THE SURGE - The Wichita Wind Surge continue their first road series of the season this afternoon. The Wind Surge will play 69 road games this season and nine games in North Little Rock, Arkansas.

THE ROAD OPENER – The Wind Surge dropped to 2-4 in road openers and 0-3 when the Surge already opened the season at home.

SURGE DROP SERIES OPENER- The Wind Surge opened a six-game road series with a 4-2 loss to Arkansas despite a dominant performance on the mound that produced 16 strikeouts, the third-highest total in franchise history. Wichita’s pitching staff showcased swing-and-miss ability throughout the game, but all four Arkansas runs came via the home run. Offensively, Billy Amick led the way with a two-run homer in the first inning as part of a multi-hit performance. Ben Ross and Hendry Mendez also recorded multiple hits, but the Wind Surge were unable to generate enough runs. Four Wichita pitchers recorded at least three strikeouts, including seven from right-hander Mike Paredes in his four-inning start. Relievers Jaylen Nowlin, Alejandro Hidalgo and Darren Bowen each added three strikeouts in relief.

*The franchise record of 20K’s was set on 8/16/22 vs Tulsa. 17K’s vs. Arkansas on 5/20/23.

AGAINST THE TRAVELERS - The Wind Surge and Travs will play 21 times this season. The Surge won the 2025 season series taking 12 of 18 meetings and split the three game series in the capital city. Wichita leads the all-time series 58-39 and have won the season series in four of the five years with 2023 being a split.

INSIDE THE PARKER – Billy Amick sprinted around the bases on Saturday for an inside the park home run. The fourth by a Wind Surge player. Will Holland, Alex Isola, and Nate Baez last June 13th vs Corpus Christi.

GOING TO BE GOLDEN- Kyle DeBarge was awarded the MiLB Gold Glove for his defense in 2025 at Cedar Rapids on Fri.

ON THE BUMP- Ryan Gallagher is set to make his second start of the season today, he dealt four innings in the opener on Thursday. A no decision working four innings, allowed four runs, two earned. Its his second career start vs Arkansas earning a win late last season pitching five innings, allowed four runs.

Nico Time in the ITC- Nico Giarratano takes the helm as manager of the Wind Surge in 2026, taking over for Brian Dinkelman, who was promoted to manage the Minnesota Twins’ Class AAA club, the St. Paul Saints, following one season in Wichita. Giarratano, who is entering his fourth year with the Twins organization, arrives in Wichita after leading the Florida Complex League Twins to a 39–20 record and a division title in 2025. He spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons as a development coach at the Twins’ Florida Complex. Before joining the Twins organization, Giarratano broke into coaching by managing the Seattle Mariners’ Dominican Summer League team in 2022. Prior to coaching, he played collegiately at the University of San Francisco and was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 24th round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

WELCOME BACK, WELCOME BACK, WELCOME BACK - The Wind Surge returned 19 players from the 2025 roster to open the 2026 season. That total marks the highest number of returning players on a season-opening roster in franchise history, surpassing the 18 returners from 2024. Dating back to 2022, Wichita has brought back double-digit returners in five consecutive seasons.

TOP OF THE LEAGUE - The Surge enter the 2026 season looking to build off a dominant offensive campaign in 2025, when they led the Texas League in both home runs (170) and runs scored (718). Wichita returns key contributors in Kala’i Rosario, Andrew Cossetti, and Ben Ross, each of whom hit 14 or more home runs and drove in 50-plus runs last season, as the Surge aim to remain one of the league’s most productive offenses.

WICHITA WUNDERKINDS - The Wind Surge open the 2026 season with one of the most talent-rich rosters in the Texas League, featuring seven players ranked among the Minnesota Twins’ Top 30 prospects according to MLB.com. Headlining the group are Hendry Mendez (No. 12), Ryan Gallagher (No. 21), C.J. Culppepper (No. 22), Kyle DeBarge (No. 22), Billy Amick (No. 24), Jose Olivares (No. 26), and Kala’i Rosario (No. 29)
