Welcome Back

Tonight, Reading resumes play after the All-Star Break as Portland comes to town. It will be the third series of the season between the teams and second in the last four weeks. The season series is tied 6-6 after Reading won four-of-six in Portland the last week of June.

Sunday Suspension

Reading and Somerset's matchup last Sunday was suspended due to rain and will be resumed on Tuesday, August 15, in Reading. Overall, Reading won four-of five at the Patriots for the R-Phils third series win of the season. In Sunday's game, Reading trailed 4-0 going into the sixth, but scored a run in the sixth and three in the seventh to tie the game. Casey Martin had three hits for the R-Phils and Carlos De La Cruz drove in two runs.

Relievers Rolling

Reading's bullpen turned in perhaps its best series of the season last week. Over the six games at Somerset, R-Phils relievers combined to allow four-earned runs across 26.2 innings, which is good for a 1.35 ERA. The bullpen added Phillies No. 21 Prospect Orion Kerkering, in addition to Dominic Pipkin and Zach Haake last week. Additionally, Phillies Minor League Pitcher of the Month Carlos Francisco has been stellar in relief.

Double Trouble

In their series at Somerset, the Fightin Phils turned eight double plays over six games. That mark lead the Eastern League from July 4-9. Overall this season, the R-Phils rank tenth in the league in double plays turned with 54 (0.7 per game). When factoring out last week, Reading was 11th in double plays turned, so a strong week in the field helps the R-Phils climb up the league's double play rankings.

Looking For Some Home Cooking

Reading has been vastly better on the road this season, then compared to at home. The R-Phils road winning percentage is .500 and it's just .341 at home. Reading is scoring over half a run more per game on the road and also has 22 more stolen bases in road contests. On the mound, Reading's team ERA is 5.55 at home and 4.45 on the road. Additionally, the R-Phils have allowed 70 home runs when at home, compared to just 42 on the road.

Hey Now You're an All Star

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Mick Abel got the start for the NL in Saturday night's All-Star Futures Game in Seattle. Abel pitched one inning, allowing one hit, no runs and striking out two.

Around the Organization

The Phillies return from the All-Star Break with a three-game series this weekend against the San Diego Padres. Lehigh Valley opens up a three-game set at home tonight against Charlotte. Jersey Shore is on the road at Rome for a series starting tonight. Finally, Clearwater hits the road at Fort Myers for a series out of the break.

Portland enters tonight with the best record in the Eatsern League in the second half at 10-2. The Sea Dogs fell just short of Somerset in the race for the First Half Northeast Title. Overall, Somerset enters tonight with a 50-31 record, which is the best in all the Eastern League. Prior to the break, Portland hosted Binghamton and took five-of-six, including the last four, from the Rumble Ponies. After this week, Portland hosts New Hampshire.

Sterling Sharp gets the start tonight for Portland. Overall, Sharp has ten starts with a 2-1 record and 4.59 ERA. Over 49 innings, he's allowed 52 hits, issued 18 walks and has 32 strikeouts. He last pitched on July 5 against Binghamton, going 4.1 innings in a loss. Sharp allowed 11 hits and seven-eanred runs, with four strikeouts. This is Sharp's third start against Reading this year, and first since Apr. 23. In two starts against the R-Phils in April, Sharp was 1-0 and allowed one-earned run over 12 innings of work. Sharp was on the injured list three times this season, from May 10-19, May 20-June 1 and most recently, from June 18-July 5. He signed with the Red Sox as a free agent last offseason after spenging 2022 with Boston.
