### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On May 19, 2017, Nashville shutout Sacramento 6-0 and allowed just three hits between starter Paul Blackburn and relievers Tucker Healy and Tyler Sturdevant. Both Renato Nunez and Ryan Lavarnway homered for the Sounds.

**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and Louisville Bats play game three of a six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. Nashville pulled ahead in the eighth inning for a 7-4 win last night. Right-hander Dylan File starts for Nashville tonight against right-hander Randy Wynne.

**Dylan File:** 25-year-old Dylan File makes his eighth start of the season tonight. The right-hander is 2-1 with a 4.45 ERA (32.1 IP/16 ER) this year. He last pitched on May 13 at Jacksonville and took his first loss of the season (5.0 IP, 7 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 3 BB, 7 K). A Phoenix, Ariz. resident, File went 2-4 with a 5.27 ERA (42.2 IP/25 ER) in nine starts for the Sounds last season. He also went 0-1 with a 7.20 ERA (5.0 IP/4 ER) in two starts for High-A Wisconsin. File entered the 2022 season as the No. 25 prospect in the Brewers organization according to MLB Pipeline. The Desert Hills (UT) High School product was drafted by the Brewers in the 21st Round of the 2017 MLB First Year Player Draft out of Dixie State University.

**Randy Wynne:** 29-year-old Randy Wynne starts for the Bats in game three of the series tonight. The right-hander is 1-5 with a 4.75 ERA (36.0 IP/19 ER) in 7 games (all starts). Wynne last pitched on May 13 against Toledo and took the loss (5.2 IP, 9 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 3 K). In 2021, he went 8-4 with a 4.94 ERA (89.1 IP/49 ER) for Double-A Chattanooga. Wynne was signed as a minor league free agent by Cincinnati in 2019. He pitched for Birmingham-Bloomfield in the United Shore League from 2016-17 and for Evansville in the Frontier League in 2018. Wynne attended Missouri Baptist University.

**2022 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 24, Second: 11, Third: 3, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Superlatives...**Last night the Sounds improved to 15-5 at home...19-8 vs. RH starters...23-0 when leading after 8...21-1 when scoring first...20-4 when scoring 4+ runs...18-7 when committing no errors.

**Chasing Larry Gilbert:** Manager Rick Sweet has 2,127 career wins as a minor league manager, just one shy of tying Larry Gilbert for seventh-most all-time. Gilbert amassed 821 wins as manager of the Nashville Vols from 1939-1948 and is the winningest manager in Nashville baseball history. Trent Jewett has the most managerial wins by a Sounds manager with 320. Gilbert led the Vols to eight playoff berths and four Southern League championships during his 10-year tenure as manager of the Vols.

**Awesome Andy:** Left-hander Andy Otero pitched 4.0 scoreless innings his season debut with the Sounds last night, allowing a hit and a walk. The 29-year-old has a career 2.94 ERA across 134 appearances (35 starts) in the minors.

**Walk the Line:** The Sounds have 41 walks over the last seven games. They are tied with Lehigh Valley with the most in the International League in that span.

**King David:** Outfielder David Dahl went 1-for-3 last night with a run and walk. Dahl is red-hot in the month of May, hitting .341 (14-for-41) with 10 runs, 4 doubles, 1 home run, 4 RBI and 5 walks in 11 games.

**There will be Math:** Infielder Mark Mathias has hit safely in six consecutive games, the second time this year he has hit safely in six games (also from April 15-24). During the six-game streak, Mathias is hitting .429 (9-for-21) with 3 runs, 1 home run, 4 RBI and 3 walks.

**Six Shooter:** The Sounds have won every series they have played this year. It's the first time since at least 1987 the team has won its first six series in a season (team records date back to 1988).

**Earn It:** Nashville's team ERA sits at 2.99 (325.0 IP/107 ER) after last night's win. The 2.99 ERA is the best mark across Triple-A Baseball, far ahead of Iowa with a 3.37 ERA.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.

**LAST OUTING:** File's last time pitching was on May 13 in a start at Jacksonville. He was tagged with his first loss of the season after he allowed four runs on seven hits. File matched a career-high with three walks and set a season-high with seven strikeouts. He threw 61 of his 92 pitches for strikes in the 7-3 loss.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** File is facing Louisville for the third time in his career. He faced the Bats in Kentucky on August 13, 2021 and allowed seven runs on 12 hits in 5.2 innings. He was tagged with another loss against Louisville on September 1, 2021 and he went 6.0 innings and allowed four runs (three earned) on seven hits.
