**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the RubberDucks, 3-2, in a game shortened to five innings due to rain. **Andy Thomas** gave the Flying Squirrels a 1-0 lead in the first with an RBI single. In the bottom of the first, Johnathan Rodriguez gave the RubberDucks a 2-1 lead with a two-run homer. The Flying Squirrels took a 3-2 lead in the top of the fifth. **Brandon Martorano** tied the score with a sac fly and Thomas hit a go-ahead, RBI single. **Carson Seymour** started and set a season high with seven strikeouts over 4.2 innings. **Raymond Burgos** picked up what became the final out of the game in the fifth before the game went into a rain delay and was eventually called.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels fourth of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The series marks Richmond's only trip to Akron this year. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond from May 16-21. The RubberDucks return to Richmond for a six-game series from Sept. 5-10.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 17-8 in their last 25 games since June 18 but have dropped six-of-their-last-nine. They went 14-2 from June 18-July 6, including taking five-of-six in series against Harrisburg and Reading, prior to losing four straight through Friday. In their last 25 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .247 (195-for-789), best in the Eastern League, with 29 homers, 33 doubles and have score 126 runs. In that same span, the Richmond pitching staff has combined for a 3.14 ERA, second-best in the league, with 274 strikeouts. Over the last 30 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 2.83 ERA (35 ER/111.1 IP) and have allowed eight home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.71 ERA is the best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 311.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 433.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.28 ERA, which is the lowest in Double-A, ahead of Akron, and the fourth-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

**THE RUBBERDUCKS** are 8-5 in their last 13 games since July 3, but have dropped four-of-five. Akron's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including SS Angel Martinez (No. 7), 2B Juan Brito (No. 11), SS Jose Tena (No. 13), OF Petey Halpin (No. 20), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 23), and LHP Doug Nikhazy (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes Martinez (No. 7), Halpin (No. 12), Brito (No. 13), Burns (No. 17), Tena (No. 18), Nikhazy (No. 25) and Will Dion (No. 30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Nick Zwack** makes his 10th start of the season and his second appearance against the RubberDucks. Zwack last pitched out of the bullpen on Sunday afternoon at Harrisburg and threw a season-high five innings, striking out eight while allowing three runs. He made a start against the RubberDucks on May 20 at The Diamond and surrendered four runs, including two homers, over 3.1 innings in a no-decision. Zwack was selected in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets out of Xavier and traded to the Giants last August as part of the deal for Darin Ruf. After starting the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, Zwack earned a promotion to High-A Brooklyn, where he went 5-1 with a 1.84 ERA in 14 outings, landing him a South Atlantic League Post-Season All-Star selection. He closed the season with six starts for High-A Eugene following the trade. Zwack, a native of Minneapolis, played his college career at Xavier, where he was a First-Team All-Big East selection in 2021 as a senior. **For more on Zwack, see page two.**

**FOR AKRON:** Left-hander Doug Nikhazy makes his 14th start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, Nikhazy worked four innings and allowed one run in a loss at Bowie on Saturday. Over his last three starts, he has gone 0-1 with a 1.98 ERA (3 ER/13.2 IP) with 15 strikeouts. Nikhazy pitched at The Diamond on May 18 and surrendered one unearned run over five innings with nine strikeouts to pick up his first Double-A win. For the season, he leads the Eastern League with 48 walks issued and has the highest BB/9 (6.5) and walk percentage (16.2) in the league (min. 60 IP). His 83 strikeouts are tied for ninth in the league and 11.3 K/9 is sixth. Nikhazy was selected by Cleveland in the second round (58th overall) in 2021 out of Ole Miss. In college, he set the Rebels' freshman record with 86 strikeouts in 2019 and ranked fifth in NCAA Division I with 142 strikeouts in 2021. He began his first professional season last year with High-A Lake County and went 4-4 with a 3.19 ERA in 21 starts. He joined Double-A Akron for his final six outings of the year, going 0-2 with an 11.57 ERA. Nikhazy is rated by Baseball America as the No. 30 Guardians prospect and No. 25 by MLB.com.

**THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:** On Thursday night, **Andy Thomas** finished the game with two RBIs. He brought a run in with a single in the first inning and added a go-ahead single in the fifth before rain halted play. On the season, he leads the team with 43 RBIs, which is tied for the sixth-most in the Giants system. He has three RBIs in his last two games played, including a solo homer on Tuesday afternoon. Dating back to June 24, Thomas has picked up 16 RBIs in 16 games played.

**ALL ABOARD THE SHANE TRAIN:** **Shane Matheny** saw his league-leading 22-game on-base streak end on Wednesday when he was retired in a pinch-hitting appearance. It was tied for the longest active streak in Double-A and was the eighth-longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. During the streak, Matheny hit .247 (19-for-77) with six doubles, three homers and 12 RBIs, adding 12 walks with a .352 on-base percentage. He picked up a hit and scored a run in Thursday's win. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 108 walks, moving ahead of **Jarrett Parker** (2013-14) for third-most in franchise history. He trails **Ricky Oropesa** (2013-16) with 112 and **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22) with 158. His .360 career on-base percentage is third-highest in Flying Squirrels franchise history (min. 700 PA).

**RETURN OF THE MECK:** **Wade Meckler** has picked up multiple hits 10 times in his 32 Double-A games. He went on a 24-game on-base streak from May 17-July 6, which was the longest on-base streak to begin a Double-A career in Flying Squirrels history, passing the previous record set by **Luis Matos** (17 games) earlier this season. It was also tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak in franchise history. Meckler also had an 11-game run scored streak from June 23-July 6, which was a Flying Squirrels franchise record, passing the previous mark of nine straight games by Tyler LaTorre in 2014. In Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23, Meckler tied the single-game franchise record for hits, going 5-for-5 and capping the night with a two-run, walk-off single for a 9-8 win over the Senators. For the season, Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 220 PA) in batting average (.393) and 10th in OBP (.461). He ranks second in the Eastern League (min. 120 PA) in batting average (.352), fourth in OBP (.440) and is third in BABIP (.398) while posting the sixth-lowest strikeout percentage (14.5) and the second-lowest swing-and-miss percentage (5.3).

**VAUN GONE WILD:** **Vaun Brown** has picked up 12 RBIs over his last 10 games since July 5, including three in last weekend's series at Harrisburg and two in the opener of this week's set in Akron. He hit a two-run homer last Friday night and added a go-ahead double on Saturday. In his last 17 games, Brown is batting .276 (21-for-76) with six homers, six doubles, 21 RBIs, 12 runs scored and one walk. Brown homered in back-to-back games on June 28 and 29 at Reading, totalling six RBIs in the two games. He homered twice last homestand against the Baysox and added a two-run homer in the series-opener at Harrisburg on Friday night.

**MARTY PARTY:** **Brandon Martorano** has reached base seven times in his last four games played since Last Friday. Last Friday night at Harrisburg, he reached base five times, picking up three hits with a walk and was hit by a pitch. In his last eight games since July 3, Martorano is batting .300 (6-or-20) with four walks, two RBIs and three runs scored. Martorano missed 39 games on the injured list from April 21-June 8. On Thursday, he came through with a game-tying sac fly in the fifth in the win.

**NOT OUT OF HIS ELEMENT:** **Donnie Walton** homered in back-to-back games to open the series. On Tuesday, he went 3-for-5 with a three-run homer and four total RBIs. He added a solo home run on Wednesday night. Walton is riding a four-game hit streak since Saturday, during which he has picked up six total hits with five RBIs.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** Among the Eastern League leaders, **Hayden Cantrelle** is ninth in on-base percentage (.384) and tied for fifth in walks (52). **Carson Seymour** is sixth in ERA (3.91), second in BAA (.227) and fifth in WHIP (1.24). **Mason Black** is tied for ninth in strikeouts (83).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 6), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 8), RHP **Mason Black** (No. 9), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 14), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 15), OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 16), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 27) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes eight Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29).
