the second 10-plus-run inning in franchise history, joining a 17-run sixth inning against Oklahoma City on Aug. 19, 2022, while falling one run shy of the PCL record for runs in a single extra inning.

WHY NOT A WALK OFF?: After Raynel Delgado's ninth-inning walk-off double on 8/1 gave Sugar Land their 11th walk-off victory of the year, the Space Cowboys added a third-consecutive walk-off and their fifth of the homestand with Matt Thaiss' two-RBI single on 8/2... Their 12 walk offs are the most second most walk-off wins in Minor League Baseball in 2026 and the most in a single season in Space Cowboys history, surpassing the 10 Sugar Land collected in 2024... Sugar Land's streak of three-straight games ending in a walk off ties their franchise record set earlier this year from July 12 - 22.

STRIKKKKKKKKKKKE 'EM OUT: Space Cowboys hurlers struck out at least 13 batters in seven-consecutive games from 7/26 - 8/2, totaling 100 strikeouts in that stretch, the most in MiLB (next, Brooklyn - 86)... It is the first time in franchise history the Space Cowboys have struck out at least 13 batters in seven-straight contest (previous, 3G, 3X, last, 8/23 - 25/24) and the longest streak of consecutive games with at least 13 strikeouts in MiLB this season (previous, Inland Empire, 6G, 4/7 - 12).

EXTRA, EXTRA!: A night after they were held to seven singles, Sugar Land connected for 14 extra-base hits on 6/17 @ ABQ (6 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR)... Their 14 extra-base hits tied the most in a single game in franchise history, which came on 5/7/23 @ ABQ (6 2B, 8 HR) in a contest Sugar Land won 24-8... Each of the Space Cowboys first nine hits on Wednesday went for extra bases.

Sugar Land's six home runs were its most in a game since 5/14/24 at Albuquerque... The Space Cowboys also recorded two triples in a game for the first time this season and their first multi-triple game since 7/22/25 at El Paso. Additionally, Sugar Land's 24 hits on Wednesday set a season high and marked the club's first 20-hit game since May 17, 2024, at Albuquerque, in which they collected 21 hits.

All Space Cowboys games can also be seen on the Bally Sports Live App for free, MiLB.TV, MLB.TV and the MiLB App. Garrett Greene returns for his fourth season as the primary play-by-play broadcaster for Sugar Land and will be on the call for all 150 games. He'll be joined at home and on select road games by Gerald Sanchez, who continues in his sixth season calling games for Sugar Land.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his seventh season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his sixth with Sugar Land, continuing as the only manager in Sugar Land's history since they became affiliated with the Astros. Storey earned his 500th professional win on June 4, 2025 over the Sacramento River Cats. He was named the Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year in 2024 after guiding Sugar Land to their first Pacific Coast League title. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with five seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Sean Buchanan, hitting coach Drew Saylor and development coach Wladimir Sutil. 2026 is Saylor's first in the Astros organization after he worked in the Royals organization from 2020 - 2025, mostly as a minor league hitting coordinator. He previously managed in the Pirates organization (West Virginia - 2019), Dodgers' organization (Rancho Cucamonga, 2016 - 2018) and Rockies (Tri-City, 2015). Buchanan enters his second year at the helm in Sugar Land after one season as the pitching coach with Double-A Corpus (2024) and one year with High-A Asheville (2023), along with a year in the Florida Complex League (2022). Buchanan previously coached in the collegiate ranks, working for eight seasons with stops that included Lehigh University, Albright College and DeSales University. Sutil enters his fifth season on the Space Cowboys' staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds the Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

LAST OUTING: Made his last appearance on 8/11 @ Round Rock... Tossed 6.0 innings allowing seven runs, four earned runs and three home runs while walking one and striking out four.

STAND OUT JULY: Led all qualified pitchers in the PCL in ERA in July with a 2.42 over 4 starts... Also had the second-lowest WHIP (1.12) and 7th best BAA (.271) in the PCL during the month.

VS.OKC: Is scheduled to make his third appearance of the year against the Comets... Made his first outing on 5/29 vs. OKC tossing 5.0 IP, 6 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 3 H, 3 BB, 4 K earning his second loss of the season... Made his second appearance of the year on 7/2 @ OKC tossing 5.2 IP, 9 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 K in a no decision.

NEW CAREER BEST: Set a new-career single-game high on 6/12 vs. Sacramento, going 7.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, BB, 5 K on 87 pitches... Surrendered two runs in the third and one run in eighth but received the win in a 4-3 Space Cowboys victory.

ON THE RIGHT FOOT: Began his career with the Space Cowboys by throwing 9.0 straight shutout innings.

ANNOUNCING HIS PRESENCE: Made his first start with Sugar Land on 4/18 in Game 1 of their doubleheader in Salt Lake... Allowed just one hit, a double, through 5.0 shutout innings... Struck out five in a row at one point and finished his evening by retiring the final 12 batters in a row... Received the win in a 2-1 Space Cowboys victory, his first career Triple-A victory... Was also recognized as the PCL Pitcher of the Week.

ACQUIRED: Signed by the Astros as a minor league free agent on 4/18/26 and assigned to Sugar Land.

WBC: Pitched for Team Australia in the World Baseball Classic in 2026... Made one appearance on 3/6 vs. the Czech Republic, starting and receiving the win in a 5-1 win by Australia... Went 3.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 ER, BB, 2 K in his start in the Tokyo Dome.

2025: Pitched for the Kansas City Monarchs in the American Association before finishing the year with the High Point Rockers in the Atlantic League... With Kansas City, went 10-5, 3.61 ERA in 19 starts, 104.2 IP, 94 H, 46 R, 42 ER, 34 BB, 116 K... Made one appearance with High Point, hurling 5.0 shutout innings with three walks and five strikeouts... Pitched for Adelaide in the Australian Baseball league in the 2025-26 offseason, making three starts, going 1-1, 2.25 ERA, 16.0 IP, 11 H, 5 R, 4 ER, 3 BB, 21 K

ORIGINALLY SELECTED: Drafted by the Phillies in the 38th Round of the 2019 Draft out of San Diego... Was in the Philadelphia Phillies organization from 2019 - 2023... Pitched In Double-A Reading (21 G) and Triple-A Lehigh Valley (3 G) in 2023.

FROM A LAND DOWN UNDER: Born in Perth, Western Australia... Represented Australia in the 2015 WBSC U18 World Cup Oceania Qualifiers and the 2016 WBSC U23 World Cup... Went to Peter Carnley Anglican Community School in Wellard, Western Australia before coming to the United States... Went to Ranger College in 2017 and Barton CC in 2018 before landing at San Diego in 2019.
