NEW YORK YANKEES DOUBLE-A AFFILIATE 2025 SCHEDULE

NEW YORK, NEW YORK: Entering play Tuesday, there are a combined 20 of the Yankees and Mets' Top 30 prospects in this series. Somerset features eight of the Yankees Top 30 Prospects, headlined by NYY No. 1 prospect 2B/SS George Lombard Jr. (MLB No. 29). Binghamton rosters 12 of the Mets Top 30 Prospects, led off by NYM No. 1 propsect SS/OF Jett Williams (MLB No. 38). Somerset and Binghamton roster the most Top 30 prospects of any affiliate within thier organizations. RODRIGUEZ-CRUISIN: Yankees No. 6 prospect Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz is slated to make his fourth start with Somerset on Tuesday. The 21-year-old from Puerto Rico has recorded 15 K to 4 BB in 19.0 IP in Double-A this season. Rodriguez-Cruz leads all active Yankee minor leaguers in IP (102.2), ERA (2.28) and AVG (.181). He also ranks second in K (114) and WHIP (1.05).

TOO CLOSE TO CALL: In Somerset's 15 games since the All-Star break, 13 have been decided by three runs or less, while seven games have been decided by one run. In the second half of the season, the Patriots are 12-8 in their 20 games that have been decided by three

SELLIN OUT: On Monday, RHP Trent Sellers was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for the week of 7/28-8/3. Sellers earned the win over Richmond on Saturday after he allowed 0 R on 1 H and 7 K in 5.0 IP. Sellers punched out seven for the sixth time this season. Sellers became the fourth Patriot to receive an MiLB weekly award this season, joining RHP Brendan Beck (4/14-4/20), OF Spencer Jones (6/16-6/22) and OF Brendan Jones (7/7-7/13).

EVERYTHING IS JASS-OME: Despite having an eight-game hit streak and 14-game on-base streak snapped in game one of Friday's doubleheader, since 7/11, Jasso is 25-for-71 (.352/.361/.465) with 9 RBI, 8 R, 5 XBH and 1 BB. In the six game series vs. RIC, Jasso paced the team with 10 hits, going 10-for-23 (.435/.458/.652) with 4 R, 4 RBI, 3 XBH (2 2B, 1 HR), 1 BB and a 1.110 OPS. Following the trade deadline, Jasso entered the Yankees' top-30 prospects (No. 24).

SECOND HALF PATS: During the second half of the season, the Patriots have three wins when trailing entering the ninth inning. Entering July 4, the Patriots were 0-35 this season when trailing entering the ninth inning. Since that day, the Patriots are 3-3 over their last six such games.

JONES IS JAMMING: In Friday's second doubleheader game. Jones went 1-for-1 with 4 RBI, 2 R and 4 BB. The four walks tied a Patriots single-game franchise record for the fourth time (last: Spencer Jones on 7/24/24 vs. POR). In the series vs. RIC, Jones went 7-for-17 (.412/.565/.765) with 6 R, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 6 BB and led the team with a 1.330 OPS. Over his last 20 games, dating back to 7/8 vs. NH, Jones is 20-for-66 (.303/.439/.667) with 18 R, 10 XBH (2 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR), 19 RBI, 16 BB, 6 SB and a 1.106 OPS. Jones ranks second among Yankees minor leaguers in SB (33), third in BB (57), tied for third in 3B (5), tied for fourth in R (64), sixth in RBI (58) and seventh in TB (137).

2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

PETER LARSON: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

DEREK WOODLEY: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafters. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.

2025

Broke camp with High-A Hudson Valley and over 15 appearances (14 starts), he led the South Atlantic League with a 2.26 ERA and 99 K. Took a no-hitter into the seventh inning and fell one strikeout shy of tying the Hudson Valley franchise record for strikeouts on 4/25 @ Asheville: 6.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 12 K. Over his final seven starts at the level, Rodriguez-Cruz ranks among the leaders in MiLB with a. 0.76 ERA (6th), 42 K (T-3rd) and 35.2 IP (T-3rd). Began the season by going 70.0 innings without allowing a HR, the longest streak in MLB or MiLB, which came to an end on 6/24 @WIL, when he allowed a home run to Gavin Dugas. In Baseball America's mid-season re-rank of the Yankees' top-30 prospects, he was one of the biggest risers, moving from #16 to #4 in the organization.

2024

Began the 2024 season in Single-A Salem again, pitching in 14 games (13 starts), posting a 3-4 record and 2.51 ERA with 73 K and 25 BB in 61.0 IP. He was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for June with Salem after allowing 2R/0ER in 20.0 IP over four starts (4BB, 19K). Following the season, he was named a Low Class-A All-Star with Salem by Baseball America. On 7/23, he was transferred to High-A Greenville, where he ended the season with seven regular season starts, pitching to a 2-1 record and 3.77 ERA with 29 K and 18 BB in 28.2 IP. Between both levels he made 21 appearances (20 starts) and went 5-5 with a 2.91 ERA in 89.2 IP with 102 K and 43 BB. Across 89.2 combined innings in Single-A and High-A last year, Rodriguez-Cruz allowed only five home runs. However, four of those home runs came in his final three starts (14.0 innings) of the season. He allowed only one homer from 4/6-8/13 (@LYN on 5/31) all season outside of that spike at the end across 75.2 IP. Entering 2024, his fastball sat in the low 90s and touched 95, while in 2024 he jumped to sitting 94-97 and touched 99 with his fastball.

2023

2022

Returned to Single-A Salem for the entire 2023 season, making 14 starts and posting a 6-3 record and 2.60 ERA with 51 K and 27 BB in 55.1 IP. Rodriguez-Cruz spent time on the Red Sox's 7-day IL with right elbow inflammation from 7/22-9/1.

Made his professional debut with the FCL Red Sox, making 11 appearances (eight starts) and pitching to an 0-3 record and 1.95 ERA with 36 K and 12 BB in 32.1 IP. On 8/30, he was transferred to Single-A Salem and ended the season with two starts over which he combined to allow one earned run in six innings pitched.

Personal Notes

Full name is Elmer Javier Rodriguez-Cruz. Originally drafted by the Boston Red Sox in the fourth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Leadership Christian Academy (PR). Had committed to play college baseball at the University of Oregon before being drafted.

Career Notes

Acquired by the Yankees on 12/11/24 alongside international slot bonus money in a trade with the Boston Red Sox in exchange for C Carlos Narvaez. The transaction marked the second consecutive off-season in which the Yankees and Red Sox pulled off a trade, with the Sox sending Alex Verdugo to the Yankees for Greg Weissert, Richard Fitts and Nicholas Judice on 12/5/23 the prior year. Originally drafted by the Red Sox in the 4th round of 2021 MLB Draft, Rodriguez-Cruz was the 3rd-youngest pitcher selected in the draft at 17 years and 11 months old.
