**TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER:** The Curve play their lone series of the season with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays.

Alex Amalfi pitched two scoreless innings against the Curve last June and makes his fourth start of the season today, 10th overall appearance. Right-handed batters have hit .318 against Amalfi this year, he allowed 5 runs in 3.0 innings last week at Somerset. A native of Ashland, MA, Amalfi was signed as an undrafted free agent in July of 2022 after he finished his junior season at UMass Boston (D3).

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Curve had 7 doubles in their 8-3 comeback win at New Hampshire on Tuesday, June 2. **Callan Moss** and **Lonnie White Jr.** each had two doubles in the win.

**DIAMONDS ARE FOREVER:** Since his return from an early season IL stint, righty **Derek Diamond** has tossed 6.0 scoreless frames and allowed just 1 hit and no walks with 9 strikeouts. Diamond finished off a 5-2 Curve win on Saturday, May 30 with 5 consecutive strikeouts.

**IF ALL THE ICE MELTS, IS IT JUST BERG LETTUCE?:** Catcher **Derek Berg** has emerged as a one of Altoona's top contributors at the plate in late-May. Berg has a hit in 11 straight games dating back to May 17, in that time he's hitting .356 (16-for-45) with 4 2B, 4 HR and 10 RBI (1.119 OPS).

**IT'S NICE TO DUMITRU:** In his last 14 games, outfielder **Titus Dumitru** has hit .302/.373/.547 (.920 OPS) with 7 2B, 2 HR and 9 RBI since May 17. He went 8-for-25 with 4 2B and 2 HR, 7 RBI last week at Hartford. **Dumitru** and **Berg** each have reached base safely in 16 straight games, the longest streaks by a Curve batter this season.

**WALKING THE TIGHT ROPE:** Each of Altoona's first four games with Hartford were decided by one run.

**CAPTAIN MURDOCK:** Reliever **Noah Murdock** bounced back from a rough team debut to become one of Altoona's most reliable arms out of the bullpen. He's unscored upon in his last 7 outings before a promotion to Triple-A on June 2, covering 11.1 IP he's allowed just 4 hits, 3 walks and struck out 12 (0.62 WHIP, .111 BAA).

**'CURT SCHILLING?:** Right-hander **Khristian Curtis** ranks 2nd among Eastern League hurlers with 61 strikeouts, T-5th among Double-A arms. Curtis tossed a career-long 7.0 innings on May 26 at Hartford, a start in which he allowed just one earned run and did not walk a batter for the second time in 10 starts this year. He ranks 2nd among Pirates Minor Leaguers in strikeouts behind Greensboro's Seth Hernandez (68).

**LAWNBALL LONNIE:** Outfielder **Lonnie White Jr.** homered in three straight games from May 15-17, the first such stretch of his career. Since arriving in Altoona, White Jr. has 12 extra-base hits in 27 games since joining the Curve on May 1.

This season, White Jr. is T-2nd among Pirates minor leaguers with 12 homers, he also ranks 5th in RBI (32), 3rd in BB (31) and 4th in SB (14).

**WILLY T:** Around a brief injured list stint, outfielder **Will Taylor** has emerged as one of Altoona's most consistent hitters. Taylor had 14-game on-base streak around his IL stint (.424 OBP) and stretching back to April 19 (27G) he's recorded a .448 on-base percentage and a .876 OPS.

**ITS OUTTA HERE:** The Curve have recorded 13 games this season in which they've hit at least two home runs. The Curve have hit 50 home runs in 53 games, they're on pace to hit 134 homers this season which would be the most in a season since 2023 when the club hit 122 round trippers. Altoona's franchise record of 143 homers in a season was set in 2022.

2005 - Jose Bautista leads a 16-hit barrage for the Curve with a 4-5 performance with 4 RBI and a solo homer. Curve won 10-8.

2023 - Catcher Henry Davis is promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis after Altoona finishes off a 5th straight win over Binghamton, 6-4. Davis' .980 OPS was the 4th-highest mark among Double-A players at the time of his promotion, he reached base safely in 37-of-41 games with the Curve to begin the 2023 season.

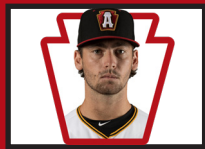
