Last Night: Dragons 7, Lugnuts 2. Dayton received three home runs in a six-run 2nd inning - solo shots from **Juan Martínez** and **Quin Cotton** and a grand slam from **Michael Siani** - and coasted to victory in front of 5,844, winning their third straight game in the series. In the loss, **Jordan Díaz** went 3-for-4 with two singles and a double, though **William Simoneit's** 11-game hitting streak came to an end.

On Deck: Tomorrow is *Latino Day* with the Lansing Locos facing the Dayton Dragons as part of *Copa de la Diversión*. LAFUCU Fireworks follow the game.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Welcome Aboard: Right-hander **Kyle Virbitsky** and southpaw **Jack Owen** joined the Lugnuts today, becoming the 50th and 51st different Lugnuts to suit up this season and the 854th and 855th Lugnuts all-time. Virbitsky was drafted in the 17th round in July from Penn State University, joining third baseman **Brett Harris** (7th round, Gonzaga) and shortstop **Drew Swift** (8th round, Arizona State) as 2021 draft picks on the Lugnuts' roster. Owen was signed as an undrafted free agent in July from Auburn University.

Happy Birthday: Corner infielder **Jordan Díaz**, the youngest player on the roster and one of the top prospects in the A's system, turns 21 years old today.

Thrice Roasted: Dayton has won the first three games of this series by a combined 29-7 score, hitting eight home runs along the way. The Dragons have 16 extra-base hits in the series, compared to the Lugnuts' 18 total base hits in the series.

On the Bright Side: **Elvis Peralta, Jr.**, has one double in each of his last four games, dating back to the finale at Lake County on Sunday and extending through the first three games of this series.

Streak Halted, Streak Extended: **William Simoneit** went 0-for-3 with a walk yesterday, ending his team-high hitting streak at 11 games while also extending his on-base streak to 14 games.

Tough Acton: Reliever **Garrett Acton** pitched a perfect 9th last night, striking out two Dragons. In his last three outings, batters are 0-for-11 against him with seven strikeouts. Acton has only allowed one run with Lansing after getting called up from Low-A Stockton, a Micah Pries homer on August 3.

2021 Alumni Report: The hottest hitter on Double-A Midland is **Max Schuemann**, who went 3-for-4 yesterday, his second straight three-hit game, and now has 14 hits in his last 30 at-bats in his last eight games, plus eight walks, to raise his slash line from .182/.292/.345 to .282/.394/.412 for the RockHounds.

Hoya Saxa: The Lugnuts have won all seven games in which **Jack Cushing** has pitched, including both games the Georgetown right-hander pitched at Lake County, Tuesday's opener and Sunday's finale. In just seven appearances, six starts, in the High-A Central, Cushing is already tied for the league lead with six victories. Cushing is scheduled to start again tomorrow night against Dayton.

All You Need is Glove: **Brett Harris** was named the 2021 West Coast Conference Defensive Player (in addition to being honored as First Team All-Conference, leading the Bulldogs with a .355 average, 1.027 OPS, 52 runs, 70 hits and 18 extra-base hits in 52 games, committing only two errors) and **Drew Swift** was named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year, the first Sun Devil so honored, and received the 2021 ABCA/Rawlings Gold Glove as the nation's top defensive shortstop. Both were added to the Lugnuts roster yesterday and debuted in the loss.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: The Lugnuts played two extra-inning games at West Michigan, winning one of them. First, the Nuts and Whitecaps completed a game suspended after 10 innings from the day before, with Ryan Metzler's two-run single driving in Lane Thomas and Connor Panas for a 5-3 11-inning victory, extending the Nuts' winning streak to six games. Interestingly, Jackson Lowery pitched for the second straight day; Lowery had recorded the final two outs the day before (Friday), stranding the bases loaded to end the 10th before pitching a scoreless 11th on Saturday to earn the win. In the regularly scheduled game, Arvinct Perez's bases-loaded, one-out RBI single in the 12th gave the Whitecaps a walkoff win. It not only ended the Nuts' winning streak, it ended a streak of eight straight Nuts wins against the Whitecaps.

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Five former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season - pitcher **Ty Tice** '18 (Toronto, now with Arizona), outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher **Taylor Saucedo** '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher **Conner Greene** '15 (Baltimore) and pitcher **Kirby Sneed** '16-'17 (Toronto). Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals. Sneed most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, **Max Schuemann** broke **Samad Taylor's** franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, **Stevie Emanuels** broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B **Jordan Diaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (**Anthony Phillips**) and Venezuela (**Javier Godard**).

Finally: Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielder **Michael Goldberg** have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Nuts have used 16 different starting pitchers this season, **Brady Basso**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Charlie Cerny**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Jack Cushing**, **David Leal**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Richard Guasch**, **Jorge Juan**, **Rafael Kelly**, **Bryce Nightengale**, **Colin Peluse**, **Leudeny Pineda**, **Seth Shuman**, **Shohei Tomioka** and **Brock Whittlesey**.

Three Nuts Go to Washington: On July 30, catcher **Drew Millas** and pitchers **Richard Guasch** and **Seth Shuman** were traded by the Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher **Yan Gomes** and utilityman **Josh Harrison**.

Talented Staff: Shohei pitched on a talented Toyo University staff, evidenced by how the 2018 Nippon Professional Baseball Draft was loaded with his teammates, with Hiroshi Kaino selected 1st overall by Fukuoka, Taiga Kamichatani going later in the 1st round to Yokohama, and Chunichi drafting Kodai Umetsu in the 2nd round.

The Road to MLB: After not being drafted, Tomioka pitched for VITAL-NET in the amateur Industrial League, a level in which Hideo Nomo, Jun Tazawa and Kosuke Fukudome all first made their names before joining the higher ranks... tried out for the Athletics with 27 other pitchers in Autumn 2019, hit 95 mph with his fastball, and was signed in February... scout: Toshiyuki Tomitsuka...2021 marks his pro debut.

Starting Strong: After a successful pair of scoreless innings in his pro debut on Opening Night, May 4, following Seth Shuman, Tomioka was even sharper against Lake County in three scoreless innings on Saturday, May 8, after relieving top prospect Jeff Criswell... entered in the 3rd inning, working around a two-out double by Will Brennan... struck out two batters in a 1-2-3 4th... gave up a leadoff single in the 5th to Daniel Schneeman but erased him with a double-play ball and faced the minimum... of 10 batters faced, only Brennan and Schneeman hit the ball out of the infield... Lugnuts won, 2-0... in each of his first two outings as a professional, Tomioka received the victory from the official scorer.

Last Outing, August 7: Scheduled to start at Lake County, scratched in favor of Charlie Cerny due to the potential for poor weather... relieved Jose Mora in the 3rd inning with two outs and tossed 3 1/3 innings, allowing three hits and one run, walking none and striking out four... continued domination of Lake County (compared to other High-A opponents), allowing only one total run in 12 1/3 innings vs. Captains in 2021.

Notable Splits: vs. LH - .252/.331/.396, 3 HR | vs. RH: .265/.333/.349, 0 HR... of 16 walks, only three have gone to RH... as a starter: 7.36 ERA, 6 GS, 18 1/3, 1.58 WHIP... reliever: 2.93, 12 G, 30 2/3, 1.21.

2021 vs. Dragons: Made his first professional start at Day Air Ballpark on May 13, allowing four hits and two runs in two innings... pitched in relief against the Dragons on June 29, allowing four unearned runs on one hit, two walks and two HBPs in 1 1/3 innings... pitched in relief against the Dragons again on the 4th of July, allowing four runs (two earned) on six hits in 1 1/3 innings, allowing a solo home run to James Free... in all, Tomioka has allowed ten runs (four earned) on 11 hits, four walks and two HBPs, striking out six, in 4 2/3 innings.
