JACKSONVILLE SUFFERS SIXTH STRAIGHT LOSS

Jacomb Amaya hit a two-run home run on Saturday, but Durham cruised to a 6-2 win over Jacksonville. The Bulls got on the board in the third thanks to a Vidal Bruian RBI ground out. They then broke things open in a five-run fourth inning. Niko Hulsizer smashed a grand slam and Brujan added an RBI double to make it 6-0. The Jumbo Shrimp's only offense came on Amaya's two-run home run in the sixth inning. Robert Garcia and Richard Rodriguez combined for 4.1 scoreless innings of relief, striking out six Bulls

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 22 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 23-for-74 (.311/.393/.622/1.015) at the plate with five doubles, six home runs, 12 RBIs, nine walks and 14 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1% of his plate appearances during the 2022 campaign. Allen has whiffed just 19.6% of the time this season. His .198 BABIP is the third-lowest of the 204 IL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023.

THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on Friday, Jacksonville outfielder Brian Miller has reached base in 20 of his last 22 games. During this stretch, the Durham, N.C., native is 27-for-76 (.355/.444/.487/.931) with six doubles, two triples, eight RBIs and nine runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 11.5 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 35.8 percent.

CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last eight contests, Jacksonville has blasted 13 long balls, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcherfriendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 13 home runs are tied for the fourth-most in Triple-A over the last seven games. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp's 62 homers rank 18th in Triple-A

BULL-Y PULPIT

Jacksonville has lost each of the first six games of their series with Durham, a set that has been totally dominated by the Bulls. Of the 100 half-innings thus far in this series, Jacksonville has led at the end of just one of them, with Durham holding the advantage at the conclusion of 65 halfinnings (34 have been tied). In all, the Bulls have outscored the Jumbo Shrimp 36-13. The series marks the first for Jacksonville suffering six losses since Montgomery swept a six-game series from June 28-July 3, 2018 at 121 Financial Ballpark. The Jumbo Shrimp are trying to avoid getting swept for the first time since Jackson took a rain-shortened three-game set from August 29-31, 2019. Jacksonville has not been broomed in a non-rain-shortened series since Mississippi took a five-game set from May 1-5, 2019.

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing in the middle part of April into May, From April 13-May 5. Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a strong 3.19 ERA. However, over their last 27 games, they've combined to surrender 103 runs, 100 earned, on 142 hits (12.4 H/9) in 103.1 innings for a 8.71 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters have walked 64 (5.8 BB/9) against only 75 strikeouts (6.5 K/9).

JACOB ARTIST

Jacksonville infielder Jacob Amaya came into play on May 1 with just one hit in his previous four games. His season batting line sat at .211/.284/.311/.595 with five extra-base hits. In the 24 games, since, the El Monte, Calif., native has taken his offensive game to a new level. Amaya is 31-for-87 during this stretch, slashing .356/.436/.644/1.080 with five doubles, one triple, six home runs, 18 RBIs, 12 walks and 18 runs scored. After posting a .122 ISO with Triple-A Oklahoma City in 2022, Amaya's ISO is .192 this year.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has lost 18 of their last 24 games, including six in a row, their longest skid since a six-gamer from July 3-9, 2021. The Jumbo Shrimp last lost seven straight during an eight-game skid from April 29-May 7, 2019... Trevor Rogers will continue a rehab assignment by starting Sunday. He fanned seven in 4.0 scoreless innings on May 30 for Jupiter.
