Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the third of a six-game series at the Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds, part of a 24-meeting season series between the two clubs. The Nuts have won their last four games, rallying against the Dayton bullpen to win the first two games of this series.

Last Night: Lugnuts 6, Dragons 3. Trailing 2-1 and down to their final strike, the Nuts rallied for five runs in the ninth inning on a Joshua Kuroda-Grauer RBI infield single, T.J. Schofield-Sam two-run single, and a pair of bases-loaded walks, shocking the Dragons for a second straight victory at Day Air Ballpark.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Dragons through Sunday, enjoy a day off on June 9, and then return to Michigan's state capital to welcome in the archrival West Michigan Whitecaps for a six-game series at Jackson Field from June 10 - June 15.

Prospecting: The Nuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Athletics prospects: No. 7 prospect (Tommy White), No. 10 (Joshua Kuroda-Grauer), No. 12 (Steven Echavarria), No. 17 (Ryan Lasko), No. 18 (Rodney Green, Jr.) and No. 28 (Nate Nankil).

Streaking: Outfielder Nate Nankil has reached base in 22 consecutive games dating back to May 7, batting .278/.376/.375 with 20 hits, 10 walks and two HBPs over that stretch.

Getting More Athletic: Yesterday, the A's recalled 2022-2023 Lugnuts infielder Max Muncy, allowing the potential of an A's starting lineup with six former Lugnuts: Muncy, Lawrence Butler, Jacob Wilson, Tyler Soderstrom, Denzel Clarke and Max Schuemann, plus either Grant Holman, Hogan Harris or Mason Miller on the mound.

Transaction: Today's starting pitcher was originally scheduled to be **Yunior Tur**, but the 6-foot-6 Cuban right-hander was promoted to Double-A Midland earlier today. Tur joins **Gage Jump**, **Kyle Robinson** and **Gustavo Rodriguez** as 2025 Lugnuts pitchers to earn a promotion this season, working in a battery with promoted Lugnuts catcher **Cole Conn**. The group is supporting a Midland RockHounds team that has won four straight games to overtake Frisco in the Texas League's South Division by half a game, 32-21 to 31-21, in a battle to clinch the first half division title.

Midwest League Outlook: With 13 games remaining in the MWL's first half, first place West Michigan leads Lansing by seven games in the East Division, 37-16 to 30-23. The Whitecaps lost yesterday to Lake County, ending their nine-game winning streak. Next week, the Whitecaps travel to Lansing for a pivotal six-game series before the Lugnuts wrap up the first half at Quad Cities while West Michigan hosts Wisconsin.

The Difference So Far: In the first two games of this series, Lansing starters have allowed six runs in 9 1/3 innings while relievers have allowed one run in 8 2/3 innings. In contrast, Dayton starters have allowed two runs in 6 2/3 innings but relief pitchers have given up nine runs in 11 1/3 innings.

The Wander Kid: Reliever Wander Guante fanned six Dragons batters last night in 2 1/3 innings, his highest strikeout total since whiffing six Wichita batsmen on June 13, 2024, in the Texas League. Entering the appearance, Guante had struck out a total of seven batters in 5 2/3 innings since rejoining the Lugnuts from Double-A Midland. It also redeemed the nightmares of last year, when Dayton scored four runs apiece against Guante in each of his three outings against the Dragons: on April 7 (2 IP), April 25 (5 IP) and August 2 (2 IP).

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.261), 2nd in base hits (453), 2nd in doubles (102), 3rd in on-base percentage (.360), 3rd in total bases (677), 3rd in OPS (.750) and are the toughest team to strike out (366).

On the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is 1st in the league in holds (26), tied for 1st in complete games (2),1st in fewest HBPs (17), 1st in fewest balks (3), 2nd in fewest walks (189) and tied for 1st in saves (15).

2019: Five Nnuts – pitchers Cobi Johnson and Josh Winckowski, starting first baseman Jake Brodt, catcher Ryan Gold and infielder Nick Podkul – were named Midwest League Eastern Division All-Stars. In the matinee game that afternoon, Hagen Danner, Griffin Conine and Nick Podkul all homered, but the Lugnuts lost at Great Lakes, 6-5.



No-Hit History: On June 13, 2024, tossed five hitless innings, walking two and striking out six, before handing the baton to Grant Judkins (2 2/3) and then Colton Johnson (1 1/3) as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since April 2003.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area; a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter, Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean. Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing and died in Jupiter.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who was homeschooled and played for Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... the Garland family was originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before Jake was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams.
