- Dunedin rallied for five eighth inning runs to come back from down three to win by two, 8-6 on Friday night at TD Ballpark.
- After allowing a first inning run, Jays starter Fernando Perez turned in four straight scoreless innings to hold the score at 1-0.
- Dunedin stranded four runners in scoring position in the first four innings, but eventually tied the game on Manuel Beltre's fifth inning RBI single.
- Jupiter chased Perez from the game in the sixth, taking a two run lead on John Cruz's RBI double and a wild pitch.
- Marcos De La Rosa blasted his first Single-A homer in the bottom of the sixth to re-tie the game.
- After Kai Peterson surrendered three runs in the top of the eighth, the offense backed him up by scoring five runs on three hits in the bottom half. Bryce Arnold tied the game on a two-RBI double, and Victor Arias delivered the lead on an RBI groundout.

THREE'S A STREAK

Last night's victory marked the Blue Jays' third straight - the team's first three game losing streak since the D-Jays won six in a row from April 6 through the 12th. A victory today would clinch a series win, the team's first since they took five of six from Tampa April 9th through the 14th.

LATE MAGIC

Dunedin continued its trend of scoring late runs last night with a five-run eighth inning rally. The Blue Jays have scored in the seventh inning or later in 10 straight games, and 14 of their last 15 games. The Blue Jays hold a +13 run differential in the final three innings this season (66 runs scored, 53 runs allowed).

JAYS JUICE

With Marcos De La Rosa's two-run home run last night, the Blue Jays have homered in six straight games - the team's longest homer streak of the season. Across that stretch, seven different players have gone deep. Dunedin is tied third in the Florida State League with 24 homers.

TWO STRIKE DAMAGE

Across the Blue Jays three-game win streak this week, the team has collected eight two-strike RBIs. Four of last night's eight runs were driven in with two strikes. Manuel Beltre's walk-off single on Thursday night came in a 2-2 count.

APONTE'S BIG WEEK

Yhoangel Aponte's eight hits in four games this week are the most in the Florida State League. His .500 average (8-16) and 1.329 OPS are the highest by a player in the circuit who has played all four games this week.

A CAVEMAN COULD DO IT

Nolan Perry is set to make his third start with the Blue Jays this evening. Perry was drafted out of Carlsbad HS (NM) in 2022 after winning New Mexico's Gatorade Player of the Year award and a state championship. Carlsbad's team mascot his the Cavemen.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

25 of the Blue Jays 37 games this season have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 10-15 record in those games.

HITS ON HITS ON HITS

The Blue Jays offense has tallied eight or more hits in five straight games. The streak is the first of its kind for Dunedin this season. This week, the team is hitting .307 (43-140) with an .849 OPS. In the first six games vs Jupiter, Dunedin hit to a .434 OPS.

STRONG FIRST IMPRESSION

Blue Jays outfielder Jean Joseph is off to a strong start in Single-A, having reached in all 16 games he's played with Dunedin. The on-base streak is Dunedin's longest streak of the season and one of four active on base streaks 16 games or longer in the league.

BACK IN A BIG WAY

After spending a month on the injured list with a shoulder injury, Blue Jays catcher Nic Deschamps went 2-3 with a homer, RBI triple and a walk in his first game since April 14 on Thursday. Deschamps has a hit in all five games he's played to open the season.
