INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: With runners at the corners and one away in the bottom of the ninth inning, Carter Bins grounded a single into center field to give the Indianapolis Indians a 1-0 walk-off win over the St. Paul Saints at Victory Field on Wednesday. Indianapolis and St. Paul were locked in a pitchers' duel through the first eight innings. After Geronimo Franzua pitched around a leadoff walk in the top of the ninth, Indianapolis capitalized on a leadoff walk of its own that led to the winning run. Gilberto Celestino drew the base on balls and stole second base. Fishers, Ind. native Matt Gorski followed with a sharp grounder to first baseman Yunior Severino for an infield single, and Bins sent the first pitch he saw up the middle to give Indy its second straight win.

WALKED IT OFF: Last night's walk-off single by Carter Bins marked the team's first walk-off win since Nick Gonzales was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded on 8/24/23. It was also the seventh walk-off victory for Indy that ended 1-0 in Victory Field history and the first since Adam Fraizer delivered a game-winning single in the 12th inning on 5/3/16 vs. Durham. SILENCED THE SAINTS: Indians pitching dominated St. Paul last night, tossing the team's first shutout of the 2024 season. Cam Aldred got the start for Indy and tossed 4.0 innings with three hits, two walks and six strikeouts. Carmen Mlodzinski, Kyle Nicolas, Kyle Nicolas and Geronimo Franzua then combined for 5.0 hitless innings with three walks and five strikeouts to close the feat. In 2023, the Indians tossed seven shutouts – five in 9.0 innings – with one coming against St. Paul on 4/16. Indians pitching has fared well against the Saints in April of recent years, also tossing the team's first no-hitter since 2012 on 4/13/22.

GONZO STREAKING: Nick Gonzales doubled in his third at-bat last night to extend his league-leading on-base streak to a career-high 16 games dating back to Opening Day on 3/29. His current 16-gamer narrowly beats his previous career-high of 15 games from 4/9-30/22 with Double-A Altoona. The double also extended his hitting streak to nine games dating back to 4/6. Gonzales, who hit for the cycle at Victory Field on Sept. 19, 2023, vs. Rochester, also went 4-for-5 on Tuesday night and was a home run shy of becoming just the first batter in franchise history to accomplish the feat twice. Eight of his 16 games have featured multi-hit performances, and he currently leads IL leaders in hits (26), doubles (10) and extra-base hits (T-1st, 12), while also ranking in batting average (.3rd, .388), runs (3rd, 16) and total bases (T-4th, 41).

NICE, NICOLAS: Indians right-hander Kyle Nicolas tossed another scoreless frame last night, extending his scoreless streak to 4.1 innings across his last three appearances. He has been dominant against International League hitters this season logging a 1.04 ERA (1er/8.2ip), nine strikeouts, 1.04 WHIP and .074 batting average against in seven appearances.

NO DOUBTING THE DOUBLES: The Indians are currently tied with Omaha with 43 doubles, the most among all 30 Triple-A teams. Nick Gonzales, who has two more doubles than anyone else in the IL, is currently leading the pack. The Indians as a team are also hitting .279 (155-for-556), good for the second-best batting average in all of Triple-A behind Durham (.294, 180-for-613).

TONIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians will look to win their third-straight consecutive game in the third contest of a six-game series vs. the St. Paul Saints this week. It is their first of three of three head-to-head series this season, two of which come at Victory Field (also: 8/13-18). Last season, the Saints narrowly edged the Indians, 10 wins to eight, with four wins coming in six games in Indianapolis. Taking the mound for Indianapolis tonight is RHP Paul Skenes (0-0, 0.00), the No. 3 prospect in all of Minor League Baseball, for his fourth Triple-A start. Countering the hard-throwing right-hander is RHP Joe Gunkel (0-1, 7.27), who made his lone appearance vs. Indy in his Triple-A debut at Victory Field on 5/11/16 with Triple-A Norfolk.

SKKKKKKKENES: Right-handed pitcher Paul Skenes, who is rated as the No. 3 prospect in MiLB, No. 1 in the Pirates organization and No. 1 among right-handed pitchers (according to MLB Pipeline) punched out eight batters across 3.1 innings during his third career Triple-A start on Friday at Toledo. All eyes were on the 21-year-old, who has racked up 19 strikeouts in just 9.1 innings pitched this season. His 19 strikeouts are tied with Nashville's Tobias Myers and Syracuse's Christian Scott for 10th-most in the International League. Skenes pitched around a leadoff single in the first with two strikeouts, struck out three while issuing one walk in the second and recorded three more punchouts in the third – two on overturned challenge calls that were initially ruled balls – while scattering two singles. For the first time as an Indian, he pitched into the fourth inning and induced a groundout to the catcher before exiting at the 55-pitch mark. He touched triple digits 15 times, with his fastball topping out at a season-high 101.6 mph.

THIS DATE IN 1985: Indianapolis and Buffalo set an American Association record when they combined for 45 hits in a 10-inning contest at Bush Stadium. Gary, Ind. native and Indiana State graduate Wally Johnson had two hits and two runs scored, and Andres Galarraga collected four hits in six at-bats, but the Indians were handed a 15-9 defeat. Indy had 19 hits while Buffalo tallied 26.

TONIGHT'S STARTER

Paul Skenes: The hard-throwing right-hander Skenes will make his fourth Triple-A start and second at Victory Field tonight vs. St. Paul.

Last Outing: Skenes punched out a career-high eight batters while going into the fourth inning for the first time on 4/12 at Toledo.

Against the Saints: Skenes has never faced St. Paul.

Triple Digits: Skenes' fastball topped out at 101.6 mph during his last start on Friday at Toledo. In his Triple-A debut on 3/30 at Louisville, four of his five strikeouts coming on triple-digit four-seamers. The hardest-thrown fastball in Triple-A since velocity began being tracked in the minors in 2021 was 102.9 mph in 2023.

Prospectus: Enters the 2024 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 1 prospect by both *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline. ... Is rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 3 prospect in baseball and No. 9 by *Baseball America*. ... Is also rated as the No. 1 right-handed pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline. ... Was rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 1 prospect in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft and No. 2 by *Baseball America*. ... Was also rated first in "Best Fastball", "Best Breaking Ball" and "Best Athlete, third in "Best Control" and fifth in "Best Changeup" by *Baseball America* in the Class of 2023.

Geaux Tigers: Went 13-2 with five shutouts, two complete games, 1.69 ERA (23er/122.2ip), SEC-leading 209 strikeouts, 20 walks and a .165 batting average against in 19 starts, leading the LSU Tigers to an NCAA Championship in 2023. ... Was named the College World Series Most Outstanding Player after going 1-0 with a 1.15 ERA and 21 strikeouts in two starts. ... Took home D1Baseball Player of the Year honors and was the SEC Pitcher of the Year. ... Also was the Dick Howser Award (for the national college baseball player of the year) after finishing second in the nation in ERA, third in strikeout-to-walk ratio (10.45) and fifth in hits allowed per 9.0 innings (5.28).
