Power of the Pinstripes: The Patriots have hit three home runs across their first two games in pinstripes, including two home runs to lead off an inning (Estevan Florial, bot. 1 on 5/4 & Donny Sands, bot. 2 on 5/5). The long ball has accounted for five of the first eight runs the team has scored so far this season. Only Erie has hit more home runs (5) as a team in the Northeast League than Somerset.

Go, Diego, Go!: Infielder Diego Castillo became the first Patriot in 2021 to record a three-hit game with a 3-for-4 performance last night. Castillo is currently tied with Thomas Milone for the team lead in hits (3).

Hits and Misses: The Patriots pitching staff has limited Harrisburg batters to only five hits over the first two games of the series. Overall, Senators batters are a combined 5-for-61 (.082) from the plate so far, accounting for the lowest team batting average in the Northeast League across two games.

Start Me Up: Somerset's two starting pitchers thus far, Luis Gil and Shawn Sample, have combined to toss 7.2 innings of scoreless baseball, striking out 11 combined batters while yielding just two walks and three hits.

Mowing 'em Down: Somerset's pitching staff recorded 15 total strikeouts against the Senators Tuesday night. Luis Gil got the starting nod recording six Ks in 3.2 innings of work. Ron Marinaccio had a team-high seven strikeouts in his 3.1 innings. All four pitchers (Gil, Marinaccio, Ridings, Weissert) recorded at least one strikeout.

He's a Krook!: LHP Matt Krook makes his Patriots debut tonight and his first professional start in the Yankees organization tonight. The southpaw was originally acquired by the Yankees from the Tampa Bay Rays in the first round of the Triple-A phase of the 2020 Rule 5 Draft. He did not pitch in 2020, but appeared in 32 games (18 starts) with Double-A Montgomery in 2019.

Yankee Connection: All three managers in the 24-year history of the Somerset Patriots have played for the Yankees organization. Current manager Julio Mosquera spent two seasons in the Yankees system (2000-01) playing with former manager Brett Jodie. Sparky Lyle spent seven seasons with the Bronx Bombers, won the Cy Young award in 1977 and a world series championship in 1978.
