NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- Of 15 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 7 and split 3 ... the Storm Chasers have a 7-9 record over their last 16 games, having split their last 2 series prior to this week, though the Chasers have lost this week's series to Indianapolis.
- Omaha went 13-12 in April ... with a 13-14 record in May and 10-15 in June, the Chasers had back-to-back losing months for the first time since June/July 2025.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Chasers have 22 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 25 losses this year.
- 22 comeback wins are tied for the 8th-most in the International League, tied 10th in Triple-A ... 25 blown leads are tied 3rd-most in the league, tied 5th in Triple-A.
- The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 13 of their last 23 losses, including 4 games where the team led for at least half the game and 2 losses where Omaha had a 6+ run lead at some point in the game.
- In the last 50 games (since May 9), Omaha is 22-28 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 15 of 22 wins and led at some point in 15 of 28 losses, meaning 30 of Omaha's last 50 games (60%) have been a comeback win for one of the teams ... in this stretch, 34 of 50 games (68%) have been decided by 3 runs or less.

SUMMER HEAT

- A pair of bats have been lighting it up over their last 10 games for Omaha.
- Brett Squires** snapped a career-high 14-game hitting streak yesterday, but over his last 10 games, is slashing .382/.450/.618 (13-for-34) with 8 RBI.
- Abraham Toro** has an .886 OPS over his last 10 games, notching 4 doubles, 2 homers and 7 RBI.

HONEST ABE

- Abraham Toro** started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May
- Since May 12, Toro has a .327 average (48-for-147) ... he ranks 3rd in the IL in OPS (1.007), 3rd in SLG (.612) and 4th in AVG ... his 37 RBI over 40 games since May 12 rank as the 7th-most in the league.
- From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 12, Toro has hits in 30 of 40 games, with 4+ hits in 3 games.

CROSS ME UP

- Gavin Cross** had one of the league's slowest start to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.
- Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) with 3 XBH and 6 RBI, with 1 multi-hit game ... but in his last 39 games (since May 16), he's hitting .284 (38-for-134), with 9 XBH and 14 RBI, with 10 multi-hit games.

JUNE BUGS

- Individually, there were many key offensive contributors in the month of June.
- Since rejoining Omaha June 18, **Brandon Drury** has reached base in all 9 games, batting .382 (13-for-34) with 4 doubles, 3 homers and 10 RBI for a 1.227 OPS.
- Abraham Toro** had hits in 18 of his 23 games in June, batting .326 (29-for-89) with 6 doubles, 3 triples, 6 homers and 24 RBI for a 1.041 OPS ... his 59 total bases last month ranked 4th-most in the International League, while tied 4th in RBI.
- Matthew Lugo** was acquired by the Royals on June 2 and in his first 21 games with Omaha, hit .325 (26-for-80) with 7 doubles, 7 homers and 21 RBI for a 1.035 OPS in June ... his 54 total bases last month ranked tied 5th-most in the IL.
- Brett Squires** hit .291 (23-for-79) in the month of June, with an .850 OPS ... he enters today's game on a career-best 16-game on-base streak since June 16, tied for Omaha's 2nd-longest of the year, a stretch where he is batting .350 (21-for-60) with 6 XBH, 11 RBI and a 9.62 OPS.

BARLOW'S BACK

- Since 2021, **Scott Barlow** is the 7th player to play for Omaha, leave the organization and return to appear in a game for the Storm Chasers.
- Barlow joins a group that includes **Zack Greinke** (2004 & 2022), **Taylor Clarke** (2022 & 2025 Omaha), **Jonathan Heasley** (2022-23 2025), **Jose Cuas** (2022-23, 2026), **Dan Altavilla** (2024, 2026) and **Rudy Martin Jr.** (2019, 2021 & 2025-26).

TODAY'S APPEARANCE

- Henry Williams is making his **8th start** this year with the Storm Chasers, his **10th Triple-A appearance** and his **17th overall appearance** this season.
- Playing his **4th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- This is Williams' 2nd career appearance against the Pirates or their affiliates after starting Tuesday's series opener against the Indians ... he allowed 5 runs over 2.0 innings in that appearance.

HENRY'S HUNCH

- FINDING HIS FOOTING:** Williams made his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers last season, but made just 2 spot starts in the 1st half of the season ... he opened 2026 in Double-A, but since being promoted to Omaha on May 12, he has pitched in 9 games ... after posting an 8.59 ERA (14 ER in 14.2 IP) with 14 strikeouts (8.59 K/9) over his first 4 outings, Williams worked a 5.59 ERA (12 ER in 19.1 IP) with 21 strikeouts (9.78 K/9) over next last 4 appearances (June 7 to 24).
- STRENGTH AND STAMINA:** Williams got off to a hot start in 2026, allowing 2 earned runs or less while going 5.0+ innings in 4 of his last 6 starts at Double-A ... following his stretch with Omaha in 2025, Williams went back to NW Arkansas (AA) and pitched 5.0+ innings in 13 of his last 18 starts at Double-A.
- HOME RUN HURTING:** Much of the damage off Williams in Triple-A this year has come on the long ball ... he has allowed 10 home runs (all solo homers) in just 9 outings for a 2.50 HR/9 that ranks 8th-highest in the International League (min. 30.0 IP) ... homers represent 30% (10 of 33) of the runs he's allowed with Omaha ... 16 home runs allowed between Double-A and Triple-A rank tied for 9th-most in the Minors.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, JUNE 30 VS. INDIANAPOLIS

- Made his shortest start of the year, his 7th start with Omaha ... allowed a 2-out RBI double in the top of the 1st inning ... issued 4 walks in the top of the 2nd inning, scoring 1 run, before allowing a 3-run double to Emmanuel Valdez ... finished the 2nd inning with a fly out and did not return for the 3rd inning ... 40 pitches thrown in the 2nd inning were the most he had thrown in a single inning in his career.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made 7 starts for Northwest Arkansas before his promotion to Omaha ... worked a 4.72 ERA (18 ER in 34.1 IP) with a 1.37 WHIP ... 3 of his 7 starts went 5.0+ innings with 1 or less runs allowed.

CAREER NOTES

2025

- Spent most of the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA), but also made 2 starts for Omaha ... among Royals Minor League pitchers, ranked 5th in innings pitched (115.1) and tied 6th in strikeouts (106).
- Opened the year with the Nationals and threw 5 quality starts over his first 8 appearances ... made his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers on May 28 vs. St. Paul (MIN) ... in 2 starts for Omaha and allowed 9 ER in 8.0 IP (10.13 ERA) before returning to Northwest Arkansas on June 6 to finish his season.
- In Northwest Arkansas, totaled 21 appearances (19 starts) and worked a 4.24 ERA (51 ER in 108.1 IP) with 100 strikeouts and a 1.37 WHIP throughout the season ... named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week for his start on July 2 @ Springfield (STL), tossing 5.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit and 7 strikeouts

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+) ... appeared in 22 games (21 starts) with a 3.68 ERA (42 ER in 102.2 IP) and 92 strikeouts at High-A ... 7 of his 21 starts were scoreless, including his last 3 of the season, for a career-high 21.0-inning scoreless streak that stretched into April 2025.
- Split 2023 between the Royals and Padres organizations ... opened the year with the Lake Elsinore Storm (A) in San Diego's system but the Padres traded him to Kansas City at the trade deadline ... after the trade, made 5 starts for Columbia (A) and posted a 3.38 ERA (9 ER in 24.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts for the Fireflies.
- Made his professional debut at the start of the 2023 season with Lake Elsinore after San Diego drafted him in the 3rd round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Duke University ... made 12 starts for the Storm before his trade to the Royals, working a 5.74 ERA (27 ER in 42.1 IP) with 40 strikeouts for Lake Elsinore ... missed the 2022 season as he recovered from Tommy John surgery.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Attended Duke University (2019-2021), where he appeared in 9 games (7 starts) over 3 seasons with the Blue Devils (ACC), going 3-3 with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER in 37.2 IP) and 45 strikeouts ... only pitched one full season in Durham (2021) due to the COVID-19 pandemic shortening his freshman campaign (2020) and Tommy John surgery in December 2021, keeping him out of action his junior year (2022).
- Lettered in both baseball and basketball all 4 years at Darien High School (CT) ... was a team captain for the basketball team his senior season.
- Father David played collegiate baseball at Davidson College from 1987 to 1991.
