LAST NIGHT'S HIGHLIGHTS: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats defeated the Altoona Curve in the 2023 season opener by a final score of 8-2 on Thursday night. The win improved the Fisher Cats to 12-7 all-time on Opening Day and 8-3 in road openers. Luis De Los Santos drove in a game-high four runs, tying his career-high, including a bases-clearing double in the 2nd and an RBI double in the 6th. The last time De Los Santos drove in four was at Portland on July 1, 2022. Sem Robberse struck out eight (one shy of his career-high) over 4.2 innings, allowing only one run in a no-decision.

WELCOME BACK PAX: Friday night starter RHP Paxton Schultz is one of 14 returning pitchers for the Fisher Cats. Schultz had a 4.04 ERA in 25 appearances (20 starts) last year with New Hampshire and threw 104.2 innings and struck out 99. It is the second straight season where Schultz has thrown 100 or more innings. In his final 13 games with the Fisher Cats last year, his ERA was 2.70, compared to his first 12 games where his ERA was 5.84.

ALTOONA/NEW HAMPSHIRE CONNECTIONS: Altoona Manager Callix (KAY-lix) Crabbe was a member of the 2011 Fisher Cats championship team. In fact, he fielded the grounder that clinched the title at Richmond. It turned out that was his final year as a player. Crabbe played 21 games for the San Diego Padres in 2008, and the Blue Jays signed him to a Minor League deal. With the Fisher Cats, he appeared in 150 games (2010-11). Also, Altoona Hitting Coach Jon Nunnally was New Hampshire's hitting coach in 2012 and 2014.

OPENING DAY ROSTER AT A GLANCE: The Fisher Cats Opening Day roster features five of the Top 30 Blue Jays prospects, according to MLB.com: IF Orelvis Martinez (No. 4), RHP Sem Robberse (No. 7), IF Leo Jimenez (No. 19), RHP Adrian Hernandez (No. 23), and IF Damiano Palmegiani (No. 29). The roster is made up of 16 pitchers, four catchers, seven infielders and five outfielders. Players come from 14 different states, one US territory (Puerto Rico), and five countries outside the US (Dominican Republic, Venezuela, Mexico, Panama, Netherlands).

CESAR MARTIN LEADS FIELD STAFF: Manager Cesar Martin (SAY-zar MAR-teen) is leading the Fisher Cats for a third straight season. Pitching coach Drew Hayes and hitting coach Mitch Huckabay are in their first season in New Hampshire, while position coach Chris Schaeffer returns for his third season in Manchester. The Fisher Cats hit a team-record 166 home runs in 2022.

MUST-SEE MARTINEZ: IF Orelvis Martinez is ranked the No. 4 prospect in the Blue Jays system to start the 2023 season. The 21-year-old Dominican Republic native hit a team-high 30 home runs last season, breaking the Fisher Cats single-season record of 27 home runs previously set by Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010). Martinez was second in the Eastern League in home runs and had four multi-homer games.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (APRIL 7, 2006): The Fisher Cats made it two in-a-row to open the season with a 7-3 win at New Britain, the Twins Double-A affiliate. Chip Cannon homered, part of a 12-hit attack. New Hampshire starter Davis Romero allowed two earned runs in five innings to secure the win.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Toronto Blue Jays completed a series win in Kansas City yesterday, winning three of four at the Royals. Cavan Biggio homered and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. hit his second home run in as many games en route to a 6-3 win. The Blue Jays begin a three-game road series against the Angels tonight...The Buffalo Bisons have yet to begin their opening homestand this week due to inclement weather. They host a doubleheader tonight against Worcester...Vancouver kicks off its season tonight as it hosts Spokane...Dunedin defeated Fort Myers last night 4-2 in five innings due to rain on its Opening Night.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats kick off the home schedule with a six-game series against the Future Red Sox (Portland Sea Dogs) at Delta Dental Stadium. The home opener is Tuesday, April 11 at 6:35 pm. Opening week
