**FRED NATS OFFENSE COMES ALIVE:** The Delmarva Shorebirds were defeated for this first time this week as the Fredericksburg Nationals got back into the series with a 12-6 win over the Shorebirds. After taking an early 1-0 lead in the second inning on an RBI single by **Luis Gonzalez**, the Fred Nats snatched the lead in the bottom of the frame. That would be the start of a strong scoring run for the rest of the night as they manufactured at least one run in each inning for the rest of the game. Down 9-1 in the seventh, the Shorebirds made a late push by scoring five runs, but couldn't get any closer as the Nationals answered with three runs in the next two innings to grab their first win of the series.

**TODAY'S OPPONENT:** The Shorebirds send **Juan De Los Santos** to the mound in search of a bounce-back outing versus former first-round pick, **Mason Denaburg** who is making his second start of the season, allowing five runs in his first start against Fayetteville on April 12 in two innings of work.

**TWIN KILLING CATCHERS:** The Shorebirds have gotten tremendous contributions from their catching duo of **Samuel Basallo** and **Creed Willems** to start the 2023 season. The two have combined for 31 hits, 6 doubles, 7 home runs, and 26 RBIs as the two have very identical offensive numbers through the first 12 games of the season. The two catchers have combined for an OPS of 1.156 and have been the focal point of Delmarva's hot start offensively. Willems has an RBI 8 of his 10 games he's appeared in. Basallo has driven in a run in four-straight including four game with multiple RBIs.

**LIVING UP TO THE HYPE:** The first pick in 2022 Draft, **Jackson Holliday**, continues his impressive start to his first full-season in professional baseball as he has two 4-RBI games this season and is tied for second in the Carolina League in extra base with 6. Holliday has found himself on base often as he owns an on-base percentage of .537 thanks to 13 walks. He has drawn at least one walk in every game but one this season with a hit in 9 of his 11 starts. He has reached base in every game he's played in this season.

**TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE: Douglas Hodo** came through late for the Shorebirds in Wednesday's win over Fredericksburg by driving in a total of three runs in his final two hits in the seventh and eighth inning in the 7-4 win over the Fred Nats. Hodo has reached base in all eight games he's played in, drawing a walk in each of the first six as he obtains an on-base percentage of .516 currently with his 3 RBIs on Wednesday a young careerhigh for the 2022 6th round pick.

**HALT THE WALKS:** The Delmara pitching staff has been haunted by walks in the first ten games of the season as they have allowed 83 free passes after yielding a season-high 15 on Tuesday night versus Fredericksburg. Tuesday was Delmarva's fourth game this year with ten or more walks but are now 3-1 in those games.

**THE BALTIMORE KID: Maxwell Costes** has made the most of his playing time as the Baltimore native has a hit and an RBI in three of his first five starts including his first professional home run on Sunday afternoon on the first pitch he saw in the at-bat. Costes is 2nd all time at the University of Maryland in home runs as he hit 40 across his four-year career there.

**PAYBACK TIME:** Delmarva looks to reverse their fate from 2022 against the Fred Nats as their North Division rival had the upper hand in 2022 by going 7-17 versus the Nationals. Virginia Credit Union Stadium was especially not kind to the Shorebirds as they went 1-11 in games at Fredericksburg including losses in their first 9 contests there.

**TODAY'S STARTER:** Juan De Los Santos returns to the mound for his third start of 2023 looking for a bounce-back outing after being roughed by Kannapolis last time out.

**LAST OUTING (4/15 vs KAN):** De Los Santos went through one of the roughest outings of his young career against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers on Saturday as he allowed 9 runs on 10 hits in a difficult 14-4 defeat. De Los Santos allowed 4 runs in each of the second and third inning. He only walked one batter during his start.

**vs. FREDERICKSBURG:** Tonight will be the fifth career start against the Fred Nats. In his four starts, De Los Santos never threw more than four innings any of his outings but finished with strong numbers with an ERA of 2.92 with 16 strikeouts in 12.1 innings with 6 walks and 4 earned runs. The Fred Nats won all four games De Los Santos started.

**2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS**: 2022 was overall a nice season for De Los Santos as he established himself as one of the more consistent arms in the Delmarva rotation early in the season. The right-hander had a strong first two months of the season before a tough June where he had an ERA of 8.44 in five appearances. The length of his starts began to go down in July as he easily eclipsed his prior career high in innings thrown as he finished season with 79.2.

# FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

Returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). 
