### LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox shut out the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Tuesday night by a final of 3-0 from Prince George's Stadium. **Kyle Brnovich**, **Dylan Heid** and **Dan Hammer** combined for a three-hit shutout and the seventh shutout win of the season. **Matthew Etzel** reached base three times with two hits, including a triple. **Frederick Bencosme** singled in a run in the fifth inning. Heid and Hammer combined to set down the final 12 batters in a row.

### ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B **Samuel Basallo** was selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game on Tuesday and will represent the Orioles at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX on Saturday, July 13. The Orioles No. 2 prospect is the 14th Baysox player in franchise history to be named to the All-Star Futures Game and is the first since Adley Rutschman was named in 2021. The 19-year-old has reached base safely in 31 of his last 33 games dating back to May 21, including in his last 11 straight.

### ON-BASE BENCOSME

IF **Frederick Bencosme**'s team-best 14-game hit streak was snapped on Tuesday, which is tied for the second-longest hit streak in the Eastern League this season behind Portland's Blaze Jordan (19). The Orioles No. 27 prospect still owns a 16-game on-base streak, the fourth longest active on-base streak in the league.

### WELCOME MR. ETZEL

OF/1B **Matthew Etzel** was the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of So. Miss. The 22-year-old hit his first two Double-A homers at Reading this past week. His 37 steals on the season between High-A Aberdeen and Double-A Bowie is tied for seventh-most in all of MiLB.

### BOWENS BATS 'EM IN

1B **TT Bowens** is the first Baysox player to reach 40 RBI on the season after his tie-breaking solo homer on Saturday. He has the ninth-most RBI in the league and has the third-most doubles (17) in the circuit. After playing only 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens has stayed healthy this year with already 61 games played.

### THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is tied for second among active Eastern League players with 13 home runs on the season. Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and hit five in June.

### ON-BASE BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 55 of 66 games started in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.346) and leads the team in walks (39), tied for the most in the Eastern League.

### SHOVING THE SHOVE

After recording a 4.28 ERA in the month of May, Bowie's pitching staff recorded the seventh-lowest ERA in all of Double-A in the month of June (3.51). The Baysox have struck out the most batters in all of Double-A (778).

### SIZING UP THE SQUIRRELS

The Richmond Flying Squirrels finished the first half in fourth in the Southwest Division with a record of 34-35. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants lost five of six to open the second half against Somerset but have won nine of 12 against Bowie in the season series. Richmond's active roster includes only three of the Giants' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - RHP Trevor McDonald (No. 12), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Seth Lonsway makes his second start of the season for Richmond after earning promotion from High-A Eugene on June 25. In his Double-A debut last Friday, Lonsway threw six shutout innings with five strikeouts over four hits and one walk allowed in a no decision. The 25-year-old southpaw recorded a 3.86 ERA in 13 outings with the Emeralds before joining the Flying Squirrels. He was drafted in the sixth round of the 2021 Draft by the Giants out of Ohio State.

**2024:** Three fourth scoreless start of the season with 4.0 IP, 3 H, 4 K, 3 BB on Thu. 6/27 @ REA. Has allowed just 5 ER over last eight starts spanning 29.1 IP (1.53 ERA). Finished first half with a 3.07 ERA over 44.0 IP with 48 K/30 BB. Still looking for first Double-A win. Baysox are 7-7 when he starts but have won five of last eight. Owns a 2.66 ERA in seven home starts. On Tue. 6/4 vs BNG, struck out season-high 8 batters over 4.0 scoreless innings. First game with 8+ K since 5/20/22 with High-A Bowling Green. Finished month of May with a 2.79 ERA in five starts after recording a 4.38 ERA in four April starts. On the BAL 40-man roster. Named to 40-man back in Nov. '22. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

**2023:** Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

**2022:** Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston - just days before his operation in Texas.

**2021:** Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

**2019:** Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

**College/Personal:** Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisburg (N.C) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell. Was his first time pitching since age 12. Convinced his junior college coaches to let him pitch in games after clocking 92 mph on a teammate's Pocket Radar during an off day.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
