FRES-NOTES

SERIES SPLIT IN SAN JOSE: The Fresno Grizzlies (29-21) were edged out by the San Jose Giants (29-21) 2-1 Sunday afternoon from Excite Ballpark. The Grizzlies settled for a series split with the Giants, suffering their first road loss on both Sundays (4-1) and day games (6-1). Fresno dropped to 22-7 when scoring first (15-4 on the road) and 20-13 against the California League North Division (16-5 away). The Grizzlies sit 65 games back of the Modesto Nuts with 15 contests left to play in the first half. The squads combined for three runs on 12 hits (all singles, no extro-base knocks) and five walks. Fresno clawed ahead 1-0 in the top of the second on a balk, inching across Jason Hinchman. It was the second straight game where the Grizzlies scored their first run on a balk (both in the 2nd inning and by the leadoff batter of that frame). San Jose took a 2-1 lead in the bottom of the third and never looked back. A pair of groundouts to second base added Ty Hanchey and Nadir Lewis, Fresno righty Jace Kaminska (3-2) agonized the setback after five solid innings of work. Kaminska allowed two runs (earned), on six singles and a career-high three wolks, while striking out five. Southpow Bryson Hammer entered for Kaminska in the sixth, picking up a double play and strikeout to stop the threat. Hammer faced and retired eight total batters, notching nine outs. His three shutout innings were the most by a Grizzlies' reliever on the season. Hammer punched out three batters as well in an unbelievable effort.

MODESTO MINI FACTS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Modesto Nuts (Seattle Mariners Single-A affiliate) start a six-game series tonight at John Thurman Field. This is the second of five regular season series between the clubs in 2024 and the first meeting in Modesto. The Nuts are 56-16 over their last 72 games dating back to August 20, 2023 (including playoffs). Last season, Modesto claimed the California League crown after a dominating 4-0 run through the playoffs. They won the second half by one game over Fresno to earn their way into the postseason. In four years, the Grizzlies are 45-42 against the Nuts over their 85 games played (4-2 Modesto in the 2024 season series) since the squads became a part of the same league for the first time since 1988. At that time, Modesto was affiliated with the Athletics and were named the A's, while the Grizzlies were known as the Fresno Suns, playing independently. Now, the Nuts are associated with the Seattle Mariners organization (affiliated with the Colorado Rockies prior to Mariners), while the Grizzlies are partnered with the Rockies. The two cities are 96 miles away from one another if you drive by car, following the CA 99 route. Fresno and Modesto are one hour and 32 minutes apart, if you drive non-stop. The halfway point between both cities is Planada, California.

PACHECO PITCHES: Tonight, the Grizzlies give the rock to LHP Albert Pacheco. Last year, Pacheco was assigned to Fresno from the ACL Rockies on June 7 and spent his entire season with the Grizzlies. Pacheco made 14 starts, going 7-4 with a 5.45 ERA. Over 72.2 innings, he struck out 69 batters. The 21-year-old signed as an international free agent by the Rockies in 2019.

JACE THE ACE: Grizzlies RHP Jace Kaminska currently leads the California League with a 1.96 ERA (2nd in Single-A). Kaminska had an unreal month of May, going 2-0 with a 1.16 ERA and 1.07 WHIP over four starts. In 23.1 innings, Kaminska allowed four runs (three earned), on 20 hits, five walks and 27 strikeouts. This included a 20 inning scoreless streak to start the month, spanning into his fourth start (May 5-26, 13 H, 4 BB, 22 K). In his first two outings of the month, Kaminska was the starter to a Grizzlies shutout win. He would then toss another quality outing in his third start of the month against Stockton.

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his new role as the team's leadoff hitter. Since Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 18 times in 36 plate appearances (eight games). In four of those eight games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score nine runs. This includes starting the game off 4-for-7 with a walk. All four hits have been singles with half of them as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped eight bases, picking up two of them in three of those games.

CLUTCH(INCHMAN): Grizzlies' OF/1B Jason Hinchman has provided the clutch hit in all three of Fresno's comeback claws wins in the seventh inning or later this season. Hinchman had a go-ahead two-RBI double in the 7th inning May 9 vs. Modesto, a walk-off two-run homer in the 9th inning May 26 vs. Visalia and a game-tying two-RBI single in the 9th frame May 30 at San Jose.

HILL HOMERS AGAIN: Grizzlies' OF/2B GJ Hill has homered four times over his last seven games (May 26-31), giving him a club-high five clouts. Hill went deep in three straight games from May 26-29. Before joining Fresno, Hill had 12 professional longballs (2019-22 in the Diamondbacks system).

TENA IS ON A TEAR: Grizzlies' OF Felix Tena is currently riding an 11-game hitting streak, the longest active streak on the team. He has powered one homer, one triple, one double, eight RBI and three runs in that span. Tena joins Andy Perez (18 games) as the only Grizzlies' batters this year to relish a double-digit hit streak.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez has had an outstanding season (48 games), going 52-for-189 (275 AVG/.320 OBP/.423 SLG/.743 OPS) with four homers (one grand slam), four triples, eight doubles, 29 RBI, 21 runs, 13 walks and two stolen bases. Perez had hit safely in his first 18 games and 23 of first 24 games to start the season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockies affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor League Boaseball at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.385 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Perez's triple on May 31 at San Jose was his 11th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him two triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kleschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

2023 (pro): Assigned to Fresno from ACL Rockies on June 7 and spent entire season with the Grizzlies...Made 14 starts, going 7-4 with a 5.45 ERA...Struck out 69 batters over 72.2 innings..Earned 1st Fresno win after quality start June 14 vs Inland Empire (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 1 BB, 6 K)...Tied career-high with 7 innings of 1-run ball June 21 at Modesto, allowed 4 hits and 1 walk while fanning 8...Struck out the side in his last frame of work...Tied career-high with 7 innings of 2-run ball August 26 vs Stockton, allowing 6 hits and no walks while fanning 8 (Earned the win).
