YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Reading Fightin Phils, 5-2. **Frankie Tostado** hit a grand slam in the third to move Richmond in front, 4-0. **Ryan Murphy**, making his home debut, worked five hitless innings without allowing a run but tied a career high with five walks for the second straight start. Reading broke the shutout in the seventh with an RBI double by Jonathan Guzman. **Mike Gigliotti** gave Richmond a 5-1 lead in the bottom of the seventh with an RBI double. In the eighth, Kevin Vicuna worked a bases-loaded walk to plate a run but **Ryan Walker** picked up the final out of the inning to limit the damage. **Cole Waites** worked a scoreless ninth to pick up his second Double-A save.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series is the only match-up of the season between the two teams. Last year, the Flying Squirrels went 8-4 against the Fightin Phils, including a 3-3 mark at The Diamond.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 3-5 to open the second half, including dropping five-of-six last week at Bowie, but have won three-of-the-last-four games. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost four and split two this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 861 strikeouts and rank second with 101 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 24-14 at home this year. Richmond is 19-11 in games decided by two-or-less runs.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS went 29-40 in the first half, finishing in fifth place in the Northeast Division and ninth overall in the Eastern League. In their first series of the second half, they went 4-2 at home against first-half Northeast Division-champion Somerset in last week's series. Reading's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects, including C Logan O'Hoppe (3), OF Johan Rojas (4), RHP Griff McGarry (8), RHP Francisco Morales (9), OF Jhailyn Ortiz (11), OF Simon Muzziotti (19) and RHP McKinley Moore (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his team-leading 16th start of the season. Last time out, he allowed three runs over 5.2 innings with seven strikeouts in a loss against the Baysox on Friday night at Prince George's Stadium. Over his last seven starts, Teng has gone 3-2 with a 3.75 ERA (15 ER/36.0 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 21 walks. Teng spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

FOR READING: Left-hander Ethan Lindow makes his sixth Double-A start. Last time out, he worked six innings last Thursday against Somerset and allowed one run in a no-decision. Over his last three starts, Lindow has gone 1-1 with a 2.25 ERA (4 ER/16.0 IP). Lindow started the season with High-A Jersey Shore, going 2-0 with a 1.33 ERA in eight relief outings before being promoted to Double-A on June 14. He was selected in the fifth round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Phillies out of Locust Grove High School in California. He made his Double-A debut last season with Reading.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,271) and total attendance (232,018). Richmond is 11th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 101 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League with Somerset (105). **Sean Roby** is second in the league with 21 homers on the season, with 16 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 181 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in 2010 (71), 2011 (83) 2012 (76), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83), 2017 (93) and 2019 (84).

GO, DIEGO, GO! After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .411 (30-for-73) with four doubles, five homers and 18 RBIs over his last 19 games since June 7. On June 12 against the SeaWolves, he picked up his first three-hit game of the year, capped with a walk-off single, his second walk-off winning with the Flying Squirrels. He has homered in four of his last 11 games played. In last week's series at Bowie, Rincones hit .600 (12-for-20) with a homer and two RBIs and struck out twice. He picked up a season-high four hits last Tuesday in the series opener at Bowie.

SHANE TRAIN: From May 1-June 30, **Shane Matheny** hit .315 (39-for-124) with eight homers, five doubles, a triple and 24 RBIs in 38 games. Over his last four games since July 1, Matheny is batting .083 (1-for-12) with a double and two RBIs, but has walked four times. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season at the time. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season. In the Eastern League this season, Matheny is ranked eighth in batting average (.285), third in OBP (.420) and sixth in OPS (.914).

TOASTY: Over his last four games since July 1, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .375 (6-for-16) with a homer, a double and six RBIs. On Wednesday, he hit the first grand slam of his professional career in a win over Reading. He hit .175 (10-for-57) over a 16-game stretch from June 9-29. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked fifth in batting average (.296), second in hits (77) and seventh in total bases (127).

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on Monday night against the Fightin Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. Roby is second in the EL in home runs this year, trailing Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 17 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duval** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked fifth in batting average (.296), second in hits (77) and seventh in total bases (127). **Sean Roby** is second in homers (21). **Shane Matheny** is eighth in batting average (.285), third in OBP (.420) and sixth in OPS (.914). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for fourth in stolen bases (19). **Ryan Walker** is tied for first in wins (6). **Chris Wright** is tied for fifth in saves (6). **Matt Frisbee** is tied for first in complete games (1).

WHERE THE FIGHTIN PHILS RANK: In the Eastern League, Logan O'Hoppe is tied for eighth in homers (14), seventh in SLG (.524), seventh in OPS (.905) and tied for 10th in runs (42). Josh Ockimey is sixth in OBP (.407) and first in walks (56). Vito Friscia is seventh in OBP (.399) and third in walks (51). Jonathan Guzman and Kevin Vicuna are tied for third in triples (4). Brian Marconi is third in games pitched (28) and tied for first in saves (10). McKinley Moore is fourth in games pitched (27). Bobby Rossman and Matt Seelinger are tied for fifth in games pitched (26).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (10), **Ricardo Genoves** (24) and **Chris Wright** (27). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (1), **Brett Auerbach** (27), Genoves (29) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.

LOOKING AT THE FUTURE: On Wednesday, it was announced by Major League Baseball that LHP **Kyle Harrison** will participate in the 2022 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles on Saturday, July 16. Harrison, currently rated by MLB.com as the San Francisco Giants' No. 2 prospect and the No. 27 overall prospect in baseball, will represent the Giants in the annual prospect showcase as part of MLB's All-Star festivities. The 2022 Futures Game features the top Minor League prospects competing as part of the first-ever All-Star Saturday. It will once again feature a National League vs. American League format, which was introduced in 2019 following 20 years of U.S. vs. World matchups. The game, which is scheduled for seven innings, will begin at 7 p.m. ET/4 PT exclusively on Peacock and SiriusXM.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: On Monday, **David Villar** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants against the Diamondbacks in Phoenix. In that game, he went 2-for-4 with a double and an RBI. Villar spent last season with the Flying Squirrels and broke the franchise's single-season record with 20 home runs on the year, batting .275 with 58 RBIs in 106 games. He started this year with Triple-A Sacramento and is leading the Pacific Coast League with 21 homers over 66 games. Villar was also selected for the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, but is currently ineligible for the game while he is active on the Giants' MLB roster.
