### Today's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Kolby Allard** to the mound today, with RHP **Trenton Denholm** slated to follow (3-0 in games Denholm piggybacks). Toledo will counter with a cavalcade of relievers. Columbus is 22-12 (.647) versus right handers this year, while going 4-13 (.235) against left-handed starters (Toledo has a pair of lefties in the bullpen, so hopefully neither of them begin the game).

### vs. the Mud Hens

Columbus was 10-11 opposing Toledo last year (have not won a season series since going 11-10 in 2022), including a 4-5 mark in Columbus (lost each of last 4G). Individually, **Bo Naylor** has hit .308 (16x52, 1HR and 9RBI) in 14G against Toledo in his career and **Kahlil Watson** has hit .293 (12x41, 1HR and 7RBI) in 12G, while **Juan Brito** has 4HR and 19RBI in 29G.

### Crazy Eighthths

Columbus had an 8th inning scoring streak snapped at 7G on 5/12, but has scored in 11 of the last 15G (also scored in six of nine last 9ths). On the year, the Clippers have 85 runs from the 8th inning on (13 more than 2nd place), crafting a collective .972OPS (+109 points on 2nd). In the 8th alone, Columbus has 22 runs in the last 15G (more than nine teams have all season, including Toledo).

### Controlling the Zone

**Cooper Ingle** had a 7G hit streak snapped on Saturday (.385, 10x26 from 5/13-5/23), but his exceptional pitch recognition has returned with 7BB and 3K in his last 7G (32PA; had 3BB and 12K over 37PA of 9G prior). Still, his 0x3 (BB) effort on Monday dropped his OBP to .504 (lowest since .500 on 4/1). He is the only batter in pro baseball with at least 100PA and an OBP over .500.

### Juan Gone

**Juan Brito** is hitless in his last 4G (15AB), batting just .163 (7x43) in 11G since a 9G hit streak to begin May (.316, 12x38 with 4HR and 13RBI). He owns just a pair of XBH on the cold spell, but has been putting the bat on the ball (3K in last 36PA). He has struggled from the left side of the plate all season (.209/.330/.308), continuing a Triple-A trend (.237/.354/.406 in career; .288/.406/.482 at lower levels).

### Misleading Streaks

**Nolan Jones** has reached base in 17 consecutive games, posting a .342OBP since 5/3, but has seen his OBP drop 18 points over the course of the streak, while his batting average has dipped 25 points (.213, 13x61). **George Valera** owns a 14G on base streak since 5/5, but has recorded only a .361OBP on the streak (+42 points on his season line), while hitting .235 (12x51; lost 10 points on average).

### Adjusting Fine

**Ralph Velazquez** was 2x3 with a double on Monday, his third double since joining the Clippers last week and his 12th between Akron and Columbus (.562SLG among both levels). Velazquez is still looking for his first RBI in Triple-A (0x3 with runners in scoring position), after driving in 19 in his last 19G with Akron. He is the fourth youngest player in the IL this year and will turn 21 tomorrow.

### Nayled It

**Bo Naylor** is returning to the Clipper lineup for the first time since 2023. Naylor amassed 126G in a Columbus uniform from 2022-23, clobbering 28HR to go with 95RBI (.255/.379/.506). While splitting those games in half between home and road, Naylor thrived outside of Huntington Park, boasting 35XBH in 244AB (.533SLG), including all of his triples (3; 22XBH in 218AB in Columbus, .477SLG).

### Hot Huff

**Kody Huff** rebounded from a pair of hitless games to end April with hits in each of his first 12G this month (.476, 20x42, 14RBI). The hit streak, from 5/1-5/16, set a new career best, topping his streak in the first 10G of April, 4/1-4/12 (.316, 12x38; hit .220, 11x50, in last 13G of April). Huff is 3x14 (.214) in 5G since the streak ended, but has driven in a pair and scored thrice (12RBI, 14 runs from career highs).

### Back on Track

In the last 13G, the Columbus bullpen has cobbled together a 3.04ERA (47.1IP, 16ER), the 3rd best mark in the IL (3ER or fewer in all 13G, longest streak of the year). Clipper relievers had allowed 21ER in 10.1IP of the 2G prior to the hot streak, as the relief ERA rose to 6.08 (worst in the IL; currently at 5.42, 18th). They have allowed 3HR to 213BF in the last 13G (17HR to 775BF prior, 45.6PA/HR).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

Wednesday, May 27

## This Date in Clipper History

5/27/2017

The Clippers topped the Norfolk Tides 8-5 at Huntington Park, led by **Eric Stamets'** 3x3 day (pair of doubles, HR and 3RBI). Clinging to a 4-2 lead in the 6th, **Nellie Rodriguez** blew the game open with a grand slam, immediately after an intentional walk to **Erik Kratz**. For Rodriguez, the HR and RBI were his first since 4/9, ending a drought that lasted 31 games (hit .083, 9x109, with 56K, 72LOB between homers).

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,429 to 1,376).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 71-70 (.504) in pitch reviews, with batters going 42-46 (.477) and pitchers/catchers going 29-24 (.547). They have run out of challenges in 29G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 833, would rank as 4th most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

## On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 68 through the first 51G (on pace for 199SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 18CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing (53) for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (nabbed 79 times in 2008, last time over 51).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,928RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.49 through the first 51G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 150HR (lowest total since 133HR in 2018; averaging 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 14th in the IL this year (.977), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 26G this season (15-11, .577), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

**Kody Huff** bunted a run in, while simultaneously moving another to scoring position in a 5/24 win vs. Louisville. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 87-23 (.791) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 4-2 mark this season (.667, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (-17th, .439).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 412-431 (.489), 382-385 with Columbus (.498).

### In the Majors:

Allard did not make Cleveland's opening day roster, but had his contract purchased on 3/30 to pitch out of the Guardian bullpen. He made four appearances for Cleveland over a couple weeks, giving up at least 1ER every time out, including multiples in each of his last 3G (6.0IP, 9ER). Following a 69-pitch outing at Atlanta on 4/12 (3.0IP, 5ER), Allard was DFA'd on 4/13 and outrighted to Columbus on 4/16.

### Bumpy Beginning:

Following his assignment, Allard appeared once out of the Columbus bullpen (3ER in 1.0IP vs. Iowa on 4/19) before going on the shelf with a sore right hip (4/22-5/6). Upon activation, he allowed 2ER in each of his first 2G back (4.1IP), averaging 48 pitches per outing. Allard was moved into the rotation beginning on 5/20 vs. Louisville, working a scoreless start (4.0IP) on only 37 pitches (0BB; issued 7BB to 24BF in 3G of relief).
