Date Thu. Fri Sat. Sun Mon Charlotte Knights (Chicago White Sox) at Coolray Field. It Dunand have combined to bat .347 (25-for-72, 5 2B, 2 is the eighth of 18 meetings between the clubs this season, and the eighth of 12 games to be played in Georgia. It is Wet Nose Wednesday, presented by New Country 101.5 (dogs free with paid owner on The Bank) and a Xolos de Gwinnett Night (MiLB's Copa de la Diversión).

VS. CHARLOTTE: Gwinnett is 73-61 (.545) in 134 games vs. Charlotte all-time at Coolray Field, including 5-2 (.714) in seven games in 2022. The Stripers are 7-5 in season home series vs. the Knights dating back to 2009, including 3-1 over the last four seasons (2017-21). Gwinnett is riding a three-game home winning streak over Charlotte since 5/7, outscoring the Knights 18-9 in that span.

LIBERATED FROM JULY 4 LOSING STREAK: Monday's 6-3 win snapped Gwinnett's three-game Independence Day losing streak as the Stripers improved to 4-8 (.333) all-time on July 4. It was Gwinnett's first victory on the holiday since beating Norfolk 11-3 at Coolray Field on 7/4/17. Since that win, the Stripers had lost in 2018 (10-5 vs. NOR), 2019 (5-3 vs. DUR), and 2021 (5-4 at DUR).

KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead the International League in strikeouts with 802 in 79 games (10.15 SO per game). That's just two behind Round Rock of the Pacific Coast League (804 in 79G) for the most in Triple-A. Gwinnett has not led Triple-A in strikeouts since 2011 (club record 1,223 SO in 143G). Kyle Muller (1st, 102), Tucker Davidson (4th, 78), Huascar Ynoa (T-9th, 67), and Bryce Elder (T-16th, 62) all rank among IL leaders in strikeouts.

SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: Braden Shewmake has hit safely in 12 of 14 games since 6/7, batting .309 (17-for-55, 2 2B, 2 HR, 6 R, 9 RBI, 2 SB, .805 OPS) in that span. He homered twice on the last road trip, 6/22 at Nashville (2-run, off RHP Luke Barker) and 7/2 at Norfolk (2-run, off RHP Marcos Diplan). In 56 games overall on his Triple-A debut, Shewmake is batting .271 (58-for-214, 10 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR, 29 R, 17 RBI, 6 SB, .722 OPS).

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin locked down his team-leading sixth save (T-10th in IL) on Monday, working 1.0 IP (0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 SO). The outing extended his team-best scoreless innings streak to 11.0 spanning his last 11 appearances. In that stretch, he's posting a 0.45 WHIP (4 H, 1 BB), .108 BAA, 14.73 SO/9.0 IP ratio (18 SO), and three saves (3-for-3). In 25 games overall, Tonkin is 3-0 with a 2.10 ERA (6 ER in 25.2 IP), .179 BAA, 14.73

RISING WATERS: Braves' No. 2 prospect Drew Waters walked twice in a game for just the second time all season on Monday (0-for-3, 2 BB, 2 R, 1 SB). After posting a .664 OPS over his first 29 games from 5/3-6/15, he owns an .800 OPS (.262, 16-for-61, 1 2B, 2 3B, 2 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI, 3 SB, 9 BB) over his last 15 games since 6/17.

SO/9.0 IP ratio (42 SO), and six saves (6-for-7).

(43-for-172, 6 2B, 3 3B, 5 HR, 25 R, 16 RBI, 4 SB, .714 OPS), including .404 (4 2B, 1 HR, .994 OPS) vs. LHP and .183 (2 2B, 3 3B, 4 HR, .592 OPS) vs. RHP. The Stripers are 5-0 when he homers.

GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .247 (169-for-683, 33 2B, 4 3B, 18 HR, 112 R, 64 RBI, 35 SB, .712 OPS) in 173 games.

TONIGHT: The Stripers continue a six-game series vs. the KILLER D's DOING DAMAGE: Alex Dickerson and Joe 3B, 4 HR, 10 R, 12 RBI) over Gwinnett's last 10 games. Dickerson is batting .351 (13-for-37, 2 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 6 R, 7 RBI, 1.012 OPS), while Dunand is batting .343 (12-for-35, 3 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 4 R, 5 RBI, 1.052 OPS).

> DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. has reached base safely in 14 of 17 games with at least one plate appearance since 6/1, batting .304 (14-for-46, 2 2B, 1 HR. 11 R, 6 RBI, 6 SB, .863 OPS). Overall with the Stripers this season, he has reached base safely in 44 of 53 games (83.0%) with a plate appearance, batting .265 (40-for-151, 6 2B, 1 HR, 24 R, 16 RBI, .740 OPS).

• IL Leaderboard: DeShields ranks among the IL top 15 in steals (T-9th, 16) and walks (T-15th, 37).

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel tallied a seasonhigh four RBI on 6/30 at Norfolk (2-for-4, 2B, HR), his most RBI in a game since 6/24/21, also at Norfolk (1-for-4, grand slam, 4 RBI in 6-2 win). Of his 18 hits, 12 have gone for extra bases (66.7%, 4 2B, 1 3B, 7 HR). For his Gwinnett career, 49.1% of his hits have been for extra bases (26 of 53), including 10 doubles, one triple, and 15 homers.

MULLER'S QUALITY STREAK ENDS: Kyle Muller saw his five-game quality start streak snapped on 7/1 at Norfolk (loss, 5.1 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 3 SO). During the streak from 6/2-6/26, he went 2-1 with a 1.87 ERA (7 ER in 33.2 IP), .171 BAA, and 11.49 SO/9.0 IP ratio (43 SO).

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (102) and ranks among the IL top five in ERA (2nd, 2.99), WHIP (2nd, 1.09), BAA (3rd, .216), innings (3rd, 81.1), and starts (T-5th, 14).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-9 with a 3.19 ERA (57 ER in 161.0 IP), .219 BAA, and 195 strikeouts (10.90 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 31 starts.

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .167 (7for-42, 4 R, 1 RBI, 2 SB) in 11 games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 170 of 200 games (85.0%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .277 (192-for-693, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 15 SB, .914 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Meija.
