LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones' four-game winning streak ended on Wednesday night in an 8-7 defeat to the Emperors...Brooklyn scored three in the seventh and one in the eighth to take a 7-3 lead...Rome answered with five in the bottom of the eighth to take an 8-7 advantage on 1B **Nick Ward's** two-run single...Brooklyn put the tying run at third in the ninth, but couldn't even the score...DH **Nolan McLean** matched a career-high with three hits, adding a double, and a two-run home run...1B **Ryan Clifford** picked up two hits, reached base three times, and drove in a season-best three runs.

YIPPEE KI-YAY: TWP **Nolan McLean** continued his incredible start to his Cyclones career on Wednesday...At the plate, the 22-year-old tied a career-high with three hits and collected a pair of extra-base hits with a double and a two-run home run...On the mound, McLean extended his scoreless inning streak to 13.0 straight by tossing five spotless frames last Saturday vs. Aberdeen, en route to his second victory...Over his previous three starts, McLean is 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 13.0 IP), allowing just six hits and three walks (6.82 BB%), adding 16 strikeouts (36.36 K%). On the year, he is eighth in the South Atlantic League in WHIP (0.95) among pitchers with 19.0+ innings...In addition to his success on the mound, McLean enters play on Thursday with 11 extra-base hits, which is tied for sixth in the SAL...The Willow Springs, N.C. native has registered 30 fewer plate appearances (53) than any other player with 11+ extra-base knocks in the circuit and 14 fewer plate appearances with that total across the minor leagues...Among players with 50+ plate appearances, McLean leads the league in slugging (.660) and ranks fourth in OPS (.981).

HE'S GOT THAT BIG RED DAWG IN HIM: 1B/OF **Ryan Clifford** reached base three times on Wednesday and tallied a season-best three RBI...The 20-year-old enters play on Thursday riding an 11-game on-base streak dating back to April 24...During that time, Clifford is hitting .258/.521/.323 with a .843 OPS...The North Carolina native has scored seven runs, picked up a pair of doubles, brought in five runs, and coaxed 17 walks in 48 plate appearances (35.42 BB%). Clifford's .444 on-base percentage ranks second in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen's INF **Jalen Vasquez** (.446).

WALK THIS WAY: 1B/OF **Ryan Clifford** and INF **William Lugo** have been accumulating walks in droves so far in 2024...Clifford's 30 walks are not only the most in the South Atlantic League but are tied for the most in Minor League Baseball...Additionally, Lugo's 24 free passes are tied for second-most in the league...Clifford's 25.6% walk rate is second-best in MiLB, while Lugo's 22.6% mark is good for eighth.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: OF **Nick Morabito** has reached base safely in both games since making his High-A and Cyclones debut on Tuesday night...Entering play on Thursday, the now 21-year-old is third in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.505), fourth in batting average (.379), and eighth in wRC+ (195)...At the time of his promotion from Single-A St. Lucie, Morabito led the Florida State League in hitting (.397), on-base percentage (.530), and OPS (1.043)...He was also third in slugging (.513), hits (31), and stolen bases (11), tied for sixth in walks (18), and seventh in total bases (40)...C **Chris Suero**, who also joined the team from St. Lucie, has walked three times in his first two contests...The 20-year-old was tied for the FSL lead in runs scored (18) by the time of his departure and seventh in OPS (.824), tied for seventh in RBI (15), eighth in on-base percentage (.390), and 10th in slugging (.434).

NICK THE STICK: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The Connecticut native picked up two more hits on Tuesday night, adding a double and an RBI...Coming into Thursday's matchup, the 23-year-old is tied for second in the South Atlantic League in triples (2), third in doubles (8), fifth in extra-base hits (12), sixth in slugging (.519), and seventh in OPS (.891)...Lorusso is also riding a team season-long eight-game hitting streak...Since April 27, the former Maryland Terrapin is 10-for-30 at the plate and hitting .333/.382/.533 with a .916 OPS...Lorusso has added five runs scored, four doubles, a triple, and six RBI in that time.

COUNTDOWN TO 1K: After Tuesday's 6-2 win over Rome, the Brooklyn Cyclones are now two wins shy of their 1,000th in franchise history...Brooklyn holds a record of 998-841 (.543) in 1,839 games since 2001...The victory also marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 200-210 (.488) in 410 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

JONAH'S WHALE OF A START: RHP **Jonah Tong**'s stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on Wednesday night at 26.0 frames...In seven appearances (five starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 1-0 with a 0.33 ERA (1 ER in 27.2 IP)...Tong is tied with High-A Beloit's LHP **Emmett Olson** for the fewest earned runs allowed (1) in 27.0+ innings across Minor League Baseball...Entering play on Thursday, the Markham, Ont. native is third among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (43.5%) and eighth in strikeout-to-walk rate (32.4%)...Tong's 47 strikeouts are sixth-most in the minors.

SWIPING THE TOP SPOT: With a pair of stolen bases off the bench last Thursday afternoon, OF **Omar De Los Santos** (55) became the Cyclones' all-time stolen base king, breaking a tie with UT **Jaylen Palmer** (50)...In 2023, the 24-year-old eclipsed INF **Walter Rasquin**'s (32) single-season stolen base record with 37 swipes...De Los Santos enters Thursday's contest 18-for-19 stealing bases to start the season...The 18 swipes are second in the South Atlantic League and tied for fourth throughout the minors...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is tied for fifth across the Minors in steals (125).

vs. ROME: Brooklyn opens its only two-week road trip of the season against the Braves' High-A affiliate...The Emperors possess seven of Atlanta's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Spencer Schwellenbach** (3), RHP **Owen Murphy** (5), RHP **Drue Hackenberg** (10), RHP **Jhancarlos Lara** (13), INF **Sabin Ceballos** (18), INF **Ambioris Tavarez** (21), and RHP **Lucas Braun** (24)...This marks the first ever meeting between the Rome and Brooklyn franchises since the Cyclones entered the South Atlantic League in 2021...Rome will visit Coney Island from July 23-28.

GOING BACK TO BACK: The Cyclones shut out the IronBirds for the second-straight day with a 4-0 win on Saturday...RHP **Nolan McLean** (5.0 IP), RHP **Victor Castañeda** (2.0), and RHP **Ben Simon** (2.0) combined on a five-hitter...On Friday, RHP **Brandon Sproat** (5.0), RHP **Jeffrey Colón** (2.2), and RHP **Joey Lancellotti** (1.1) united to one-hit Aberdeen, 2-0...The back-to-back shutouts are the first for the Cyclones at the full-season level and the first since Brooklyn blanked the Connecticut Tigers on the road in both ends of a doubleheader on August 23, 2019...RHP **Michel Otañez** (4.1), RHP **Mitch Ragan** (1.2), and RHP **Josh Hejka** (1.0) united on a 4-0 win in Game 1, while RHP **Dan Goggin** (2.0), RHP **Hunter Parsons** (2.0), and RHP **Jared Biddy** (3.0) led the charge to a 5-0 victory in Game 2...It is also the first for Brooklyn in consecutive nine-inning games since August 21-22, 2014, vs. Staten Island and Tri-City...RHP **Daisuke Matsuzaka** (5.0), LHP **Brad Wieck** (2.0), LHP **Kelly Secrest** (1.0), and LHP **Shane Bay** (1.0) twirled the 'Clones to a 2-0 win over Staten Island in the first leg...RHP **Martires Arias** (5.0), RHP **Gaither Bumgardner** (2.0), and RHP **Cameron Griffin** (2.0) provided the zeroes in a 7-0 rout of Tri-City on the back end...Saturday's blanking marked the fifth of the season for Brooklyn's pitching staff...The five shutouts are the most in the South Atlantic League and tied for the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball...The Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts in 2023.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on Sunday afternoon vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 49 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.64 ERA (23 ER in 78.1 IP) and 4 saves, walking just 18 and striking out 70.

FEAR THE HAWK: RHP **Dakota Hawkins** had his 91-inning scoreless streak snapped in the fifth inning on Thursday at Rome...The stretch was the longest spotless run by a Brooklyn reliever this year...Among South Atlantic League relief arms, Hawkins is tied for the circuit lead in strikeouts (26)...He is also tied for seventh in innings pitched (17.0) and eighth in strikeout-to-walk rate (6.50).

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP **Justin Lawson** has started his 2024 with a bang...The former member of the N.C. State Wolfpack is third in the circuit in saves (4)...Among South Atlantic League relievers with at least 14.0 innings pitched, the 23-year-old leads the circuit in ERA (0.63) and WHIP (0.70), in addition to being tied for the fewest hits allowed (5).

KING STANLEY: With his RBI double in the bottom of the first inning last Friday, OF **Stanley Consuegra** became the first player in Cyclones history to reach the century mark in RBI...The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 67 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 101 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the first in last Tuesday's 9-2 win vs. Aberdeen...They also accomplished the feat in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on April 24...Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning...The seven-run frames are the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, vs. Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph...The 13 runs for Brooklyn set a new season high...The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-12 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023...It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is 10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...The 20 runs were also a franchise record.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 6), **Brandon Sproat** (10), **Nolan McLean** (11), **Jonah Tong** (22), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), **Wilfredo Lara** (23), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 87th-best farmhand in all of baseball.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second-consecutive victory last Friday night vs. Aberdeen...Did not allow a run on one hit over a career-high-tying five innings...Walked four and punched out a career-best eight...Tossed a career-high 84 pitches and 47 strikes (55.95%)...Relieved by RHP **Jeffrey Colón** to start the top of the sixth with Brooklyn leading, 1-0...Sproat, Colón (2.2 IP), and RHP **Joey Lancellotti** (1.1), would combine on a one-hit shutout, as the Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0.

PROSPECT RADAR: Sproat enters the 2024 campaign as one of the top pitching prospects in the New York Mets farm system...The 23-year-old is considered New York's No. 10 prospect per *Baseball America* and No. 13 by MLB Pipeline...He is the fourth-ranked pitching prospect in the organization by *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline.

SPECTACULAR SPROAT: Entering play on Thursday, Sproat has not allowed an earned run in 12.1 innings dating back to two out in the first inning on April 21 at Jersey Shore...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 19.0 innings of work, Sproat ranks second in the circuit in ERA (0.92) behind only LHP **Samuel Aldegheri** (0.64) of Jersey Shore...He is also seventh in the league in hits allowed per nine innings (4.58) and eighth in in opposing OPS (.512).

SPRING BREAKOUT: The Pace, Fla. native earned a hold pitching in relief for the New York Mets prospects in their contest against the Washington Nationals' farmhands on Friday, March 15...Sproat came on in support of fellow Cyclone RHP **Nolan McLean** in the top of the sixth...The right-hander retired the side in order on just six pitches (all strikes) earning punch outs of C **Maxwell Romero Jr.** and OF **Andrew Pinckney**...McLean earned the win and teammate RHP **Calvin Ziegler** picked up the save in New York's 4-2, seven-inning win.

GATOR BAIT: Sproat did not pitch after being drafted by the Mets last season, but thrived for the 2023 NCAA runner-up Florida Gators...In 19 starts, the right-hander posted an 8-3 record with a 4.66 ERA (55 ER in 106.1 IP), earning All-SEC Second Team honors...Sproat finished the campaign seventh among Division I pitchers in strikeouts (134).

THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM: Sproat was drafted for the third and final time in the MLB draft last summer, ultimately signing for a \$1.47 million bonus...Prior to being New York's second-round selection in 2023, the 23-year-old was picked by the Mets in the third round of the 2022 draft out of Florida, but did not sign...In 2019, Sproat was drafted by the Texas Rangers in the seventh round out of Pace High School, but also did not sign.
