The Lugnuts are coming off a six-game home-and-home split with Fort Wayne while the Loons took four of six from West Michigan.

Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 5, TinCaps 2. Tommy White shattered a 2-2 tie with a three-run homer in the eighth inning, launching the Lugnuts to victory on a hot, humid, rain-affected finale. The game was delayed 35 minutes in the bottom of the third inning, and more torrential rain fell following the game's conclusion.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and Loons play through Sunday, enjoy the four-day All-Star Break, and then the Nuts welcome in West Michigan from July 18-20.

Prospecting: The Lugnuts' current roster boasts eight of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Athletics prospects in No. 5 Tommy White, No. 8 Joshua Kuroda-Grauer, No. 10 Steven Echavarria, No. 15 Ryan Lasko, No. 16 Rodney Green, Jr., No. 26 Nate Nankil, No. 29 Tzu-Chen Sha and No. 30 Wei-En Lin. 22 of the Top 30 overall have seen action in Lansing, while five have yet to reach the Midwest League.

From The 517 to The Show: Six former Lugnuts players have made the Major Leagues this season, most recently Colby Thomas on June 29, bringing the total to 199 Lugnuts all-time who've reach the Majors. Thomas joined Max Muncy, Gunnar Hoglund, Jack Winkler, Denzel Clarke, Jack Perkins and broadcaster Adam Jaksa to debut this season in MLB.

Streaking: Shortstop Joshua Kuroda-Grauer enters today on a 21-game on-base streak, going 1-for-3 with a walk on Sunday. During those 21 games, Kuroda-Grauer is batting .326/.400/.393 with more walks (8) than strikeouts (7).

Happy Belated: Yesterday was catcher C.J. Rodriguez's 25th birthday and pitching coach Dave Burba's 59th birthday.

Heading to Atlanta, Part I: Tommy White and 2025 Opening Day starter Gage Jump (now in Double-A) will represent the Athletics' organization at the 2025 All-Star Futures Game this Saturday at 4 p.m. White, the A's No. 6 prospect, joins Luis Morales (2024), Denzel Clarke (2022), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. and Bo Bichette (2017) and Angel Perdomo (2016) as active Lugnuts to play in the Futures Game.

Heading to Atlanta, Part II: Four Lugnuts were named Major League All-Stars – American League starting shortstop Jacob Wilson (2023), A.L. starting first baseman Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. (2017), A.L. reserve catcher Alejandro Kirk (2019), and N.L. starting pitcher Matthew Boyd (2013). This is Vladdy's fifth All-Star appearance, Kirk's second, and the first apiece for Wilson and Boyd.

Dubious History: 2018 Lugnut Vinny Capra was former Great Lakes Loon Clayton Kershaw's 3,000th strikeout victim on July 2. Capra, a 20th-rounder from Richmond in 2018, had been claimed off waivers by the White Sox from the Milwaukee Brewers on May 15.

Happy Trails: 2012 Nut Kevin Pillar announced his retirement on July 2 following a 13-year playing career with 10 different teams. A 32nd-round selection in 2011, Pillar went 6-for-6 with a grand slam in a 6-RBI night at the Dayton Dragons on May 13, 2012, and found a fire extinguisher in his locker after the game. He went on to be the 2012 Midwest League Most Valuable Player.

**2022:** Jack Owen set down the first 14 batters, tossing six innings of one-hit baseball with seven strikeouts, and Tyler Soderstrom's third-inning RBI double provided the only run in a 1-0 victory at home over Great Lakes. Kumar Nambiar pitched the seventh and eighth and Trayson Kubo struck out the side in the ninth, ending the game in two hours, three minutes. For his efforts, Owen was named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week.

**Happy Birthday,** Renyel Pinto (1982), a 6'4 southpaw and member of the 2001-02 Lugnuts starting rotation (at age 18 and 19) who went on to make 244 appearances in the Major Leagues from 2006-2010 with the Florida Marlins.



Starting Out: Corey Avant's first start of the season came due to unusual circumstances: April 25 vs. Fort Wayne, the start time was pushed back an hour due to worry of inclement weather, so Avant's number was called instead of the scheduled starter, Gage Jump. Avant pitched two innings, allowing one run, before yielding to Jump, who struck out 13 batters in 6 2/3 scoreless innings in a 3-1 Lugnuts win... fully joined the rotation on May 13 vs. South Bend... set career highs for most innings (7.0) and most strikeouts (8) in a terrific start at Quad Cities on June 21, allowing four hits, three walks and one run

High School: Avant attended Sun Valley H.S., the Spartans, whose fight song is the Michigan State University fight song, Victory for MSU... the school's colors are maroon and gold, a la Central Michigan University... Sun Valley also produced NFL QB Sam Howell... Avant graduated Class of 2020.

College: Onward to Wingate University (named for Washington Manly Wingate, the fourth president at Wake Forest), the Bulldogs, colors; navy and gold... Avant majored in Math Business... redshirted the 2021 season, in which Wingate went 39-13, earned the No. 1 seed, and won the Division II National Championship in Cary, North Carolina, at the USA Baseball National Training Complex... in 2022, the Bulldogs set a program record for wins, going 48-10 with a 29-3 home record (first in the nation in both wins and winning percentage), but lost in the Southeast Regionals; redshirt freshman Avant went 3-1 with a 3.41 ERA in 26 relief appearances / 29 IP: 1 HR, 15 BB, 51 K... followed up in 2023 as a redshirt sophomore, striking out 57 batters in 39 innings (5.31, 23 G, 2 GS, 27 BB), as the Bulldogs finished 32-18, 18-6 in conference, but were eliminated in the SAC Tourney... excelled off the field with a 4.00 GPA, named two-time Academic All-America and served as Commencement Marshal at 2023 graduation
