Final Week

Reading continues its final series of the season at Binghamton. The Rumble Ponies clinched the season-series over Reading and lead it 12-4.

Reading beat Binghamton 2-1 last night to even the series at two. David Parkinson tossed five-strong innings and allowed one run. Down 1-0, Reading got two runs in the seventh inning, thanks to four-straight walks from Binghamton. The R-Phils bullpen was dominant, as Erich Uelmen, Hans Crouse, McKinley Moore and Jordi Martinez combined to now allow a hit, nor run, over three innings of relief work.

He Dunn Gets on Base

With a walk Thursday night, Oliver Dunn extended his on-base streak to 19 games. If Dunn can reach 20 games, it will mark his second on-base streak of 20-plus games in 2023, with his other coming from May 26 to June 23 (22 games). Dunn leads the team and Eastern League in on base percentage at .402 and also leads the league in OPS at .918.

Pitchers Finishing Strong

Three Reading starters have finished their 2023 seasons on a high note. Mick Abel tossed five-strong on Wednesday, Matt Osterberg went seven-shutout frames Thursday and David Parkinson five-quality innings last night to cap off strong 2023 seasons, and second halves, for all three.

Reading was held to just three hits last night, marking a season low for the eighth time this season. Entering last night, the R-Phils were 7-46 in games when they were outhit this year. But, they got on base plenty, as Resding worked 10 walks. With 12 strikeouts as well, it marked the first time since May 30, 2022, at New Hampshire, that Reading's offense worked 10+ walks and strikeouts in the same game.

Piling Up Strikeouts

Through four games this week, Reading's pitching staff has 48 strikeouts, good for 12 per game. That total includes 17 on Wednesday night and 16 last night from the staff. Reading ranks second in the Eastern League in strikeouts per nine innings this week, with 12.46.

Around the Organization

The Phillies beat the Cardinals last night 5-4 to take the first game of a three-game series. Lehigh Valley beat Rochester 8-4 last night as Kody Clemens had three hits, including two homers. The IronPigs are now two-games back of Durham with eight games to play. Jersey Shore fell 3-2 to Hudson Valley in game three last night to end the BlueClaws season. Clearwater narrolwy edged out Lakeland 2-1 to move on to the Florida State League Championship. The series will begin on Sunday against the Jupiter Hammherheads.

This Day in Baseballtown History

September 16, 1972: At Veterans Stadium in Philadelphia, Mike Schmidt hits his first Major League home run, a three-run shot in the 7th inning that lifts the Phillies past Montreal, 3-1. Schmidt had been a shortstop in Reading just a season before.

Playoff Bound Ponies

Binghamton enters tonight with a 37-27 record in the second half and 72-61 overall this season. The Rumble Ponies clinched the second-half title on Sunday and will match up with Somerset next week in the playoffs. Last week, Binghamton went 4-2 on the road at Hartford. The Ponies have the following Mets prospects ranked within their top 30: Luisangel Acuna (1), Drew Gilbert (2), Jett Williams (3), Kevin Parada (5), Blake Tidwell (10), Christian Scott (12), Dom Hamel (16), Tyler Stuart (17), Jeremiah Jackson (22), Matt Rudick (27) and Coleman Crow (29).

Benito Garcia gets the start for Binghamton tonight, his second Double-A appearence of his career. He was called up from High-A Brooklyn prior to last night's game. His lone appearence came on Sept. 3 against Harrisburg, where he earned a win over three-innings of work in relief. Garcia struck out four and walked one, with one hit allowed and no runs. Garcia has spent most of the season with Brooklyn, going 3-1 with a 1.18 ERA over 20 appearences/two starts. Garcia's also appeared in eight games this season for Single-A St. Lucie. He split 2022 between Brookly, St. Lucie and the FCL. The Mets signed him in 2018 as an international free agent out of the Dominican Republic at 18-years old.
