**ABOUT LAST TIME...** The Vancouver Canadians mustered a season-low two hits in an 8-0 loss to the Spokane Indians (Rockies) Thursday afternoon as their seven-game winning streak against their Eastern Washington opponent came to an end.

After a scoreless first, Spokane took the lead for good with a run in the bottom of the second. Niko Decolati successfully bunted for a base hit and went to third on the same play after the throw to first went down the right field line before coming home with the first run of the game via a Luis Quinones (L, 1-1) balk.

Spokane starter Ryan Feltner (W, 3-1) baffled the C's for five innings in which he scattered two hits, walked two and struck out seven.

The Indians doubled their lead by scoring a run without a hit in the fourth. Consecutive one out walks, a double steal and a wild pitch made it 2-0 before an RBI double from Willie MacIver in the fifth put the Tribe up 3-0.

Quinones made it through four innings and issued a season-high six walks - the most by a C's starter this year - with eight strikeouts.

Spokane put the game away for good with two runs in the sixth and three in the eighth to win 8-0.

**HASTA AVISTA:** Vancouver arrives in Spokane this week for the first of two visits to Avista Stadium and the second of five meetings with the Indians. These two teams last met May 11-16 at Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro, when the C's took the last five games of the series after dropping the home-away-from-home opener. The Canadians have outscored the Rockies affiliate 44-24 in the season series.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

**ON THIS DATE IN BASEBALL HISTORY:** June 11, 1990 - At the age of 43, Ranger Nolan Ryan no-hits the A's, 5-0, becoming the oldest player to throw a no-hitter, extending his major league record to six. The 'Ryan Express' becomes the first player to throw one in three different decades and to accomplish the feat for three different teams.

**DID YOU KNOW?:** C's skipper Donnie Murphy made his pro debut for Spokane in 2002 after he was drafted by the Royals in the 5<sup>th</sup> round that year. 19-year-old Murph hit .303 with 10 doubles, two triples, 12 runs scored and 15 RBI in 28 games before he was promoted to Low-A Burlington. He made his MLB debut with Kansas City in 2004 and went on to play in parts of nine seasons with five different teams.

**ON THE HILL:** #9 Blue Jays prospect (MLB.com) Adam Kloffenstein returns to the hill tonight looking for a return to his early season form that saw him post a 1-0 record and 0.71 ERA through his first three outings. His finest start of the year game against the Indians on May 15; that day, the 20-year-old dominated for six innings in which he allowed one run on two hits with two walks and four strikeouts. Since then, Kloffenstein has allowed 15 earned runs in 9.1 innings and has failed to go longer than 4.2 frames in a start. Drafted in the third round (88<sup>th</sup> overall) of the 2018 draft out of Magnolia HS in his hometown of Magnolia, TX, "Kloff" is in the midst of his first full professional season.

Right-hander Will Ethridge makes his Advanced-A debut tonight for Spokane after he was promoted from Low-A Fresno. In six starts for the Grizzlies, the 23-year-old went 3-1 with a 2.56 ERA in 31.2 innings pitched with 32 strikeouts and just two walks. Low-A Southwest batters hit .191 against him. Ethridge played collegiately at Ole Miss where he was teammates with C's reliever Parker Caracci.
