Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, open a six-game series at the Lake County Captains – the 253rd all-time meeting between Lansing and Lake County and the seventh meeting of the 2025 regular season. The Nuts and Caps split a six-game series in Lansing at the end of April and start of May. Lansing is coming off winning five of six games at home against South Bend.

Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 8, Cubs 4. Corey Avant fired four innings, Jake Garland tossed four, Tom Reisinger and Mark Adamiak combined on the ninth, and the Nuts easily defeated South Bend behind 13 hits and eight walks. T.J. Schofield-Sam went 3-for-4 with an HBP to increase his league-leading batting average to .352.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and Captains play through Sunday, then the Nuts return to Michigan's state capital to open a six-game series with the Beloit Sky Carp.

Prospecting: The Nuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 7 prospect (Tommy White), No. 10 (Joshua Kuroda-Grauer), No. 12 (Steven Echavarria), No. 17 (Ryan Lasko), No. 18 (Rodney Green, Jr.) and No. 28 (Nate Nankil).

League Overview: Both Lansing and West Michigan won on Sunday, so with 39 games played and 27 games remaining in the first half, the Lugnuts trail the Whitecaps for first place in the East Division by three games. The winners of the East and West Division in each of the 66-game halves clinch postseason berths.

Streaking: First baseman T.J. Schofield-Sam enters today on a 12-game hitting streak. Third baseman Tommy White returns from the Injured List with a 17-game hitting streak and 19-game on-base streak.

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank second in the Midwest League in batting average (.268), first in base hits (345), second in doubles (79), second in on-base percentage (.364) and are the toughest team to strike out (263).

In the Field: The Nuts are the second best defensive group in the league, posting a .980 fielding percentage with only 27 errors committed in 1,373 chances. Only West Michigan (26 errors, 1,410 chances, .982) ranks higher. Lansing committed only two errors in six games against South Bend after committing only two errors in the prior series at the Whitecaps.

On the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is first in the league in holds (19), first in fewest HBPs (13), first in fewest balks (3) and tied for second in fewest walks (140).

DK at the Helm: The 19th manager in Lugnuts history is Darryl Kennedy, entering his second year in the A's organization. Kennedy distinguished himself as a catcher at Manatee Community College before starring at the University of North Florida and was named an NCAA All-American in 1991 en route to North Florida's Hall of Fame, inducted in 2017. Kennedy played in the Minor Leagues for seven seasons, including parts of four seasons in Triple-A. Following his 1997 retirement, he immediately began managing, leading the Gulf Coast League Rangers to the 1998 GCL Championship. Kennedy won a second title with the GCL Rangers in 2000, moving on to stops in the Florida State League, Northwest League and Texas League through 2006. Upon joining the Royals' organization, Kennedy managed in the Appalachian League, Carolina League, Pioneer League, Arizona League and Texas League through 2020. He served as bench coach for the KBO's Hanwha Eagles from 2021 through 2023 before joining the A's.

## **History vs. Lake County**

The Nuts are 124-128 all-time vs. the Caps. 69-63 in Lansing and 55-65 in Ohio. The Captains won the 2024 MWL championship, but the Nuts went 12-6 vs. the Captains last year, 4-2 at home, 12-6 on the road.

#### May 20th in Lugnuts History

**2004:** With all eyes on him and a Thursday night crowd of 9,823 in attendance, rehabbing Mark Prior made his first appearance since the 2003 National League Championship Series, beginning his road back to the Majors. Prior faced the minimum in three innings, striking out five and issuing one walk – to Drew Macias, who was then caught stealing by catcher Jake Fox to end the second inning. The Lugnuts defeated the Fort Wayne Wizards, 2-1, on two runs in the bottom of the ninth. Brian Dopirak tied the game with a two-out RBI double. Three batters later, Fox drew a walk-off walk to bring in Dopirak. Future Major Leaguer Carlos Marmol picked up the win, allowing one run in six innings and striking out eight.

**2017:** The Lugnuts sent ten batters to the plate in a four-run first inning, knocking out South Bend starter Tyson Miller, but the Cubs responded with an 11-run third inning for an 11-7 rain-shortened six-inning victory at Four Winds Field. Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. went 3-for-3 with a walk and three RBIs (one for each hit) in the loss.

Last Time Out: Steven tossed a career high 5 1/3 innings with nine hits and one run allowed, walking none and striking out four in a no-decision vs. the Cubs; 81 pitches (52 strikes)... Nuts scored four in the 7th for a 4-1 win.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball - the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

Path to Lansing: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... vs. right-handers: .306/.387, 1 HR, 5 GiDP... vs. left-handers: .316/.431/.474, 3 HR, 1 GiDP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
