- After scoring just one run on Tuesday, the Sky Carp bats came to life for an 8-5 win over Lake County on Wednesday afternoon at Classic Park.
- All but one Beloit hitter collected a base hit, and six players collected two as the Carp notched 14 hits.
- Beloit struck first on a bases loaded walk from Josh Zamora in the first, chasing Captains starter Steve Hajjar after just two thirds of an inning.
- Cam Barstad made it 2-0 with a third inning RBI single, and Beloit doubled the lead with Torin Montgomery and Jorge Caballero RBI knocks in the 4th inning.
- On the pitching side, lke Buxton retired the first 10 batters he faced in his High-A debut before allowing a solo homer to Milan Tolentino in the bottom of the 4th inning.
- Ynmanol Marinez belted his own homer in the fifth a 2-run shot to make it 6-1.
- After retiring the first two batters in the bottom of the sixth, Buxton allowed the next three batters to reach and was removed following an RBI single from Joe Lampe. Yeuris Jimenez came on and issued two bases loaded walks to trim the lead to 6-4, but Tyler Eckberg entered and stranded the bases loaded.
- Beloit got insurance on a Tanner Allen 2-RBI double in the seventh to make it 8-4. Jake Fox responded with a solo homer for LC in the bottom half, but Caleb Wurster turned in scoreless innings in the eighth and ninth for a 2-inning save.

WE'RE A SECOND HALF TEAM

Beloit's .275 batting average in the second half is tops in the Midwest League, 15 points higher than the next closest team (Lansing, .260). Their .772 OPS ranks 3rd. Through 25 games, the team is averaging 5.8 runs per game and 10.1 hits per game. In the first half, the Sky Carp averaged 4 runs and 7.4 hits per game.

EARLY BIRDS GOT THE WORM

By scoring a run in the top of the first inning yesterday, the Sky Carp scored first for just the second time in their last 11 games. Beloit has allowed their opponent to score first in 55 of the team's 91 games.

STAYING UP LATE

In each of Beloit's last 13 wins, the team has scored at least one run in the seventh inning or later. Tanner Allen's 2-run double in the seventh inning last night gave Beloit insurance in a 3-run win.

Starter Cade Gibson enters today's start having posted a quality start in his last two outings, including 7 innings of shutout ball vs Quad Cities in his last start. In three July starts, Gibson has recorded an ERA of 3.50 (7 ER, 18 IP).

CAN'T PUT THIS JUICE IN A BOX

With a 2-4 performance yesterday, Osiris Johnson (nicknamed OJ, or Juice) extended his hit streak to 6 games -Beloit's longest active streak. Across his last 10 games, the 2018 second round pick is hitting .419 with 6 RBIs.

NICE AND CLOSE

16 of Beloit's first 26 games in the second half have been decided by 3 or fewer. The Sky Carp have gone 10-6 in those contests. The Sky Carp's record in games decided by three or fewer is 27-23.

THE BIG (FIRST) THREE

The Sky Carp have allowed at least one run in the first three innings in 10 of their last 12 games. Of Beloit's 501 runs allowed this season, 39% (198) have come in the first three innings. When the Sky Carp keep the opponent scoreless through 3, they are 20-6 - including yesterday's win.

LEFTY ON LEFTY

Entering today's matchup with LHP Rodney Boone, many of Beloit's lefthanded batters have hit well against southpaws. Tanner Allen is hitting .308 with a .994 OPS vs lefties. Davis Bradshaw boasts a .394 average and .929 OPS. Joe Mack is hitting .280 vs lefty hurlers.

Beloit will spend their entire 12 game road trip in the state of Ohio, marking the team's only two-week road trip of the 2023 season. The Sky Carp's 460 mile trip to Eastlake from ABC Supply Stadium marks their longest road trip by distance of the season.
