Tonight: Coming off a home six-game split against Lake County and a road six-game split at Dayton, the Lugnuts open a series at Fort Wayne against the TinCaps in the first of 18 meetings between the two clubs this season. 23-year-old right-hander **Rafael Kelly**, whose 3.35 ERA in 2019 ranked second-best in the Oakland system, makes his second start of the season for the Nuts, taking on Fort Wayne right-hander **Matt Waldron**, in his third start of 2021.

Last Game: Lugnuts 3, Dayton Dragons 1. The Nuts halted a three-game losing streak behind **Stevie Emanuels** (five shutout innings) and the relief work of **Dalton Sawyer**, **Aiden McIntyre** and **Jack Weisenburger**, with Lansing's shutout bid spoiled in the ninth by a Brian Rey RBI double. An **Austin Beck** RBI double and a **Ryan Gridley** RBI single in the fourth inning gave the Lugnuts all the runs they would need, with a **Shane Selman** bases-loaded walk in the eighth inning supplying insurance.

Last Transaction: The Nuts have made only one roster move this year, placing starting pitcher **Jeff Criswell** on the Injured List and adding relief pitcher **Brandon Withers** from Extended Spring Training on May 12th. Withers is the 835th player in Lugnuts team history.

LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland Athletics, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020). The Athletics had previously partnered with Lugnuts rivals Burlington (1963-1974, 2011-2012), West Michigan (1994-1996), Kane County (1993-2010) and Beloit (2013-2020).

Meet the Boss: **Scott Steinmann** is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017).

Best in the High-A Central: The Lugnuts' pitching staff has allowed four runs or fewer in 10 of 12 games, including all six games against Dayton (4, 2, 4, 3, 3, 1). The Nuts rank 1st in the league in ERA (2.38), fewest walks (28), GO/AO ratio (1.66) and double plays (7). Only the Buffalo Bisons (1.82) have a better team ERA than the Lugnuts; only the Montgomery Biscuits (24) and Aberdeen IronBirds (25) have walked fewer batters; and only the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes have a better GO/AO ratio (1.87), though, weirdly, the Quakes have only turned two double plays this season.

Double Your Fun: The Lugnuts' offense leads the circuit in doubles (31), nine more than Fort Wayne and South Bend, who are tied for second. That team doubles total is tied for 3rd-most in Minor League Baseball with the Sugar Land Skeeters, trailing the Everett AquaSox (37) and Lynchburg Hillcats (33). Outfielder **Jake Suddleson** leads the High-A Central with six doubles and infielder **Ryan Gridley** is tied for fourth with four doubles.

A Slew of Starters: The Lugnuts have already used eight starting pitchers this season, with a ninth on the horizon, namely: **Seth Shuman** (May 4, May 15); **Brady Basso** (May 5, May 12); **Richard Guasch** (May 6); **Reid Birlingmair** (May 7, May 14); **Jeff Criswell** (May 8); **Stevie Emanuels** (May 9, May 16); **Rafael Kelly** (May 11); and **Shohei Tomioka** (May 13); with **Colin Peluse** scheduled to start for the first time on Saturday.

Streaking: Outfielder **Jake Suddleson** was hitless in his pro debut on Opening Day, but has hit safely in all eight games he has played since (11-for-31, .355). Infielder **Ryan Gridley**, infielder **Max Schuemann** and outfielder **Michael Guldborg** have each reached base in their last seven games.

Major League Lugnuts: Two former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, pitcher **Ty Tice** '18 and outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17, with the duo coincidentally making their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2014: In a tie game in the bottom of the ninth, Dayton Dragons reliever Evan Mitchell attempted to complete an intentional walk to Jorge Saez with runners at first and third, but catcher Brandon Dailey's passed ball on Ball 4 brought Justin Atkinson in from third with the winning run in a 4-3 Lugnuts win.

2017: The Lugnuts won their 1500th game all-time, 5-1 at South Bend's Four Winds Field. Patrick Murphy carried a perfect game bid into the sixth inning, outdueling top prospect Dylan Cease.

Familiar Settings: 14 of the 30 Lugnuts players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members **Scott Steinmann**, **Don Schulze** and **Anthony Phillips** all have experience in the league.

A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You: **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University, and **Jeff Criswell** (Portage Central H.S.) and **Jack Weisenburger** (Rockford H.S.) are the fourth and fifth Michigan Wolverines to play in Lansing (following **Troy Miller**, **Jake Fox** and **Rich Hill**).

Finally: Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielders **Michael Guldberg** and **Jake Suddleson** are all making their pro debut this season.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. Outfielder **Jake Suddleson** and first baseman **Patrick McColl** played for Harvard, reliever **Michael Danielak** was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher **William Simoneit** spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (**Michael Guldberg**, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (**Brady Basso**, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (**Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger**, Michigan; **Dalton Sawyer**, Minnesota); and the SEC (**Cobie Vance**, Alabama, and **Ryan Gridley**, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (**Stevie Emanuels**, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 15 different states represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. **Jake Suddleson** and **Patrick McColl** played together at Harvard, **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and **Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger** pitched together in Ann Arbor. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons, but **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year. Simoneit has caught Peluse twice this season, forming a full Demon Deacon battery.

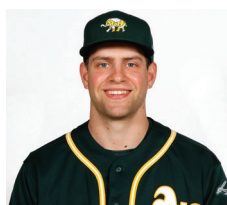

Personal: One of five international free agents on the Lugnuts roster... one of four players (Austin Beck, Michael Danielak, Ryan Gridley) with experience at the High-A level, having pitched in Stockton in 2019... signed with the A's at age 19 on July 1, 2016... scout: Juan C. De La Cruz, who also signed teammate Richard Guasch... Guasch had taken up residence in the Dominican Republic after leaving Cuba... other notable players from Samaná: Hanley Ramirez, Yordano Ventura, Wily Peralta, Fernando Rodney.

Last Outing: Received first start of the season on Tuesday, May 11th at Dayton, replacing Opening Day starter Seth Shuman (who was pushed back to May 15th)... pitched on a tightrope, allowing eight hits, one walk and one HBP in five innings, but struck out five and allowed only two runs in a no-decision... pitched around a pair of singles in the 1st inning, with Quin Cotton caught stealing second base by catcher Drew Millas... with two outs and no one on in the 2nd, allowed a single to Mariel Bautista, a walk to Miguel Hernández and an RBI double to Jacob Hurtubise that scored a run, but retired the dangerous Brian Rey on a flyout to leave runners at second and third... pitched around a two-out Eric Yang single in the 3rd inning... with one out in the 4th, plunked Bautista and gave up a single to Hernández and a sac fly to Hurtubise, but again retired Rey on a flyout to end the inning... pitched around singles by Cotton and Quincy McAfee, stranding runners at the corners to end the 5th and final inning... Lugnuts went on to win in ten innings over the Dragons, 9-4.

2021 with the Lugnuts: Piggybacked in the second game of the season on Wednesday, May 5th vs Lake County, relieving southpaw Brady Basso in the fifth inning with Nuts trailing, 1-0... allowed unearned run in the 5th and earned run in the 6th before finding a groove and setting down seven of the last eight batters faced... final line: 4 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 4 K in Lugnuts' 3-1 loss.

Winter Ball: Made one relief appearance in 2019-2020 and two appearances in 2020-2021 for Toros del Este in the Dominican Winter League, totaling one unearned run allowed... Toros won the Dominican Winter League in 2019-2020.

2019: Made first appearance of the season on May 16th for High-A Stockton... assigned to Low-A Beloit on June 13th, debuting with six scoreless innings... made one start at Short-Season A Vermont, June 18th, working five innings, before returning to Beloit... came back to Stockton for one start, on August 3rd, and posted 5 2/3 scoreless innings, but was sent back to Beloit afterward to finish the season in the MWL... struck out 20 batters in a two-start Midwest League span (8/15 at Quad Cities: 9 K in 5 2/3 scoreless innings; 8/20 vs. Burlington: 11 K in 5 innings, allowing five unearned runs)... overall ERA for the season of 3.35 ranked second in the organization... opposing base stealers were successful in all seven attempts against him.

2018: Spent the entire season with SS-A Vermont (4.59 ERA, 14 G, 10 GS, 68 2/3 IP, 7 HR, 27 BB, 59 K, .247)... worked six innings on four occasions... in seven of last eight outings, allowed one run or fewer... limited left-handers to .171/.298/.305, while right-handers hit .297/.353/.462... opposing base stealers were successful in four out of five attempts.

2017: Excelled in the Dominican Summer League (2.53 ERA, 10 G, 6 GS, 42 2/3 IP, 1 HR, 10 BB, 47 K, .184 AVG), earning ticket on August 3rd to the AZL (2.38 ERA, 6 G, 2 GS, 22 2/3 IP, 1 HR, 2 BB, 23 K, .238 AVG)... tossed six no-hit innings in DSL, 7/22/17 vs. Astros... of 16 runs allowed in the DSL, eight came in one start; in seven starts, allowed one run or fewer... in post-season interview, Gil Patterson told Melissa Lockard (who currently covers the A's for The Athletic) that Kelly was "Unorthodox. He falls way off the rubber on each pitch. You don't teach that. He throws a change-up that people keep calling a curveball because it looks like a curveball. He has a fastball, curveball, change-up and split. And you know what I'm going to do with him? Leave him alone. I'm going to leave him alone because it works. When the time comes that it doesn't work as well, then we will try to address some things with the delivery, specifically with keeping the head online a little bit and finishing straight to homeplate for extension."
