RIDERS SPLIT SERIES WITH AMARILLO:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Midland RockHounds 7-3 on Tuesday afternoon from Riders Field. Frisco (24-15) started the scoring in the bottom of the second inning when **Cody Freeman** doubled and later scored on a groundout by **Abimelec Ortiz** against Midland (26-14) starter James Gonzalez (2-0). **Josh Stephan** (0-2) faced the minimum through the first two innings, but ran into trouble in the top of the third inning. Cooper Bowman delivered an RBI single to tie the game at 1-1 before a two-run single by Jack Winkler gave the RockHounds a 3-1 advantage. Colby Thomas capped off the five-run inning with a two-run homer, his 11th of the season. The five-run thief frame provided all of the scoring against Stephan who surrendered six hits and a walk while fanning six across 6.0 innings. In the bottom of the fifth inning, **Kellen Strahm** roped an RBI single to center that scored **Frainer Chavez** to cut the deficit to 5-2. Midland used a two-run homer in the top of the eighth inning by Shane McGuire to push their lead to five runs. In the home half of the eighth, Frisco got a run back when **Liam Hicks** scored on a sacrifice fly from Josh Hatcher, marking his team-leading 26th RBI of the season. Offensively, Freeman and **Keyber Rodriguez** notched three-hit affairs. Hicks extended his hitting streak to seven games while Strahm reached for a 25th straight game.

POWER OUTAGE:

Over their last 15 games, the RoughRiders have hit just nine home runs, which is the second-worst in the Texas League during that span. Frisco has hit 28 doubles during that stretch, good for fourth in the league, giving them a .398 SLG as a team (also 4th in the league). Along with the lack of power, they are also striking out fewer times than anyone else in the league (6.6 K/G as a team over the last 15 games) and hitting .269, which is second in the league. **Cody Freeman** (two) is the only Riders player with multiple home runs over the last 15 games.

MORE THAN O-KAY(ber):

Keyber Rodriguez has been tearing up the baseball over the last week. In his last seven games, Rodriguez is hitting .536 (15-for-28) with six multi-hit games during that span, including five doubles, a triple, a home run, six RBIs, a walk, five runs scored and a steal. The infielder raised his batting average from .087 to .333 and OPS from .371 to .963 over the last week.

TIMING MATTERS:

While the RoughRiders are fourth in the league in batting average (.250), they are second in the Texas League in average with runners in scoring position (.281). They also have the fewest left on base in the Texas League (235, 6.0 per game). **Josh Hatcher** is seventh in the league with a .366 batting average with RISP while **Cody Freeman** is eighth (.361) and **Maximo Acosta**, **Kellen Strahm** and **Aaron Zavala** are tied for 12th (.324).

MAY FLOWERS:

The RoughRiders are 11-6 in the month of May, the best record in the Texas League. Frisco has the best overall ERA in the month (3.61) while they have a 2.55 bullpen ERA in the month. Out of their 11 wins in the month, the Riders have recorded a league-best seven saves. On the offensive side, they are tied for first in the league with 27 steals and first in fewest strikeouts (113, 6.6 per game), but are sixth in OPS (.710) and tied for eighth with just 11 home runs.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has the longest on-base streak this season for the RoughRiders, currently at 25 games. During the streak, he hit .313 (30-for-96)/.396/.417/.813 with two doubles, a triple, two home runs, nine RBIs, 14 walks, six steals and 23 runs scored. The streak is the third-longest active streak in the Texas League. In his career, Strahm has the second-longest on-base steak in RoughRiders franchise history (37 games in 2022). His 160 career walks with the RoughRiders are the second-most in franchise history, trailing only **Guilder Rodriguez**, who walked 206 times over seven seasons from 2009 to 2015.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Part of the RoughRiders' dominance on the mound has been the Frisco bullpen. Over the last 18 games, the bullpen has allowed just 17 earned runs over 63.1 innings (2.42 ERA). On the season, the bullpen is second in the Texas League with a 3.60 ERA.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman had a monster game on April 25th against Amarillo, going 5-for-5 with two home runs and a double. It was the first five-hit game in Freeman's Minor League career and the first one for the Riders since **Blaine Crim** accomplished the feat on September 2nd, 2022 at Amarillo. In his last 22 games, he has batted .353/.378/.635/1.013 with all five of his homers. This season, he has the seventh-lowest strikeout rate in the Texas League (13.3%) and has just whiffed five times in 15 games and 58 at-bats in May.

THE HATCHER HAMMER:

In an incredible win on April 27th, **Josh Hatcher** hammered a three-run, walk-off home run for a 4-3 win over Amarillo. Hatcher's caper was his third home run in as many games. He is slashing .333/.372/.505/.877. Hatcher is second in the league in batting average (.333), sixth in RBIs (26) and ninth in OPS (.877). Hatcher was named the Rangers Minor League Player of the Month for April. He slashed .373/.403/.576/.979 over 15 games for Frisco in April with three doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 11 runs and three steals. He finished third in the Texas League in batting average (.373), tied for eighth in RBIs (16), sixth in slugging (.576) and sixth in OPS (.979).

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Threw 5.2 scoreless at CC on 4/30. Over four starts at Whataburger Field, Garcia has allowed just three runs over 20.2 IP (1.31 ERA).

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.

ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John" ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22

2021 SEASON

-Pitching mainly in an extended relief role, he combined to go 3-1, 3.70 (23 ER/56.0 IP) in 20 G/4 GS for Down East (A) and Hickory (A+), averaging 10.0 strikeouts per 9 innings.

-Began season with Down East and was promoted to Hickory on 7/7.

2019 SEASON

-Saw minimal pro action after being drafted. Posted a 9.9 SO/9 figure over 7 G for Spokane (A) and AZL Rangers (Rk.).
