Tonight: Welcome to the 28th season of Lansing Lugnuts baseball! The Nuts, entering their fourth season as the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play at the Dayton Dragons, the High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds, opening a three-game weekend series.

If the Luggies win tonight, it would... improve Lansing's record to 14-14 all-time on Opening Day; last year the Lugnuts won at Great Lakes in 10 innings, 4-3, en route to a three-game season-opening sweep and four straight wins to begin 2023... it would also be Lansing's fifth straight victory in Dayton.

14 Years Ago: The last time that the Lugnuts opened the season in Dayton, it was April 8, 2010. The Dragons walked off the Nuts 6-5 in 11 innings on a Didi Gregorius RBI single on their way to a three-game sweep. Future Major Leaguer and current Angels infield coach Ryan Goins homered for the Lugnuts in the loss.

On Deck: Following the conclusion of this series, the Lugnuts officially open Jackson Field with a six-game series against Great Lakes from Tuesday, April 9, through Sunday, April 14.

2023 Retrospective: The Lugnuts finished the season with a 60-71 record... catcher Daniel Susac won the Midwest League batting title with a .303 average... 11 former Lugnuts (Ryan Noda, Hogan Harris, Mason Miller, Garrett Acton, Samad Taylor, Tyler Soderstrom, Lawrence Butler, Hagen Danner, Drew Millas, Joey Estes and José Espada) made their Major League debuts, bringing the total to 184 MLB Lugnuts all-time... Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. who played in the 2016 Crosstown Showdown, won the 2023 All-Star Home Run Derby... reliever Kumar Nambiar represented the Minor League Baseball Players' union in a panel of new labor unions with President Biden and Vice President Harris at the White House; Nambiar retired at the end of the season and now works in the Baltimore Orioles' analytics department... the World Series was won by the Texas Rangers, with assistant hitting coach Seth Conner (2013-14 with Lansing), over the Arizona Diamondbacks, starring 2019 Nuts catcher Gabriel Moreno and 2014 pitcher Miguel Castro.

A Good First Impression: The Lugnuts played the Michigan State Spartans on Wednesday in the 16th Crosstown Showdown exhibition, winning easily 18-0. Pitchers Grant Judkins, Hunter Breault and Yehizon Sanchez combined to hold the Spartans to two base runners on a pair of base hits while the offense blasted four home runs: a solo shot and a grand slam from Will Simpson and three-run homers by Joshwan Wright and Henry Bolte. Wright reached base in all four plate appearances (single, homer, two walks), but was outdone by Colby Halter, who reached base five times thanks to two singles, two walks and an HBP.

Prospecting: The Nuts' Opening Day roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 12) and first baseman Will Simpson (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from the University of Washington last year.

Familiar Faces: Lansing returns 17 players from the 2023 ballclub, not including second-year manager Craig Conklin and fourth-year pitching coach Don Schulze. The returners include James Gonzalez, Euribiel Angeles, Brayan Buelvas, Jonny Butler and Joshwan Wright, each of whom appeared in games for the Lugnuts in both 2022 and 2023, as well as lefty Jack Owen, who has pitched effectively for the Lugnuts during each of the last three seasons.

Come Together: The Lugnuts' Opening Day roster includes players representing 10 states, Puerto Rico, and five countries: Canada, Colombia, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

Pure Fire: On Tuesday, 2022 Lugnut Mason Miller delivered the five fastest pitches clocked in the Majors this year in a two-inning scoreless stint vs. Boston, ranging from 101.4 mph to 102.4 mph. Miller's third and final appearance for the Lugnuts was on September 10, 2022, vs. the Dayton Dragons, whiffing seven batters in three hitless innings. He made his Major League debut seven months later.

History vs. Dayton

The Lugnuts are 213-171 (.555) all-time vs. the Dayton Dragons, their best winning percentage

against any team in the Midwest League. They are 109-87 all-time at home against Dayton

and 104-84 in the Gem City. Last year, the Nuts went 6-6 vs. Dayton, losing four of six games at home before reeling off four straight victories at Day Air Ballpark.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

1996: TThe Lugnuts play their first ever game, drawing 9,318 despite temperatures in the 30s. A dropped popup in the ninth inning, however, forces extras, and the Rockford Cubbies triumph in the tenth, 9-5. The starting lineup including 18-year-old switch-hitting outfielder Carlos Beltran.

2010: Johnny Aiello stole home in the sixth, Alejandro Kirk stole home in the seventh, and Reggie Pruitt stole second base three times in a 7-3 win at Fort Wayne. Joey Murray whiffed five in five innings while allowing two unearned runs in his Lugnuts debut, earning the win.

Happy Birthday! Chris Dorsett (1975), a catcher on the 1999 Lugnuts who played in 57 games and drew 37 walks while striking out only 24 times (.395 OBP). It was the last of his two professional seasons.

In a Nutshell: Appearing for the Lugnuts for the third straight season... was added to the Lansing roster from Stockton on August 15, 2023, to replace the promoted Brady Basso, and impressed in four appearances to conclude the year... had previously been a member of the Lugnuts at age 21 for five ill-fated appearances from April 14-May 10, 2022 before getting transferred to Stockton to conclude the 2022 season.

Statistically Speaking: Base stealers were successful in 18 out of 20 attempts against James in 2023... Midwest League hitters batted just .151 (8-for-53) in the first five innings... dominated right-handed hitters in the MWL (8-for-45, .178, .483 OPS) compared to lefties (7-for-26, .269, .713 OPS).

Path to Lansing: After signing as a free agent at age 18 in 2019, James jumped from the Dominican Summer League that initial professional season to the Arizona Complex League and the Low-A West in 2021, then joined the Lugnuts out of Extended Spring Training last season before finding a regular role in the Ports' rotation... this season, he ranked second in the California League in strikeouts (108) and seventh in innings pitched (87 1/3), recording four quality starts as the ace of the Stockton starting rotation.

Changing Things Up: Former Lugnuts pitcher Stevie Emanuels, who broke out last season, earning a trip to the Arizona Fall League and a spot in Double-A to begin this season, credits James for teaching him his current change-up grip last year while with Stockton... James's sinking change-up is considered his best pitch.

Los Canaleros: Joins Joshwan Wright (Injured List) as native Panamanians on the Lugnuts' roster... both were on Team Panama's World Baseball Class team in 2023... made one appearance, allowing three hits and two runs without recording an out... the best players from Panama in baseball history: Mariano Rivera, Rod Carew, Carlos Lee, Bruce Chen, Juan Berenguer.

In a Nutshell: The last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016 and spent 2022 with the Cincinnati Reds... @mitch_myers9.

Respect: Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Super Monkey Ball...* he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightly in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.
