The Nuts won the opener on Tuesday, handing the Whitecaps their first loss of the year, but West Michigan responded with wins in three straight games before the Nuts halted the skid yesterday, wearing Page Fence Giants on Jackie Robinson Day.

**Starting Matchup:** 2022 fifth-rounder **Jack Perkins**, who debuted with five hitless innings last Sunday at Great Lakes, makes his first home start. West Michigan counters with Aussie southpaw **Jack O'Loughlin**, who started the first game of the series and allowed two runs in four innings en route to defeat.

**Last Night:** Nuts 6, Whitecaps 4. The Lugnuts received the first home runs of the season from **Daniel Susac** and **Max Muncy** and held off West Michigan, securing the win on a **Caeden Trenkle** diving catch in right field to end the game.

### LUG•NOTES

**First-Round Pedigrees:** The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

**Three's a Charm:** RF **Jonny Butler** tied a single game franchise record yesterday with two triples, which also tied him for first in triples in the Midwest League. The Major League record for triples in a game is three, last achieved by **Yasiel Puig** in 2014.

**Streaking:** **Jack Winkler** and **Caeden Trenkle** have each reached base in all seven Lugnuts games they have played this year. After going 0-for-4 in the opener, Winkler has hit safely in the last six games, while Trenkle is 7-for-14 with four walks during this series and ranks fourth in the league with a .375 batting average and fourth with a .500 on-base percentage.

**Going Deep:** After not homering in their first six games of the year, the Nuts have hit three roundtrippers in the last two games. **Jonny Butler** flipped the power switch with a two-run homer on Friday before **Daniel Susac** and **Max Muncy** each connected yesterday. The Nuts' total of three homers is second lowest in the league, ahead of only Peoria (1 homer).

**Doubling Their Pleasure:** West Michigan (19) and Lansing (17) are the top two teams in the league in doubles, with the Lugnuts adding two more two-baggers yesterday. **Jack Winkler** is tied for second in the league with four doubles.

**Transaction:** On Friday, the Nuts added pitchers **Grant Holman** and **John Beller** to the active roster. Holman, the 2022 Opening Day starter, was reinstated from the Injured List and tossed a perfect first inning last night. Beller, a member of the Peoria Chiefs last season, was signed as a Minor League free agent and promoted to Lansing from the Arizona Complex League; he joined the bullpen and has yet to see action.

**They Know Their Trade:** Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

**Welcome to the Show:** 2022 Lugnuts lefty **Hogan Harris** debuted in relief for the Oakland Athletics Friday night, becoming the 175th Nuts alumnus to reach the Major Leagues and the second this year. Harris was optioned back to Triple-A Las Vegas yesterday.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2009:** 12,992 fans watch Michigan State pick up its first CTSD win, routing the Lugnuts 12-2 in the 3rd Annual Crosstown Showdown presented by Auto-Owners Insurance. The Nuts commit four errors in the loss, two by left fielder Kenny Wilson. The game lasts nine innings.

**2015:** Rowdy Tellez's 16th-inning two-run home run of Great Lakes first-baseman-turned-emergency-pitcher Josmar Cordero gave the Lugnuts 4-2 win at Dow Diamond. The game lasted four hours and 51 minutes and ended one inning shy of tying the franchise record for most innings played.

**In a Nutshell:** Jack Perkins makes his second Lugnuts start today, following up five hitless innings last Sunday at Great Lakes... one of four 2022 draftees on the roster; the others are 1st-rounder Daniel Susac, 4th-rounder Jacob Watters and 9th-rounder Caeden Trenkle... scouted and signed by Rich Sparks, who also was responsible for scouting/signing Blake Beers and such other notables as Max Schuemann, Jeff Criswell, Jack Weisenburger and prospect OF Clark Elliott... unrelated to former Phillies MiLB pitcher of the same name who split 2022 between Lehigh Valley and Reading before being released... agent is Sam Samardzija, Jeff "Shark" Samardzija's brother.

**Glory Days:** Starred at Kokomo High School, batting .525 as a senior while being ranked Perfect Game's No. 2 prospect in the state of Indiana and No. 1 right-handed pitcher and No. 61 overall in the nation.... all-state running back for Kokomo Wildkats football, earning three letters... taken in the 39th round by the Cubs, but elected to attend college instead.

**Study Skills:** Posted a 4.42 GPA in high school, graduating fifth in his class... graduated in three years from the University of Louisville, earning double major in finance and marketing, before pursuing business management in grad school at Indiana.

**Life in Louisville:** Pitched in 2019 and 2021 for the Cardinals... overall as a freshman, posted 4.18 ERA in 16 appearances, four starts, spanning 32 1/3 innings, with 18 walks and 37 strikeouts... missed 2020 due to undergoing Tommy John; suffered UCL tear while pitching against Clemson in the 2019 ACC Tournament... returned in 2021 and struggled, with 7.31 ERA in 11 games (1 start) over 16 innings, walking 22 and whiffing only 15.

**Off to Bloomington:** Transferred to Indiana in order to work with pitching coach Justin Parker, but Parker left for South Carolina the week after Perkins transferred in... ended up instead working with Dustin Glant, who had been the pitching coach at NYY Triple-A affiliate Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, whom he credits for his development... opened as the no. 2 starter for the Hoosiers in 2022, but moved into the Friday night role for Big Ten play, going 3-4 with a 5.10 ERA in 16 games, team-leading 15 starts... in a team-leading 83 innings, gave up only six homers and struck out 91 while walking 47, hitting 21 batters and tossing 12 wild pitches... 91 strikeouts ranks 10th highest all-time in school history... recorded six quality starts.

**Draft Day:** Selected with the 154th pick of the 2022 draft, Oakland's fifth-round selection and second pitcher taken (after fourth-rounder Jacob Watters)... signed for \$270,750... highest of three Indiana Hoosiers selected in the draft (12th-rounder Bradley Brehmer and 20th-rounder Reese Sharp, both to the Orioles)... the last impactful Indiana Hoosier to reach the Majors was Kyle Schwarber, taken fourth overall in 2014.

**Pro Debut:** Made Minor League Baseball debut on August 6, 2022, in the Arizona Complex League, striking out three while allowing two hits and one run in one inning at the Cubs... worked with catcher Daniel Susac; fellow Lugnut Caeden Trenkle was in right field and leading off in the game... six days later, made Stockton debut with two scoreless innings at San Jose, the first of three straight two-inning scoreless appearances for the Ports in which Perkins allowed only one hit, walked none, and struck out seven in total... whiffed four Giants in two innings on September 2 in fourth Stockton appearance before allowing two runs on two hits and two walks in one inning on September 8 at Modesto, his final appearance of the year... runners attempted two steals and were caught once... lefties hit .182 (2-for-11, 0 BB, 4 K) and righties hit .150 (3-for-20, 2 BB, 7 K).
