ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Hudson Valley mashed two key home runs in a 5-1 victory over Brooklyn Saturday night in front of 5,050 fans at Maimonides Park on Star Wars Night. Renegades C **Carlos Narvaez** broke a scoreless tie in the sixth with a three-run home run, while OF **Grant Richardson** tacked on a two-run shot in the eighth to put the game out of reach. Brooklyn's offense was led by INF **Jose Peroza** who went 2-for-4 with a double and a walk, pushing his on-base streak to 20 consecutive games. LHP **Daniel Juarez** made his High-A debut, tossing a scoreless ninth for the 'Clones.

SUBWAY SERIES: For the final time in 2022, the Cyclones face the Hudson Valley Renegades. Last series, at Dutchess Stadium, the Cyclones won four out of six, winning a series at the home of the Renegades for the first time since the 2019 season. This year, Hudson Valley has won 15 games and Brooklyn has won 14.

DIVISION ON THE LINE: Including today, the Cyclones have 19 games remaining and four series: one more vs. Hudson Valley, six at Jersey Shore, six vs. Wilmington, and six at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting a half-game behind the Renegades for first place.

BUTTO TO THE BIGS: RHP **Jose Butto** makes his Major League Debut this afternoon in Philadelphia, starting for the New York Mets. Butto pitched with the Cyclones in 2018 and 2021, spending the majority of this season in Double-A with two Triple-A starts under his belt. Butto becomes the 92nd Cyclones to play in the major leagues.

HOW RUDE!: In August, OF **Matt Rudick** has a whopping .429 on-base percentage and a .840 OPS over 15 contests. Rudick has been on base in 10 consecutive games and is hitting .304 (17-56). In

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The New York Yankees affiliate host five of the Bronx Bombers' Top 30 prospects, including two in the top 10. OF Jasson Dominguez ranks second in the system and 42nd in baseball. SS Trey Sweeney ranks No. 6, LHP Yoendrys Gomez ranks No. 12, LHP Edgar Barclay ranks No. 29, and RHP Juan Carela ranks No. 30. The Renegades finished the first half nine games behind division-winner Aberdeen.

the stretch, Rudick has raised his batting average from .205 to .229.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .883 over his past 33 games with a 20-game on-base streak. The 22-year-old Venezuelan has been on base in 31 of the past 33 games, hitting .305 with a .400 OBP. The current active streak leader is Rome C **Tyler Tolve** who has a 25-game on-base streak.

PALMER POP WHEN IT COUNTS: OF **Jaylen Palmer** has come alive in the head-to-head series against Hudson Valley. Palmer has an .780 OPS against the Yankees affiliate, hitting five of his eight home runs, stealing eight of his 20 bases, and scoring 11 of his 31 runs.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half and overall. Brooklyn ranks second in the North Division with a +8 run differential with Hudson Valley +24 at the top. The Cyclones have allowed just 188 runs over 47 games (4.0 runs/game) in the second half. The next-closest team is Hudson Valley, allowing 4.2 runs per game in the second half.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE!: The Cyclones have scored just 441 runs in 113 games (3.9 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and fifth-worst in Minor League Baseball in fewest runs.

SHINE BRIGHT LIKE A DOMMOND: Dominic Hamel retakes the mound against Hudson Valley, facing the Renegades for the second time this week, looking for a bounce back start.

TREND BEHIND RIGHTED: Of his 12 runs allowed with Brooklyn, five have been runners who reached on a walk. Hamel tied his career high on Tuesday vs. Hudson Valley, walking five batters.

PROMOTED: Dominic Hamel, who is the Mets No. 12 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, earned the promotion from Low-A St. Lucie, joining the Cyclones on the Fourth of July.

ST. LUCIE: With the Low-A St. Lucie Mets, Hamel made 14 appearances and 13 starts, posting a 3.84 ERA in 63 1/3 innings. Hamel posted a 27% strikeout rate, 11% walk rate, and a 3.91 FIP.

DOM-INANT JUNE: Hamel posted a 2.84 ERA in June, making five starts. He struck out 30 and walked 10 in 25 1/3 innings.

BEGINNINGS: The Arizona native was drafted by the Mets in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist, signing for \$755,300 and made two appearances for the Florida Complex League Mets last year.

COLLEGE DAYS: Hamel pitched at Dallas Baptist in 2020 and 2021 after two seasons at Yavapai College. At Dallas Baptist in his senior season, Hamel set a school record with 136 strikeouts in 91 2/3 innings.
