Last Night: Chiefs 10, Lugnuts 5. **Leonardo Bernal** hit a two-run homer in a four-run first inning and a two-run double in a three-run fifth, and the Chiefs received insurance home runs from **Joshua Baez** and **Alex Iadisernia** in the Friday night slugfest victory.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a Capital City Market Kids Day, closing out the homestand, before the Lugnuts head off for a six-game series at the Dayton Dragons.

Nate's Nuggets:

- Tonight's leadoff hitter, **Casey Yamauchi**, was a fast starter with Class-A Stockton, batting .416 (20-for-48) in the first four innings of games. Compare Yamauchi to **Colby Halter**, who is hitting .342 (27-for-79) vs. relief pitchers this season.
- Catcher **Cole Conn**, who joined the Lugnuts from Stockton on Wednesday along with Yamauchi and **Luke Mann**, hit .452 (14-for-31) with Stockton with runners in scoring position.
- **Henry Bolte** is batting .344 (21-for-61) during weekend games, compared to .261 (31-for-119) during the week.

Welcome to the Show: Southpaw **Brady Basso**, who pitched for the Lugnuts in 2021 and 2023, pitched one scoreless inning last night against Atlanta, striking out Marcel Ozuna, in his Major League Baseball debut. Brady is the third former Lugnut this season to reach the Majors (joining **Max Schuemann** and **Brett Harris**) and the 187th non-rehab Major League Lugnut in franchise history.

Prospecting: Today, MLB Pipeline added outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** to the Oakland Athletics' Top 30 prospect list, giving the Lugnuts six MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 25), southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 28) and outfielder Buelvas (No. 30).

Idle Hands: Yesterday marked the first day off of the season for **Colby Halter**, who had played in each of the Lugnuts' first 48 games of the season (47 starts).

Team Effort: The Nuts lead the Midwest League in triples (21) and are 2nd in walks (232), tied for 1st in runs scored (263), tied for 2nd in hits (419), 2nd in total bases (645), 2nd in on-base percentage (.354), 3rd in slugging percentage (.393) and 2nd in team OPS (.747).

Without Missing a Beat: **Colton Johnson**, who did not pitch either of the last two years, is tied for 1st in the Midwest League in appearances (18, with teammate **Yehizon Sanchez**) and tied for 2nd in saves (6).

Others of Note: **Euribiel Angeles** is tied for 2nd in RBIs (38) while **Henry Bolte** ranks 1st in the league in runs scored (44), 1st in total bases (95), 2nd in extra-base hits (24), tied for 2nd in doubles (13), 3rd in steals (20), tied for 4th in base hits (52), and tied for 5th in OPS (.941)

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: The Cedar Rapids Kernels arrived in Lansing, led by star centerfielder Mike Trout. Trout went 2-for-4 with a home run and two steals as the Kernels beat the Nuts, 5-4. The game was tense till the end, with Ryan Goins hitting a three-run double in the 9th to draw the Nuts within one run. Following an intentional walk to Brad McElroy, Sean Ochinko reached on an error by SS Jon Karcich. Goins wheeled around third base and attempted to score, but was thrown out at the plate to end the game.

2017: A day off for the league's leading hitter, Bo Bichette, but the Nuts' offense still flew high. Trailing 6-1 at Lake County after four innings, they scored four in the 5th and eighth in the 6th on their way to a 21-hit 15-9 win over the Captains. Every batter reached base at least twice, and Edward Olivares and Christian Williams each homered.

In a Nutshell: Opens second Midwest League season in a pitching piggyback tandem with Grant Judkins... @JakeGarland25... as a starter: 4 GS, 5.40, 18 1/3, 12 R/11 ER, 4 HR, 7 BB, 9 K... as a reliever: 5 G, 1.42, 12 2/3, 3 R/2 ER, 2 BB, 10 K... lefties: .310/.403/.586, with 4 HR / 8 BB / 10 K, while righties are batting .222/.258/.254 with 0 HR, 1 BB, 9 K.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams... can often be seen at this time of year wearing his Boston Bruins Patrice Bergeron uniform.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

2023 Retrospective: Opened the campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win... finished with 18 appearances, 84 1/3 IP.

In a Nutshell: One of five undrafted free agents on the Nuts, joining pitchers Dylan Hall and Jack Owen, infielder Casey Yamauchi and outfielder Cameron Masterman... last Iowa player to suit up for Lansing: former Major League lefty Matt Dermody... started the Crosstown Showdown against Michigan State and tossed four scoreless two-hit innings in 18-0 win, April 3.

Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

International Stage: With Iowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.
