LAST TIME OUT: Mace started last Sunday afternoon against the Lansing Lugnuts. He didn't reach the second inning after allowing three runs, two earned on three hits.

IN THE SWAMP: The Florida native pitched four seasons at the University of Florida. Primarily a starter, Mace earned 258 strikeouts in 269.2 innings and a 4.37 ERA. He finished with a 22-7 record.

COMMUNITY SERVICE: Mace was on the SEC Community Service Team in the 2021 and 2020 seasons. The honor goes to players in recognition of their off the field volunteering and community service activities.

WANNA HAVE A CATCH?: As a freshman at Florida, Mace became "catch" partners with Brady Singer, who is currently in his third year as a member of the Kansas City Royals and was their first round draft pick in 2018. Both treated "catch" very seriously, using it as a time to work on their craft. They first became friends after finding out they had a shared interest in golf and became partners there too.

TRUST: Mace was first drafted back in 2017, by the Cincinnati Reds in Round 12. He elected to attend Florida instead and told the Perfect Game Amateur Hour podcast he trusted himself and "wanted to get what he was worth"

GROWTH SPURT: The 6'6 pitcher shot up to that height during his senior year at Sunlake High School near Tampa. During that season, Mace had a 1.29 ERA in 70.2 innings pitched and led the Seahawks to the FHSAA 7A Regional Finals.
