LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned at least a series split with a 6-3 win at Wilmington on Friday...The Cyclones erupted for 4 runs in the 4th inning, taking the lead for good on a 2-run single by RF Carson Benge...Benge finished the game with 2 hits, including a double, and 2 RBI...CF A.J. Ewing collected 3 knocks...LF Chris Suero drew a pair of walks and swiped two bags...RHP Joel Diaz earned his 2nd win, tossing 5.0 innings of 5-hit, 1-run ball...RHP Raimon Gómez collected a hold with a scoreless 7th inning of relief...RHP Saúl García recorded the final 3 outs for his South Atlantic League-leading 6th save...With the win, Brooklyn has not lost back-to-back games since April 20-22...They have not lost on consecutive days since April 10-12.

THE NUMBER ONE SPOT: The Cyclones are mired in a 3-team race for the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown...Entering play on Sunday, Brooklyn holds a 2.0-game lead on Greensboro for 1st place in the division...The Cyclones are 4.5 games up on 3rd-place Hudson Valley with 10 games remaining in the first half...Brooklyn's magic number to clinch the first half division crown is 8...Any Cyclones wins or Grasshoppers losses will decrease the number...Brooklyn does not play Hudson Valley or Greensboro for the remainder of the half... Greensboro has played one series (April 15-20 vs. Jersey Shore) against a North Division foe and will not play another until the second half (July 1-6 vs./at Aberdeen).

ROSTER MOVES: The Cyclones made a pair of roster moves prior to Sunday's series finale... INF **Jefrey De Los Santos** was reinstated from the Temporarily Inactive List, and C **Onix Vega** was placed on the Development List.

GARCÍA LATER: RHP Saúl García has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2025...Entering Sunday, the 21-year-old is tied with Bowling Green's RHP Jack Snyder for the South Atlantic League lead in saves (6)...Among SAL relievers with 15.0 or more innings of work, García paces the circuit in strikeouts-per-9-innings (16.80)...That total is 2nd-best at High-A (Toronto's High-A Vancouver RHP Nate Garkow, 17.28)...It is also the 6th-best in Minor League Baseball...Los Angeles-NL's Single-A Rancho Cucamonga RHP Ryan Brown (18.69) is 1st...He is also 2nd in batting average against (.085) and hits-per-9-innings (2.40), and 8th in ERA (1.20).

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first 56 games of the 2025 season with Saturday's win at Wilmington, guaranteeing at least a series split...Through Brooklyn's first 9 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 7-0-2 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 4-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 9-0-2 in a series of any length... Additionally, the Cyclones' 39-17 record is the franchise's best record through 56 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...Brooklyn's 38-18 record in 2007 is the 2nd best.

HOME COOKING: Brooklyn continued their dominance at Maimonides Park last Sunday with a 4-3 walk-off victory vs. Aberdeen...Sunday's triumph was the Cyclones' 13th-consecutive home win...Brooklyn's franchise record for consecutive home wins is 19, set in the inaugural 2001 campaign...Entering play on Sunday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 22-5 (.815)...No one else in the league has more than 20 home victories (Greenville)...The 22 home wins are the most at the High-A level and tied for the 4th most in Minor League Baseball...Miami's Triple-A Jacksonville is 1st (24)...Brooklyn's .815 home winning percentage is the best in MiLB...San Francisco's Single-A San José (.750) is 2nd.

REIMER SHINE: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Entering play on Sunday, Reimer is tied for 7th in Minor League Baseball in runs scored (47) and tied for 10th in extra-base hits (27)...The former 4th-round pick also leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (47), slugging percentage (.566), OPS (.983), and doubles (16), and is tied for 1st in extra-base hits (27)...Reimer also ranks 2nd in batting average (.313), total bases (103), and hits (57), tied for 3rd in RBI (36), 5th in on-base percentage (.417), and tied for 10th in home runs (8)...Reimer was limited to just 35 games in 2024 with a hamstring injury.

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF Jesús Báez has slowly returned to form...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in May 23's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit. 647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), Slugging percentage (1059) OPS (1798), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF A.J. Ewing won Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Brooklyn hitters had won a league's Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history...Báez also was recognized on Mil.B.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" for his efforts...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native had a 24-game on-base streak since May 3 vs. Wilmington snapped on Wednesday...During that time, Báez hit 367/.475/.544/1.019 with 18 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 23 RBI, 3 stolen bases, and 17 walks to 11 strikeouts...On May 20, the infielder tied a Cyclones' single-game franchise record, working 4 walks at Jersey Shore...The feat has been accomplished 11 times, most recently by LF Ryan Clifford on April 21, 2024, at Jersey Shore...Since the start of May, Báez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (27), is 3rd in batting average (.327), on-base percentage (.435), and OPS (.940), 5th inst (33), 7th in slugging percentage (.520), tied for 7th in walks (19), tied for 8th in runs scored (21), and tied for 10th in total bases (51).

BENGE IT LIKE CARSON: OF **Carson Benge** has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The Yukon, Okla. native was recognized on Mil.B.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" from May 20-25 after hitting .412 (7-17) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, an RBI, 8 walks to 3 strikeouts, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches in 6 games at Jersey Shore from May 20-25...The 2024 first-round pick enters Sunday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in triples (4)...He is also 2nd in runs scored (42), tied for 2nd in doubles (13), 4th in batting average (.299) and extra-base hits (21), 5th in total bases (86) and OPS (.902), tied for 5th in hits (53), 6th in on-base percentage (.416), tied for 6th in walks (33), and 8th in slugging percentage (.486).

EWING-ING IT: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season and was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week for May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem... In 5 games, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base

vs. WILMINGTON: After sweeping their 2nd-straight home series, Brooklyn hits the road for a 6-game series with the Blue Rocks...Wilmington enters the series after taking a 4-of-6 games in Wappingers Falls against Hudson Valley...The Blue Rocks are 14-15 at home this season...Brooklyn is 10-4 in 14 contests against Wilmington in 2025...The Blue Rocks boast 9 of the Nationals' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP Travis Sykora (1), LHP Alex Clemmey (5), C Caleb Lomavita (8), RHP Andry Lara (16), LHP Jake Bennett (17), LHP Jackson Kent (20), OF Elijah Green (22), OF Sam Petersen (26), OF Brenner Cox (28)... Green is currently on the development list...Lara is on a rehab assignment and Bennett is on the injured list...In 121 meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 67-54 (.554)... Brooklyn is 29-32 (.475) in 61 games at Daniel S. Frawley Stadium.

percentage (.609) for the week...He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF **Nick Lorusso** and LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024...Entering play on Sunday, the Springboro, Ohio native is tied for the Minor League lead in triples (7)...He is also tied for 2nd in batting average (.352), 3rd in stolen bases (41), and 10th in hits (68)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (27), is 2nd in batting average (.328) and hits (42), tied for 2nd in triples (3), tied for 4th in runs scored (24), 6th in on-base percentage (.408), and 6th in total bases (57)...Overall, Ewing is 2nd in the SAL in stolen bags (27)...The 2023 4th-round pick had a 33-game on-base streak since April 18 snapped last Sunday...During the on-base streak, Ewing hit .359/.450/.500/.950 with 27 runs scored, 5 doubles, 5 triples, a home run, 18 RBI, 21 walks, and 30 stolen bases.

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win vs. Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City... Brooklyn enters play on Sunday with 129 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (136)...The 129 steals are 9th in Minor League Baseball...Cleveland's Single-A Lynchburg leads MiLB (161)...Brooklyn already has 5 players with 10-or-more steals on the season...The 129 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 55 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 49 swipes...The 2024 club is 2nd with 80 steals through 56 games...The Cyclones are 52 steals shy of breaking their single-season franchise record of 181 steals set in 2024.

NOAH'S ARC: After being limited to just 13.0 innings in his first professional season in 2024, RHP Noah Hall has found a new gear in 2025...The 24-year-old registered his 1st pro save on Thursday night at Wilmingston, tossing 4.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball...The save was Hall's first since April 30, 2021, vs. the University of Louisiana at Monroe, while pitching for Appalachian State University...Entering play on Sunday, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 3rd in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.42), tied for 4th in batting average against (194), and tied for 8th in innings pitched (52.0).

CAN'T TUCC THIS: LHP Jonathan Santucci has found his form in 2025...The 2024 Mets' 2nd-round selection is a perfect 3-0 over his last 4 outings (3 starts), including a career-high-tying 5.1 scoreless inning performance in a no-decision Wednesday at Wilmington...Since May 16 vs. Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has an 0.44 ERA (1 ER in 20.2 IP) with 11 hits allowed, 6 walks, and 22 strikeouts...Santucci has also thrown 14.1 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to the 2nd inning in game one of a doubleheader on May 23 at Jersey Shore...Since May 16, Santucci leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (0.44), is tied for 1st in wins (3), 3rd in batting average against (.153) and WHIP (0.82), and 8th in innings pitched (20.2).

IT'S A WALK-OFF: C Chris Suero provided Brooklyn's 2nd walk-off win in as many days in Sunday's 4-3 victory vs. Aberdeen...With 2nd and 3rd and 2 out, the 21-year-old reached on a run-scoring infield single, while a throwing error from 3B Anderson De Los Santos enabled the winning run to cross...On Saturday, C Ronald Hernandez helped Brooklyn complete another come-from-behind win, clobbering a walk-off solo home run with 1 out in the 9th in a 5-4 Cyclones win...The walk-off homer was Brooklyn's 1st since 3B Jefrey De Los Santos hit a game-tying 2-run blast and LF Omar De Los Santos smashed the game-ending solo shot on July 28, 2024, vs. Rome...Hernandez also delivered a walk-off winner with a run-producing fielder's choice in the bottom of the 10th on May 18 vs. Winston-Salem...2B Marco Vargas collected Brooklyn's 1st walk-off win of the year, slapping a game-ending RBI single in the bottom of the 10th on April 29 vs. Wilmington.

MAGIC 8 BALL: Brooklyn erupted for a season-high 8 runs in the 3rd inning in Tuesday's 12-3 win at Wilmington...The Cyclones scored 8 runs on 8 hits and sent 12 batters to the plate...The 8-run frame was Brooklyn's biggest offensive outburst this year...The previous high had been 6 runs on 3 occasions, most recently on May 14 vs. Winston-Salem in the bottom of the 4th...The 8-run inning was the 'Clones largest frame since scoring 9 runs in the bottom of the 2nd inning in an 11-7 win vs. Wilmington on July 27, 2023...Brooklyn scored 9 runs on 6 hits in that inning, sending 12 to the dish...It was the Cyclones' biggest offensive inning on the road since tallying 10 runs in the top of the 6th in a 20-6 rout on May 27, 2022, at Bowling Green.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 8, 2023, after playing underneath hazy orange skies due to smoke from Canadian wildfires, in a walk-off win over Greenville the day before, the Cyclones and Drive are postponed because of the hazardous air quality conditions at Maimonides Park.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 12 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), RHP Nate Dohm (18), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Chris Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), OF A.J. Ewing (27), and RHP Will Watson (29)...The Cyclones also possess 11 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (6), Benge (7), Ewing (8), Reimer (10), Vargas (11), Baro (17), Santucci (18), Suero (18), Suero (19), Serrano (19), Serrano (19), Serrano (19), Servano Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

Gordon**...Entered in support of Gordon with runners at 2nd and 3rd, and 2 out in the bottom of the 4th inning with Brooklyn leading 10-1...Both inherited runners were stranded on a ground out...Girton allowed 2 runs on 3 hits over 4.1 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 3...Threw 65 pitches and 39 strikes (60.0%)...Relieved by RHP **Chandler Marsh** to start the bottom of the 9th inning with the Cyclones leading 12-3...Brooklyn went on to defeat Wilmington, 12-3.

2025: Broke camp with Brooklyn...Did not receive a decision in his High-A debut, striking out a career-high 5 on 4/6 vs. WIL (2.2 IP, 3 H, R, ER, BB, 5 K)...Suffered the loss in his 1st appearance of the year in relief on 4/12-1 vs. HV (3.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, ER, 3 BB, 4 K)...Earned the 1st win of his professional career in relief on 4/23 @JS (3.0 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 2 K)...Tossed a career-high 4.0 innings and tied a career-best with 5 K's in a no-decision on 5/1 vs. WIL (4.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 5 K)...Earned the win and struck out a career-best 9 over a career-long 5.0 innings on 5/13 vWS (5.0 IP, H, R, ER, 2 BB, 9 K)...Struck out 8 over 4.2 innings in a no-decision on 5/27 vABD (4.2 IP, 2 H, BB, 8 K)...Appeared in a relief capacity following R.J. Gordon on 6/3 @WIL...Earned his 3rd win, tossing 4.1 innings of 2-run relief on 6/3 @WIL (4.1 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, BB, 3 K).

WHAT'S IN A ROLE: Girton has split time in 2025 between Brooklyn's rotation and bullpen...The 23-year-old started the year in a piggyback tandem with RHP Joel Díaz before moving to the rotation full-time after LHP Zach Thornton's transfer to Double-A Binghamton...In 7 starts, Girton has a 1-0 record and a 3.33 ERA (10 ER in 27.0 IP) with 22 hits allowed, 13 walks, and 38 strikeouts...In 3 appearances out of the bullpen, the right-hander is 2-1 with a 3.48 ERA (4 ER in 10.1 IP), 10 hits allowed, 6 walks, and 9 punchouts.

HOME COOKING: The Gage, Okla. native has thrived when gracing the bump at Maimonides Park...In 5 appearances (4 starts) on Coney Island, Girton holds a 1-1 record with a 2.33 ERA (5 ER in 19.1 IP), 13 hits, 7 walks, and 31 strikeouts...The 23-year-old is 2-0 with a 4.50 ERA (9 ER in 18.0 IP) with 19 hits, 12 walks, and 16 strikeouts in 5 outings (3 starts) in visiting parks.

2024: Signed with the Mets on 7/20 and assigned to Single-A St. Lucie on 8/28...Made his professional debut in relief, striking out the side in order on 8/29 vs. Jupiter (1.0 IP, 3 K)...Took a no-decision in his first and only pro start on 9/3 at Clearwater (1.0 IP, 2 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 1 K)...In 3 appearances (1 start), did not receive a decision and tallied a 12.00 ERA (4 ER in 3.0 IP) with 5 hits, 4 walks, and 5 strikeouts.

BOOMER SOONER: Girton spent the 2024 collegiate season at the University of Oklahoma...Girton grew up about 177 miles northwest of the university in Gage, Okla... Corralled a 0-1 record with a 7.32 ERA (29 ER in 35.2 IP), 1 save, 44 hits, 31 walks, and 47 strikeouts in 16 appearances (10 starts) for the Sooners...In first outing as a Sooner, went 4.0 innings and surrendered 1 run on 3 hits and 3 walks with 9 strikeouts in a win vs. No. 9 Tennessee on 2/17...Tossed 4.0 innings of 1-hit ball with 2 strikeouts in a win at TCU on 3/16...Started and struck out a pair in 2 postseason appearances vs. Kansas (5/24) and vs. UConn (6/2).

RED RAIDER NATION: The 23-year-old started his college career at Texas Tech University...During his 3 years with the Red Raiders, Girton compiled a 7-2 record with a 5.21 ERA (54 ER in 93.1 IP), 1 save, 77 hits, 57 walks, and 77 strikeouts in 42 outings (9 starts)...Named to the All-Big 12 Academic Second Team in 2023...Named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week on 2/20/23 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings out of the bullpen on Opening Day vs. Gonzaga...Had his 2022 season cut short due to injury.
