JUMBO SHRIMP SLUG WAY TO 11-5 WIN

Lewin Díaz and Jesús Sánchez each homered Tuesday to help the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp beat the Norfolk Tides 11-5 on Opening Day Tuesday in front of a sellout crowd at 121 Financial Ballpark. Díaz bashed a two-run shot in the first inning to give Jacksonville an early lead. The Jumbo Shrimp tacked on five runs in the second for a massive seven-run advantage. After the Tides plated two in the third, the game remained 7-2 until the seventh, when Seth Mejias-Brean went yard for Norfolk. However, Sánchez's three-run bomb highlighted a four-run eighth to put Jacksonville ahead 11-3. Norfolk added two runs in the ninth, but could get no closer in the Jumbo Shrimp's 11-5 win. The 11 runs Jacksonville scored are its most on Opening Day in the Jumbo Shrimp era.

CHICKS DIG THE LONG BALL

Just two batters into Tuesday's season opener against Norfolk, Lewin Díaz homered to give the Jumbo Shrimp a 2-0 lead. In the bottom of the eighth inning, Jesús Sánchez's laser shot gave Jacksonville 11 runs - the most on any Opening Day in the Jumbo Shrimp era (2017-present). During Jacksonville's 2019 season, an offensive outburst of this nature was a rarity; the Jumbo Shrimp scored at least 11 runs just four times in 137 contests, hitting that mark just once in the campaign's first 84 games. Meanwhile, the two home runs Jacksonville launched on Tuesday equaled their season-high from the 2019 season. All nine Jumbo Shrimp position players reached base at least once in Tuesday's season opener.

MEET THE SHRIMP

The Jumbo Shrimp's 2021 Opening Day roster features an eclectic mix of talented prospects, players who possess major league experience and familiar faces for fans in Northeast Florida. Lewin Díaz (No. 5), Jesús Sánchez (No. 6) and Braxton Garrett (No. 7) represent three of the Miami Marlins' top seven prospects according to MLB Pipeline. Jacksonville also has nine different players on its Opening Day roster with major league experience. There are also nine players who have previously logged time in Jacksonville when the club was Miami's Double-A affiliate. Jacksonville and the Marlins boast a long-standing affiliation that dates back to the 2009 season.

PEDRIQUE TO MANAGE JUMBO SHRIMP IN 2021

Boasting 13 years of minor league managing experience and seven seasons on a major league coaching staff, Al Pedrique will manage the Jumbo Shrimp in 2021. Pedrique enters his first year with the Marlins' organization after spending the previous three years on the Oakland A's major league staff as first base coach (2018) and third base coach (2019-20). His major league coaching experience includes a stint in 2004 with the Arizona Diamondbacks as third base coach and interim manager. Pedrique was also the third base coach for Houston in 2009 before serving as the Astros' bench coach from 2010-11. In addition to his wealth of MLB coaching experience, Pedrique has managed 13 seasons in the minor leagues in the Royals, Diamondbacks and Yankees' organizations.

AN ERA OF UNMATCHED SUCCESS

Jacksonville fielded a Double-A club in the Southern League from 1970-2019, an era of virtually unequalled success in the city's history. During their 50 seasons in the Southern League, Jacksonville made 20 playoff appearances, winning 13 Division Series', both Southern League records. Jacksonville also won six championships, finishing as the runner-up a league-best eight times. The city's clubs played in a Southern League-record 122 playoff games during this span, compiling a 64-58 (.525) record in the Southern League postseason.

CHARLOTTE'S (AND NORFOLK/DURHAM'S) WEB

Jacksonville's first foray into Triple-A since 1968 will see the club play only within the Southeast Division in the Triple-A East League. Tuesday's season-opener with the Tides marked the first of 36 contests against Norfolk. The Jumbo Shrimp will also play Durham 36 times and Charlotte 30 times during the 2021 campaign. Thus, an extraordinary 102 of the 120 games (85 percent) the Jumbo Shrimp will play this season come against the Triple-A affiliates of the Orioles, Rays and White Sox, respectively.

ABOUT SHAWN

-A 19th-round pick by Cleveland in the 2011 draft out of Ocean Lakes High School (Virginia Beach, Va.), Morimando was ranked as the organization's 12th-ranked prospect in 2016 and 16th-best prospect in 2017.

-Morimando made his major league debut for Cleveland on July 2, 2016. However, that debut almost did not happen. Cleveland was playing in Toronto when it decided to call-up Morimando, who was playing with Triple-A Columbus on a road trip to Pawtucket, R.I. Morimando's passport was actually in Akron, Ohio, where Cleveland's Double-A affiliate is located (the left-hander had recently been promoted from the RubberDucks). An intern in Cleveland's front office drove from Cleveland to Akron, where he met the RubberDucks' clubhouse manager, who found Morimando's apartment keys in his locker and hunted down the missing passport. The intern then drove back to Cleveland, where he met Morimando at an airport hotel following the pitcher's flight from Rhode Island. Morimando caught a 6:30 a.m. ET flight to Toronto on the morning of July 2 to make it in time for the game to make his MLB debut.

-Cleveland released Morimando in 2018, and after clearing waivers, the southpaw signed with the Toronto Blue Jays. He pitched for Triple-A Buffalo (as well as the Rookie-level GCL Blue Jays in 2018) in 2018 and 2019, but following an injury, opted for free agency following the 2019 season. Morimando spent the 2020 season pitching for Canberra in the Australian Baseball League, posting a 3-3 record and 2.57 ERA in eight games, including six starts (42.0 IP, 33 H, 10 BB, 47 K). He signed with the Marlins in February 2021.

-Morimando was hit hard in April, recording a 12.56 ERA without making it through five innings in a single start. However, for the rest of the season, he registered a 4.34 ERA.
