

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped Wednesday's matinee at Hudson Valley, 6-4...Renegades scored 3 unearned runs in the 8th to take the lead for good...**1B Rafael Flores** tallied a go-ahead 2-run double and **SS Alexander Vargas** added a run-scoring single...Brooklyn grabbed the lead in the top of the inning on a **3B William Lugo** sacrifice fly...**RF Stanley Consuegra** powered a pair of solo home runs for the 'Clones in the 4th and 6th...Lugo drove in two with a pair of sacrifice flies...**CF Alex Ramirez** and **DH Kevin Parada** added multi-hit games...Flores had a pair of hits, including a 2-run home run in the 1st for the 'Gades...**CF Spencer Jones** tallied a game-tying solo blast in the 6th.

SUPER STAFF: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Thursday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 2.72 ERA (142 ER in 470.0 IP) over their last 54 games, holding a 31-23 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (3.07) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 6 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.3% and a walk rate of 11.2%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching has permitted 3 fewer home runs (18) than any other squad and holds the lowest opposing OPS (.596), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.64) in that time period...RHPs **Tyler Stuart** (1.62) and **Blade Tidwell** (1.73) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 50.0 IP).

RED HOT RELIEF: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Thursday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.12) in the entire South Atlantic League and throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.13) is 2nd in MiLB, while Hudson Valley (3.45) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones are also 3rd in MiLB in hits-per-9 innings (6.86) and 5th in opposing OPS (.644).

PARADA POWER: C **Kevin Parada** registered his 2nd multi-home run game of the season on Saturday, tallying solo shots in the 1st and 5th innings...The Pasadena, Calif. native also accrued multiple blasts on June 23 vs. Hudson Valley...Kevin poked a solo home run in the 3rd and a 2-run inside-the-parker in the 6th...Since 2005, Parada is 1 of 2 Cyclones to record a pair multi-homer games in the same season...**INF Nick Evans** powered a pair of jacks on July 22, 2005, vs. Jamestown and again on August 24, 2005, at Williamsport...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .325/.391/.592 with a .983 OPS and 163 wRC+ in 31 games...Parada has accrued 18 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 triples, 7 home runs, 20 RBI, 10 walks, and 3 hit-by-pitches...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Thursday ranked 5th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (33), total bases (138), hits (81), and doubles (19)...Since June 6, Parada is tied for 1st in triples (3), 2nd in total bases (71), tied for 3rd in hits (39), 5th in slugging (.592), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (15) and home runs (7), 6th in OPS (.983), and tied for 8th in batting average (.325).

CUTTING 'EM DOWN: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is amid his best stretch of baseball in 2023...Tidwell has earned the win in 4 of his last 5 outings with Brooklyn winning all 5 games...He has permitted just 6 runs on 21 hits over 31.2 innings...He has walked only 7 (5.8 BB%) and struck out 43 (35.8 K%) in those contests...Tidwell punched out a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 in consecutive starts on July 6 at Wilmington and June 30 vs. Jersey Shore...This comes after tied a then-career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 10 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 6-0 with a 1.73 ERA (10 ER in 52.0 IP) with just 31 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 27 and struck out 76 (36.2 K%)...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .169 batting average (31-182) against him...Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League and Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (76) by 2 over Hudson Valley's RHP **Drew Thorpe** (74)...He also leads in batting average against (.170) and is 3rd in ERA (1.73) since that date (min. 50.0 IP)...On the season in the SAL, the Loretto, Tenn. native leads in batting average against (.196), is tied for 3rd in wins (6), and 4th in strikeouts (103) and ERA (3.45).

O SAY, CONSUEGRA: OF **Stanley Consuegra** collected his first career multi-home run game for Brooklyn on Wednesday afternoon...The 22-year-old ripped a solo home run in the 4th and 6th innings, the latter of which traveled and estimated 464 feet...Consuegra is the 3rd different Cyclone to tally a multi-home run game in 2023, joining C **Drake Osborn** (6/17) and C **Kevin Parada** (6/23 & 7/15)...The last time Brooklyn had that many separate players register multi-homer games in a season was in 2021...9 different Cyclones accomplished the feat that season: **Cody Bohanek** (9/15/21), **Nic Gaddis** (9/8/21), **Jaylen Palmer** (8/31/21), **Francisco Alvarez** (7/31/21), **Edgardo Fermin** (7/27/21), **Ronny Mauricio** (7/27/21), **Antoine Duplantis** (7/11/21), **Luke Ritter** (6/20/21), and **Brett Baty** (6/3/21)...The Dominican native has picked up at least one hit in 12-of-15 games since being reinstated...In that time, Consuegra ranks 2nd in the circuit in home runs-per-plate appearance (.063), tied for 2nd in home runs (4), 7th in isolated power (.259), and tied for 7th in extra-base hits (7).

ACE GERVASE: RHP **Paul Gervase** has been as dominant as any relief pitcher in Minor League Baseball in 2023...Through 23 relief appearances, the 23-year-old is 1st and 2nd in ERA (1.23) among SAL and MiLB relievers, respectively (min. 35.0 IP)...The 2022 12th-round pick is 2nd in MiLB in opposing batting average (.130), 6th in strikeouts-per-9 innings (13.99), and 7th in opposing OPS (.492)...Since June 6, Gervase holds a 0.60 ERA (1 ER in 15.0 IP) with a hold and 3 saves over 10 relief outings...In MiLB, the former Louisiana State arm is 3rd in strikeouts-per-9 innings (16.20) among MiLB relievers (min 15.0 IP), tied for 4th in hits allowed (5), 5th in opposing batting average (.100), 6th in ERA (0.60), and 8th in opposing OPS (.382)...He holds a strikeout rate of 44.3% in that time.

LUGO LAND: INF **William Lugo** has been scalding hot with the bat over the last few weeks...Since June 22 vs. Hudson Valley, the 21-year-old is slashing .328/.395/.625 with a 1.020 OPS and a 165 wRC+...In 18 games, Lugo is hitting .328 (21-64) with 9 runs scored, 5 doubles, a triple, 4 home runs, 17 RBI, and 8 walks (10.5 BB%) to only 10 strikeouts (13.2 K%)...In that time, the right-handed swinger has raised his batting average by 42 points (.181 to .223)...Among SAL players, Lugo is tied for 4th in RBI (17), tied for 6th in extra-base hits (10), 7th in slugging percentage (.625) and OPS (1.020), and tied for 7th in total bases (40) since that date.

BANANA'S FOR FOSTER: RHP **Cameron Foster** has found his groove on the bump over the last few weeks...Since the start of June, the 24-year-old holds a 2-0 record with a 2.51 ERA (8 ER in 28.2 IP) with 10 walks and 31 strikeouts over 6 starts...Foster's strikeout rate is up 3.6% from his overall numbers (26.5% from 22.9%) and his walk rate is down 1.5% (8.5% from 10.0%)...Since his start on June 6, the right-hander is 8th in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.51) (31/21 IP).

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns to the road to open a 6-game road trip against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades posses 3 of New York's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: OF **Spencer Jones** (7), RHP **Drew Thorpe** (8), and C **Antonio Gómez** (29)...Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Maimonides Park for the first time in 2023...Brooklyn captured the first series at Heritage Financial Park from May 16-21 and the first meeting on Coney Island from June 20-25...The Cyclones went 4-2 in both sets, taking 4-straight games to close out the most recent series...The Cyclones are 134-139 (.491) all-time against the Renegades dating back to their inaugural season in 2001.

OMAR KEEPS SWIPING: OF **Omar De Los Santos** stole a pair of bags on July 9 at Wilmington and has 32 stolen bases in 2023...The 32 swipes match INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also tied for 2nd in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 102 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (108), Mariners farmhand OF **Jonathan Clase** (108), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (108), and Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (105) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 60 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 42.

AL-WAYS ON: OF **Alex Ramirez** is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (28) and 4th in walks (24) and pitches-per-plate appearance (3.944) since the beginning of June (min. 160 PA)...Ramirez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Thursday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (71) and is 20 behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark...He is also tied for 2nd in doubles (30) with INF **Walter Rasquin**, 3rd in hits (129), and 5th in total bases (191) and runs scored (68).

JUNIOR MINT: INF **Junior Tilién** clubbed a go-ahead 3-run home run with 2 out in the 9th on July 7 at Wilmington as part of a multi-hit night...The 20-year-old has picked up a knock in 11 of his last 13 games entering Thursday...Tilién is 15-for-his-last-49 (.306) with 7 runs scored, 3 doubles, 3 home runs, 8 RBI, and 4 walks...During the streak, Tilién is slashing .306/.358/.571 with a .930 OPS and 148 wRC+.

BENI, VIDI, VICI: RHP **Benito García** has been as reliable as any Cyclones reliever over the last month...Dating back to June 9 vs. Greenville, the 23-year-old has tallied 6-consecutive scoreless relief appearances...In 71 innings, García has earned a save and permitted just 6 hits and 1 walk, while striking out 7...The right-hander holds a 25.9% strikeout rate (7/27) and 3.7% walk rate (1/27) during that span...In 10 relief outings with Brooklyn in 2023, García holds a 1.26 ERA (2 ER in 14.1 IP).

THE .500 CLUB: With Brooklyn's victory on Tuesday night, the Cyclones returned to .500 on the season at 42-42...It was the second time since Saturday the 'Clones were at the .500 mark since they were 2-2 following a 5-3 defeat at Winston-Salem on April 11...Brooklyn has not been over .500 since the 3rd game of the season...The Cyclones moved to 2-1 with a 4-2 win vs. Jersey Shore to close out the season-opening homestand on April 9.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Brooklyn's season-high 5-game winning streak came to a close on July 8 at Wilmington...Alas, the team has won 8-of-11 and 14-of-20 going into Thursday's contest...The Cyclones are 13-5 in the second half and lead the North Division of the SAL by half a game over Aberdeen (13-6)...Brooklyn is 1.5 games behind Hickory (15-4) for the best record in the circuit during the half...The 5-game streak was the longest for the 'Clones since they won 6-straight from September 3-9, 2022, vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem.

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn earned their 16th come-from-behind victory of the 2023 season with a 7-4 win at Hudson Valley on Tuesday night...The Cyclones accrued 4 comeback wins during the pre-All-Star-break series at Wilmington...July 7's win was Brooklyn's first in 2023 when trailing after 8 innings...It marked the 'Clones first victory when trailing after 8 frames since August 14, 2022, at Wilmington...Brooklyn erased a 5-4 deficit entering the 9th that night on a 2-run pinch-hit home run by C **Matt O'Neill**...The Cyclones came from 4 runs down to earn the victory on Tuesday, matching their largest deficit erased on the campaign...The 'Clones erased a 4-0 margin entering the 5th and a 4-1 deficit going into the 7th...Brooklyn also erased a 4-run ledger on Opening Day — April 7 — vs. Jersey Shore...The Cyclones trailed 4-0 after the 1st inning that day, ultimately topping the BlueClaws, 9-8, in 11 innings.

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: Brooklyn collected their 7th shutout win of the season with a 3-0 blanking of Greensboro on Saturday...7 different pitchers combined on the shutout...RHPs **Jordany Ventura** (2.0 IP), **Robert Colina** (2.0), **Luis Montas** (1.0), **Joshua Cornielly** (1.0), **Manny Rodríguez** (1.0), **Wilkin Ramos** (1.0), and **Dylan Hall** (1.0)...It was the Cyclones' first shutout since a 2-0 victory vs. Hudson Valley on June 24...Brooklyn has matched their shutout total from 2022 (7)...The last time Brooklyn accrued more than 7 shutouts in a season was when they tallied 10 in 76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014.


AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on June 14...7 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C **Kevin Parada** (No. 2), OF **Alex Ramirez** (5), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (15), RHP **Christian Scott** (16), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (18), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (22)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 1), RHP **Mike Vasil** (4), OF **Matt Rudick** (13), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (14), RHP **Junior Santos** (19), RHP **José Butto** (23), RHP **Luis Montas** (24), OF **Rowdy Jordan** (25), and RHP **Matt Allan** (30)...In all, 16-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

2022: Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft...Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts...Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League playoffs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

VOLUNTEER SERVICE: Tidwell joined the New York system after an incredible career at Tennessee...As a draft-eligible sophomore in 2022, The Volunteer State native accrued a 3-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER in 39.0 IP) and 51 punch outs in 13 appearances (9 starts)...Missed the first two months of the season with shoulder soreness...Named to the 2022 Knoxville Regional All-Tournament team...As a freshman in 2021, Tidwell was recognized on the SEC All-Freshman Team and named a Freshman All-American by D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game.

LORETTO LIGHTNING: Tidwell is no stranger to being around talent...At Loretto (Tenn.) High School, the former second-round selection was teammates with 2018 first-round pick (No. 7 overall) and current San Diego Padres LHP **Ryan Weathers**...Ryan's father, **David**, who pitched for the Mets (2002-04) is also a Loretto High School alum.

» RHP **Paul Gervase** holds the South Atlantic League's best relief ERA (1.23) among pitchers with 35.0+ innings pitched.
