JUMBO SHRIMP STUMBLE IN 10-1 LOSS

Peyton Burdick homered on Thursday, but the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell 10-1 to the Charlotte Knights at Truist Field. The Knights built an advantage thanks to a five-run second, highlighted by a three-run double from Adam Haseley. After tacking on another run in the third, Haseley homered to start the fourth. Two batters later, Carlos Perez cracked a two-run shot to make it 9-0. A Yolbert Sanchez RBI single in the fifth put the margin at 10-0. Burdick's homer in the eighth was the lone source of offense for the Jumbo Shrimp.

SELF-STARTERS

Through the season's first 10 games, Jacksonville starting pitchers ceded at least four runs on six different outings, posting a collective 7.85 ERA in the process. Over the last 10 games, though, Jumbo Shrimp starters have yielded more than two earned runs in a start just twice. In total during this run, the Jumbo Shrimp starting rotation has surrendered just 19 runs, 15 earned, in 46.1 innings for a 2.91 ERA. During this 10-game run, the club's lid-lifters have registered 36 strikeouts (7.0 K/9) against 44 hits (8.5 H/9) and 18 walks (3.5 BB/9) allowed.

CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE

Charles Leblanc went 1-for-4 on Wednesday, continuing a fantastic start to 2022. The Laval, Quebic City native has already reached base multiple times in nine of his 17 games this year. On the season, Leblanc ranks second in the International League in batting average (.356), fifth in OPS (1.045), sixth in on-base percentage (.435), eighth in slugging percentage (.610), tied for 11th in home runs (4) and tied for 14th in hits (21).

MEN OF STEAL

Heading into play on April 17, Jacksonville had stolen just four bases, tied for the third-fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp swiped five bases in Durham that night, matching the franchise's most in any game since the Jacksonville Suns swiped six bases on April 10, 2016 against Birmingham. In the nine games from April 17 on, the Jumbo Shrimp have collected 15 stolen bases, tied for the second-most in Triple-A. Jacksonville has been caught only three times during this stretch, a success rate of 83.3 percent. THE WHOLE NINE WINS The Jumbo Shrimp have won nine of the past 11 games, outscoring their opponents during this stretch by a whopping 74-40 margin and compiling a 112-82 advantage in hits and 18-5 margin in home runs. Since this roll began on April 15, the Jumbo Shrimp are hitting .291/.397/.488/.865 as a team and rank sixth out of 120 Minor League Baseball teams in hits, tied for sixth in home runs and tied for seventh in runs. The club's 3.06 team ERA

during this span places 17th.

Over his last eight games, **Lorenzo Quintana** has gone 14-for-34 at the plate, slashing .412/.474/.882/1.356 with four doubles, four home runs, 13 RBIs and nine runs scored. This hot stretch has pushed Quintana up the International League leaderboards on the season; the native of Pinar del Rio in Cuba ranks in the top 15 of the league in home runs (T-5th; 5), slugging (5th; 656), RBIs (6th; 17), OPS (7th; 1.042), batting average (8th; .344), hits (T-9th; 22), extrabase hits (T-10th; 10) and runs scored (T-17th; 13). Of the 134 qualified hitters in the International League, Quintana has posted the 13th-lowest strikeout rate (12.9 percent) behind the 37th-lowest swinging-strike rate (9.6 percent). He places sixth in both wOBA (.445) and wRC+ (173).

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 28 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking in a tie for fourth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast in recent years; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

SHRIMP SPECKS

Jacksonville has scored at least six runs in eight of their last 12 games, and 10 of the club's 20 contests this year. In 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered at least six tallied in only 48 of their 130 games (36.9 percent)... Wednesday's loss was Jacksonville's biggest margin of defeat of the season.

ABOUT BRYAN										

-Originally selected by the New York Yankees in the 16th round of the 2009 draft, Mitchell bypassed on a commitment to play at the University of North Carolina to begin his professional career.

-Mitchell made his major league debut for the Yankees on August 10, 2014 by tossing 2.0 scoreless innings of relief against Cleveland at Yankee Stadium.

-The Yankees traded Mitchell along with infielder Chase Headley on December 12, 2017 to the San Diego Padres in exchange for outfielder Jabari Blash. The Padres designated Mitchell for assignment on March 28, 2019, and after spending the entirety of that season with Triple-A El Paso and the AZL Padres, he elected free agency on October 1, 2019.

-On January 16, 2020, Mitchell signed a minor league contract with the Chicago White Sox. He was part of their player pool at the team's Alternate Training Site before being released on August 24, 2020.

-After signing with the Marlins on July 28, Mitchell's first three appearances with Jacksonville were all hitless, spanning a total of 8.0 innings (0 R, 3 BB, 9 K)

-Mitchell had his contract selected by the Marlins on August 19 and made a pair of appearances for them before being designated for assignment on August 25 and then outrighted to Jacksonville on August 27.

2019 SEASON

-Of Mitchell's 11 starts with El Paso, only four went for at least 5.0 innings of work.

2018 SEASON

-After posting an 0-3 record and 7.08 ERA in 12 games, seven starts, before the All-Star Break with San Diego, Mitchell went 2-1 with a 2.19 ERA in four starts in the season's second-half with the Padres.

-In 11 starts with San Diego, Mitchell went 2-4 with a 4.61 ERA over 56.2 innings (60 H, 34 BB, 31 K). However, in five relief appearances with the Padres, the right-hander was 0-0 with an 8.27 ERA in 16.1 innings (25 H, 9 BB, 7 K).
