INDY BITS

ABOUT YESTERDAY: The Indianapolis Indians scored eight unanswered runs - six in the bottom of the eighth inning - to defeat the lowa Cubs and knot the series at one-game apiece on Wednesday afternoon at Victory Field, 9-4. With Iowa leading 4-1 through its half of the sixth inning, the Indians tightened the game to a one-run deficit in the bottom half and then stole the victory in dominating fashion during their last offensive frame. Domingo Leyba tied the game with a double in the eighth, scoring Jared Triolo following a leadoff walk. The bats then came alive with one out as the next four batters reached base safely on a walk, back-to-back RBI singles and a run-scoring throwing error by pitcher Anthony Kay. The I-Cubs scored all four of their runs on two-run homers by Alexander Canario in the first inning and Jake Slaughter in the sixth, both who also homered in the series opener. The dingers sandwiched a Ryan Vilade RBI single in the fourth to put Indy on the board.

LET HIM KOCH: Grant Koch led the Indians offense with three hits in Wednesday afternoon's win. Indy's backstop drove in the winning run in the bottom of the eighth inning in part of six-run outburst. Koch's three-hit day was his second of the season and of this month. The 26-year-old is 5-for-10 over his last three games and is hitting .313 (10-for-32) in 11 games this month.

THAT'S A WINNER: The Indians earned their fifth last at-bat win of the season yesterday thanks to a six-run eighth inning. Their last final at-bat win came on Aug. 16, at St. Paul, when an RBI single by Nick Gonzales broke open a game that was knotted at three-runs apiece. Yesterday was just the fourth time the Indians were victorious after trailing through seven innings in 51 games.

STRAT KEEPS DOMINATING: Hunter Stratton earned his fourth win of the season on Wednesday, he entered in relief with one out and two runners on in the eighth inning, retiring the next two batters to escape the jam before Indy's offense came alive in the bottom half of the frame. Stratton extended his scoreless streak to 9.2 innings in eight relief appearances in August. He has held opponents without a hit in seven of eight appearances in August, opponents are 1-for-30. Since July 18, he is 2-0 with a 1.17 ERA (2er/15.1ip), seven hits allowed, 21 strikeouts and 0.85 WHIP. His three saves this month is tied for the second-most in the International League.

HE'S ON, HE SCORES: Jared Triolo scored a season-high tying three times yesterday. Since being optioned by Pittsburgh on Aug. 18, he is 6-for-19 with six runs scored, a double, home run, three RBI, three walks and .409 on-base percentage. On Tuesday night, he lined a ball 101.9 MPH off the bat narrowly over the left-field wall in part of three-hit performance. Triolo was recalled by Pittsburgh on June 28 and made his major league debut that day vs. San Diego. The third baseman played in 36 games with the big league club, hitting .273 (33-for-121) with 16 runs scored, two doubles, a home run and 16 RBI.

LEYBA DRIVES: Domingo Leyba came up big with Indy's Ione extra-base hit yesterday, which plated the tying run in part of the late-inning comeback. The 28-year-old continues to be one of the driving forces of the Indians offensive attack. The switch-hitter is hitting .303 (20-for-66) with three doubles, a triple and five home runs — four of his blasts coming in August. Leyba joined the Indians from Double-A Altoona on July 25, and signed a minor league contract with Pittsburgh prior to the season on March 8, 2023.

NICOLAS SHINES IN RELIEF: Kyle Nicolas posted 2.0 perfect innings of relief with a pair of strikeouts on Tuesday night. Nicolas' transition to the bullpen has suited him well, he is 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA (3er/11.0ip) with five hits allowed, four walks, 13 strikeouts and 0.82 WHIP in six relief appearances this month. Opponents are hitting .135 (5-for-37) against him during this span.

TONIGHT: The Indians and I-Cubs continue their series at Victory Field on Thursday at 7:05 PM ET in their fourth and final series of the season. Indy's win on Wednesday afternoon knotted the series at one-game apiece with four games to play. Iowa has gotten the best of the season series so far, winners in 13 of 20 games against Indianapolis. The last time the two team's met at Victory Field was from June 16-21, a series split. Tonight, RHP Beau Sulser (2-1, 7.84) will take the hill for Indianapolis against lowa's RHP Riley Thompson (2-6, 4.95).

GO FOR BEAU: Beau Sulser will make his fourth outing with Indianapolis tonight against the lowa Cubs. Sulser will make his sixth career appearance against the I-Cubs, he is 1-1 with a 3.38 ERA (9er/24.0ip) and 19 strikeouts. After taking the loss in his season debut with Indy, he's earned wins in both of his last two outings. On Aug. 13, vs. Nashville, he tossed 5.0 shutout innings with six punchouts in a combined one-hitter with John O'Reilly, Yohan Ramirez, Hunter Stratton and Rob Zastryzny. It was the first one-hitter since James Marvel, Montana DuRapau and Dovydas Neverauskas accomplished the feat at Syracuse on July 24, 2019. Sulser has allowed just one run and four hits with seven punchouts in 8.0 innings between his last two appearances. He began the season with the KT Wiz in the Korean Baseball Organization. In nine starts for the Wiz this year, he went 1-7 with a 5.62 ERA (31er/49.2ip). He was then signed to a minor league contract by the Pirates on June 29 and reported to Double-A where he made four starts, going 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA (6er/14.0ip).

THIS DATE IN 1986: The Indians outlasted Nashville in a 15-inning, 4-hour and 18-minute marathon at Bush Stadium, 7-6. The Sounds led 5-2 midway through the eighth ininng, but the Indians plated three runs in the bottom half to eventually force extras. Both teams were held scoreless until the 15th when the visitors plated one, only to see Indy respond with two in the home half and score the game-winning run on an extra-base hit by Rene Gonzalez. George Wright went yard with a team-high three hits, and Razor Shines went deep as well.
