DESPITE RAJCIC'S START, CARDINALS DROP 5TH STRAIGHT: Max

Rajcic allowed just one run on 4 hits over 6.1 innings in his second straight quality start but the Cardinals could not get anything going at the plate as Springfield dropped it's 5th straight with a 4-0 loss to NW Arkansas on Friday night at Hammons Field. Bryan Torres went 2-for-3 to extend his hitting streak to 6 games, but the Cards managed just 4 hits as a team and left 8 runners on base. With the loss and an Arkansas Travelers win the Cards are a half-game back of first place in the North Division with 8 to play.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Luinder Avila** makes his 12th start of the season for the Naturals... Last pitched on Sunday, June 9 against Wichita and fired 5.1 scoreless innings with 6 K while allowing just 2 H...Over his last 5 starts has allowed just 5 ER (1.67 ERA) and has allowed just 14 H in 27.0 IP during that time (.152 BAA)...Lowered his ERA during that time from 7.40 to 4.15...Pitched against the Cardinals on May 11 in Springdale and allowed 4 R on 6 H over 4.0 IP...Mike Antico hit a HR off Avila to start the ballgame...NW Arkansas won the game 6-5 in 11 innings...Spent all of last season at High-A Quad Cities in the Midwest League and went 4-7 with a 4.39 ERA in 22 appearances (20 starts)...Made 26 starts in 2022 with Low-A Columbia in the Carolina League and went 6-10 with a 4.54 ERA...Made his full-season debut in 2021 with Columbia and made 6 starts...Signed by the Royals as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela in 2018...22 years old

CARDS HOST NATURALS TO START FIRST-HALF STRETCH RUN: Holding a half-game lead in the North Division with 12 to play to start the week, the Cardinals host the NW Arkansas Naturals (AA, Kansas City Royals) for the first of two series between the two clubs at Hammons Field. The Cards dropped 4 of 6 at Arvest Ballpark in Springdale at the beginning on May.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

> For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

FIRST HALF PENNANT RACE: With just 8 games to play, the Cardinals are in a tight race for the 1st half title with the Arkansas Travelers and Tulsa Drillers. Arkansas leads the division by just a half game over the Cards while the Drillers are 2.5 games back. While the Travelers and Drillers have two more head-to-head meetings this week, the Cards will not play either team again until the 2nd half. The Cards' last 1st half title came in 2016 when they went 41-29 and won the division by 3.5 games over Tulsa. Springfield won the 2nd half title last season and lost in the Division Series to the Travelers.

IN A FUNK AT HAMMONS: After winning their first 8 games of the season at home, the Cardinals have struggled of late at Hammons Field. The Cards have dropped 16 of their last 21 games at Hammons Field, a stretch that includes a franchise record-tying 8-game skid at home. The Cardinals are now 13-16 with a 5.90 team ERA at Hammons Field. After playing 4 of their last 6 series away from Hammons Field, the Cardinals go into the All-Star Break with 21 of 30 at home.

LET'S FLIP THE SCRIPT: While the Cardinals have had success against most of the North Division so far this season, Springfield has struggled against the Northwest Arkansas Naturals. The Naturals lead the season series 8-2 and have outscored the Cards 62-32 in 10 games this season. The Cardinals are batting .229 as a team against the Naturals and have been out-homered 13-3 in the season series. The Naturals have a team ERA over a full run better than Springfield's on the series (3.17 to 4.46). Against the rest of the North Division the Cardinals are 26-13.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 429 whiffs in 61 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (410 K in 61 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.03 K's per game.

POWER OUTAGE: While the Cardinals have been piling up base hits, not many recently have gone over the wall. The Cardinals have hit just 2 HR over their last 17 games: Mike Antico's 2-run shot off Mason Barnett in the 6th inning on Thursday at Hammons Field and Jacob Buchberger's 3-run blast in the 5th on Saturday night in North Little Rock, which snapped a homerless streak for the Cards of 11 straight games. Springfield has hit the fewest home runs this season with 32.

RELEASE THE PRESSURE: During their 5-game losing streak, the Cardinals have had a tough time generating offense. Springfield has scored 10 runs (2/game) and is batting .205 as a team during that time with a league-low .556 OPS and .255 SLG and just 6 extra base hits. The Cardinals have also scuffled with runners in scoring position, going 6-for-42 (.143) over their last 5.

BIG INNINGS, LONGBALL HAUNTING CARDS AGAIN: After not allowing a "big inning" in 11 of the 12 games on their road trip through Wichita and North Little Rock, the Naturals have used crooked numbers to win the first three games of the series at Hammons Field this week. The Natruals have 5 innings of 3+ runs this week, bringing the Cardinals' season total to 41 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 41 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 160 of the 316 total runs scored by the opposition, 50.6% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. In the other 481.1 IP Springfield has allowed 152 runs, which comes out to 2.84 runs per 9 innings. The Cardinals are 24-6 in games in which they have not allowed a "big inning".

After giving up 5 home runs on Thursday night, the Cardinals once again sit at the top of the Texas League for most home runs allowed. Their 68 HR surrendered is 3 more than the 65 allowed by Amarillo.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 213.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 31 straight games without a home run.


