Durham Bulls RHP Joe Boyle (3-3, 1.46) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Brian Van Belle (1-1, 3.54)

Welcome Home – The Worcester Red Sox – who left home 16 days ago – finally play again at Polar Park tonight when they open a 6-game series against the Durham Bulls (AAA-Tampa Bay) this evening at 6:05 pm. The WooSox left the Heart of the Commonwealth on Monday, May 5th in advance of their season-long 12-game roadtrip to Lehigh Valley and then Buffalo from May 6-18. Through it all, the WooSox went 5-7 going 2-4 vs. the IronPigs and then 3-3 vs. the Bisons last week and this past weekend. They now host the 2nd-place Durham Bulls this week/weekend for their last remaining homestand in the month of May. Tonight's game is live on NESN+ and can be heard on NASH 98.9 FM, The Pike 100.1 FM, and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network.

Work From Home – Including tonight, 18 of the next 30 WooSox games will be played here at Polar Park to conclude the first half of the International League schedule (which ends with a June 22 game vs. Buffalo at Polar Park). Worcester is 9-11 at home compared to 12-12 on the road. This 6-game set with Durham includes night games tonight & tomorrow at 6:05 pm, a morning start on Thursday at 11:05 am, a Friday evening affair at 6:05 pm, and then weekend games on Saturday at 4:05 pm and Sunday at 1:05 pm. Durham comes to town with a 28-17 record good for a tie for 2nd-place in the IL East with Jacksonville and 3 GB of front-running Lehigh Valley who have a 31-14 record. Worcester is 21-23 and has matched their season-high deficit of 9½ GB of the IronPigs.

"The Password" to Enter Polar Park – The Red Sox today have transferred outfielder **Jhostynxon Garcia** from Double-A Portland to Worcester. Pronounced JOES-tin-son, the unusual spelling of his first name has earned him the nickname "The Password". The 22-year-old Venezuelan is already in his 5th professional season since the Red Sox signed him as an international free agent in July of 2019. He was added to Boston's 40-man roster this past off-season. Garcia has spent this season with Portland playing 33 games (31 in CF) and batting .256 with 5 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 17 RBI, and 4 SB. His average was .291 on May 7 but he was 5-for-31 in his last 8 games. Jhostynxon had back-to-back walk-off hits on May 10 (game-winning HR) and May 11 (game-winning 2-run single) to give the Sea Dogs wins over Chesapeake Bay. Garcia led all Red Sox minor leaguers with 23 HR last year during a fine offensive season split among three Red Sox affiliates. He played in 24 games for Salem (A), 53 games for Greenville (A+), and 20 games for Portland (AA) and batted a combined .286 with 24 2B, 23 HR, 66 RBI, and a .536 slugging pct.

Lost Weekends – The WooSox have suffered some rough weekends during the last month and have not won a weekend game since Sunday, April 20 in Rochester, 7-0. Since then they were rained out on Saturday, April 26 and then swept by Syracuse in a doubleheader on April 27 at Polar Park; lost both Saturday, May 3 and Sunday, May 4 at home vs. Toledo; dropped games at Lehigh Valley on Saturday, May 10 and Sunday, May 11; and fell this past Saturday and Sunday in Buffalo. For reasons unknown, the WooSox are just 3-11 on weekends this season (0-5 on Saturdays and 3-6 on Sundays) but they are 18-12 on weekdays/weeknights. And the good news... Worcester is 4-2 on Tuesdays thus far this season.

What Have You Done For Me Lately – The WooSox have lost 14 of their last 21 games since April 25 after winning 10 of their previous 11 games from April 13-24. They had to settle for a split of their most recent series in Buffalo after an 8-4 loss to the Bisons in the series and roadtrip finale on Sunday. Worcester is 2-4-2 in their first eight series played this season...two wins, four losses, and two splits.

Sox Standouts

-OF **Roman Anthony** has a 9-game hitting streak (14-for-34, .412) and has reached base safely in 11 of his last 16 plate appearances (3 games) with 6 hits and 5 walks. He has also been on base in 16 games in a row and has reached in 33 of his last 34 games (since April 6). Among those 33 games on base he has had 28 games with at least one hit and the other 5 games with at least one walk. He has hit safely in 20 of his last 23 games (30-for-81, .370) with 19 walks, 5 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 5 RBI, and 18 runs scored.

-INF/OF **Nate Eaton** had his 9-game hitting streak end on May 7. He has hit in 16 of 20 at a .301 clip (22-for-73) with 6 doubles, 2 HR & 12 RBI.

-INF/OF **Vaughn Grissom** has a 6-game hitting streak (8-for-27, .296).

-1B **Nathan Hickey** has hit in 7 of his last 9 games (9-for-31, .290) with 1 2B, 4 HR & 12 RBI. He did not get a hit on May 17 in Buffalo but reached base all five plate appearances on 4 walks and 1 HBP.

-INF **Marcelo Mayer** had his streak of reaching base safely end at 22 straight games on May 11 (it began on April 15). He has hit in 18 of his last 26 games (31-for-102, .304) with 5 2B, 1 3B, 6 HR, 30 RBI, and 18 runs scored. Marcelo is 4th in all of professional baseball with 40 RBI on the season behind only Jac Caglianone - formerly of Northwest Arkansas (AA-KC) and recently promoted to Triple-A Omaha - who has 43 RBI as well as Wilmer Flores of the Giants (42 RBI) and Aaron Judge who has 41 RBI. Mayer is tied for 6th in the IL with 8 HR.

-OF **Trayce Thompson** has hit in 5 straight (9-for-24, .375) with 1 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBI, and 5 runs scored.

Among the League Leaders – Several WooSox are among the Top Ten in the International League in a variety of categories.

Roman Anthony is 2nd in walks (35), tied for 3rd in runs (31), 5th in hits (48), 5th in OBP (.446), and 7th in total bases (75). **Nate Eaton** is tied for 9th in hits (45), tied for 4th in doubles (13), tied for 8th in extra-base hits (17), and 10th in runs scored (28). **Vaughn Grissom** is tied for 6th in runs scored (29). **Marcelo Mayer** is 1st in RBI (40), tied for 6th in HR (8), and 9th in total bases (73). RHP **Robert Stock** is tied for 5th in SO (51) and 6th in lowest batting average against (.199).

Where They Rank – Worcester comes into play tonight with a .260 Team Batting average (5th in the league), they are 5^h in runs scored (234), 5th in hits (377), tied for 2nd in doubles (84), 6th in HR (46), 5th in on-base pct. (.352), 7th in slugging pct. (.420), 6th in OPS (.772), and 3rd in LOB (333). On the pitching side, the WooSox are 12th with their 4.81 ERA.

Durham has the 2nd best ERA in the league at 3.18 (Nashville is at 3.16) while the Bulls are 11th in the IL in batting (.249).

It All Adds Up - Worcester is 21-23 overall. They have been exactly at the .500 mark for the 10 times already this year. The WooSox have been 1-1, 2-2, 3-3, 8-8, 9-9, 14-14, 16-16, 18-18, 20-20, and 21-21. The Sox were a season-low 4-games below .500 (4-8) on April 11, but quickly turned things around to reach a season-high of 5-games above .500 on April 24 (14-9).

Home Run Derby – The WooSox have maximized their use of the long-ball all season as 27 of their total 46 HR on the year have come with runners on base. Worcester batters have belted (19) solo HR, (16) 2-run homers, (6) 3-run blasts & (5) grand slams.

Bulls Run at Polar Park – Worcester has yet to play in Durham, North Carolina since the WooSox were born in 2021. This week marks the Bulls third trip to Polar Park in Worcester, however. From August 2-7 of the 2022 season, the clubs split a 6-game series here at Polar Park. Current WooSox RHP Cooper Criswell started one game and appeared in relief in another for Durham during that series back in 2022. And just over a year ago from April 16-21 of 2024, the WooSox took 4 of 6 from Durham here in Worcester. The Sox won the first three games by 7-4, 6-2, and 12-5 scores; the Bulls swept a make-up doubleheader on April 20 by 12-2 & 4-3 scores; and Worcester won the finale and the series outright with a 7-1 victory on April 21.

Durham Dynasty - As winners of the 2nd half of the International League in 2023, the Durham Bulls qualified for the International League playoffs for an amazing 19th time in their first 25 Triple-A seasons. (They did not make the post-season last year). Durham did lose their playoff series to eventual 2023 Triple-A Champion Norfolk last September, 2 games to 1 as the Bulls fell short in their attempt to repeat and defend their 2022 International League Championship. The Durham Bulls became the Triple-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays in 1998 when they joined the International League. From 1998 – 2019 (the last year of the former International League), Durham won nine (9) Governors' Cup Championships as champions of the IL post-season. Those titles came in 1998, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003 (over the PawSox), 2009, 2013, 2017, and 2018. Pawtucket did defeat Durham in a thrilling 5-game Governors' Cup Finals series in 2014. In 2021 in the new Triple-A East, Durham had the best record of any of the 20-teams in the league winning the Triple-A East South Division with their 86-44 overall record. That mark included a 9-1 finish as the Bulls also captured the Triple-A Final Stretch which was 10-game "playoff" that was a late addition to the original Triple-A schedule by Major League Baseball. And in 2022 the Bulls won their 10th Governor's Cup before falling one game short of another title in September of 2023.

Streaks Appeal – The WooSox have had a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks (from April 13-18 and again from April 20-24). Worcester had a season-high 5-game losing streak from April 25-30 and they have also had a 4-game losing streak (May 8-11) and a 3-game losing skid (April 5-9).

Movin' Along in May After April is History – Worcester is scheduled to play 27 games in the 31 days this May and they are 7-9 this month. The WooSox finished 13-13 in April – a month that also included one cold-out, two snow-outs, and one rain-out among three postponements and one cancellation (3 at home & 1 on the road). And the WooSox went 1-1 in March that also had one rain-out mixed in for good measure (at home).

Month to Month - Sox hitters are batting .235 (124-for-528) with 17 HR & 74 runs scored while Sox pitchers are 7-9 with a 5.29 ERA (80 ER in 136 IP) with 23 HRA and 87 runs allowed. Worcester hit .273 in April with 25 HR & 145 runs scored and WooSox pitchers were 13-13 in April with a 4.74 ERA along with 26 HRA and 128 runs given up.

A Winning Tradition – The 2024 Worcester Red Sox went 79-71 to post a winning season for the fourth time in as many years of existence and for the third year in a row under manager Chad Tracy. Trace is only the second Red Sox Triple-A manager to ever post three consecutive winning seasons. Darrell Johnson did so from 1971-73 (the first two years when the Red Sox Triple-A club was in Louisville before moving to Pawtucket in 1973). Worcester finished 35-40 during the first half last year but then improved to 44-31 in the second half. Overall the 2024 WooSox went 40-34 at home and 39-37 on the road. The 2021 WooSox had a 74-54 record during their abbreviated inaugural season, the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73, and the 2023 club posted a 79-68 mark.

2024 WooSox Batters Led the Way – Worcester led all 20 International League clubs in a host of team offensive categories last season. The WooSox led the league with 869 runs scored (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was next with 846 runs scored). The Sox also led the IL with 786 walks (Toledo was a distant 2nd with 676 walks). Worcester paced the league by a wide margin with an impressive .369 on-base pct. as the WooSox were the only team in the IL with an OBP of over .359 (Scranton/WB was 2nd at .358). Furthermore, Worcester had the 2nd best OPS in the league at .795 (Columbus was 1st at .804).

2024 Rankings – Worcester finished 5th in the IL in team batting with a .259 average. On the pitching side, the Sox were 10th in team ERA (4.84). Sox pitchers allowed the 2nd fewest HR in the league (141 HRA while Nashville had 139 HRA). Defensively, the WooSox were 11th with a .979 field pct. (107 errors in 5126 total chances).

Players Aplenty - The 2024 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records (previously set by the 2023 WooSox) as they made 281 player transactions during the 2024 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used 84 different players in 2024 (37 position players and 47 pitchers) to better the mark of 79 players in 2023. Ironically, the 2021 WooSox broke a long-standing Red Sox Triple-A record when they used 72 different players to beat the 1995 Pawtucket Red Sox (during a strike year when replacement players were used for the first month+ of that season) and the 2006 PawSox

who each employed 70 different players. When Chad Tracy made his Worcester debut in 2022, the WooSox quickly set a new record using 75 different players (that was immediately topped first in 2023 and again in 2024).

WooSox to BoSox - The WooSox sent 28 different players to Boston during the 2024 season (not counting rehab players). A total of 22 different players were promoted from Double-A Portland to Triple-A Worcester last season.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) GAME RECAP – The Portland Sea Dogs (20-15) open a series at home vs. Reading tonight.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – As mentioned on Page 1 of these Game Notes, the Boston Red Sox today transferred OF **Jhostynxon Garcia** from Double-A Portland to Worcester. The WooSox today also reinstated catcher **Seby Zavala** from the injured list (he had been rehabbing with the Florida Complex League Red Sox since May 5 after going on the IL on April 14 with a left oblique strain) and reinstated INF/OF Tyler McDonough who had been on the injured list since April 20 with an intra-abdominal injury (suffered after he crashed into the CF making a great catch on April 19 in Rochester). And the WooSox today added RHP **Cooper Criswell** following his option from Boston on May 16. Criswell, who is expected to start for the WooSox on Friday night, has posted a 1.99 ERA (5 ER/22.2 IP) with a 0.97 WHIP and 31 strikeouts in five games (four starts) for Worcester. He has also appeared in three games this season for Boston, allowing eight runs (five earned) in 4.1 innings.

To make room, the WooSox today placed INF **Alex Binelas** and OF **Phillip Sikes** on the Development List.

Worcester currently has four players on their 7-day injured list...pitchers Shane Drohan, Hobie Harris, Jacob Webb and Josh Winckowski and three players on the development list...catcher Enderso Lira, INF Alex Binelas, and OF Phillip Sikes.

Since the start of the season (7½ weeks) the WooSox have sent RHP Hunter Dobbins (three times), RHP Robert Stock, C Blake Sabol, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Michael Fulmer, NF Nick Sogard (twice), RHP Luis Guerrero, RHP Cooper Criswell (twice), INF Abraham Toro, and RHP Nick Burdi to Boston; although Stock, Winckowski, Sabol, Guerrero, and Criswell are all back with Worcester. The Red Sox also recalled rehabbers RHP Lucas Giolito & C Connor Wong from Worcester. Furthermore, Fulmer elected to become a free agent and signed with the Cubs following his outright assignment, RHP Quinn Priester was traded, and OF Corey Rosier and C Enderso Lira were sent to Double-A Portland (although Rosier and Lira have rejoined the WooSox).
