On this day in 2006, Zach Sorensen went 4-for-4 out of the leadoff spot as the Sounds took down Oklahoma 4-1 in seven innings. The contest was completed early due to rain at AT&T Bricktown Ballpark.

Pitchers Pace the Pack: Despite posting the league's second-highest ERA in July (6.97), Nashville pitching still leads the International League in ERA (4.40) ahead of the Norfolk Tides (4.52). They also lead the circuit in fewest walks allowed (341), WHIP (1.41), home runs allowed (tied, 91) and rank second in runs allowed (450).

Infielder Keston Hiura has a more painful claim to fame. Since returning from the injured list on the

same date, Hiura leads the circuit in times hit by pitch (9). He was hit by a pair of Jacksonville offerings

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville currently has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect (No. 17 in baseball), left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect and right-handed pitcher Justin Jarvis is the No. 30 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 651-560 record during an eight-season span.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Junk is facing Jacksonville for the third time this season. He is 1-0 with a 1.04 ERA (8.2 IP / 1 ER), picking up a win on April 19 and taking a no decision in a rain-shortened outing on June 10.
