LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox held off the Richmond Flying Squirrels for a 9-7 victory on Friday night. Bowie built an early 5-1 edge, with three runs in the first inning that all scored on two Richmond errors. The Flying Squirrels got a run back in the third on a Will Wilson solo home run, but John Rhodes answered with a two-run shot in the fourth that made it 5-1 Bowie. Right-handed starter Carlos Tavera saw his night come to an end after just 4.2 frames, with Richmond plating three in the fifth to make it a 5-4 game. The star of the night was Jackson Holliday, as he tallied five hits on the evening, including an RBI triple that plated a run, as part of a four run-seventh for the Baysox that also saw Collin Burns drive in a pair on a single, along with Rhodes picking up his third RBI of the night on a bases loaded walk. Right-hander Tyler Burch got the win for the Baysox, allowing two runs across three innings of relief in the eighth, before another late tally in the ninth was not enough for Richmond to rally

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter tonight with a record of 54-52 on the season. Their 21-16 mark in the second half has them leading the Southwest division standings and sitting two games above Bowie. The Baysox are 10-12 against the Flying Squirrels this season, securing a series split in Richmond back in early July. Richmond's 3.81 staff ERA on the campaign is second-best in the Eastern League,. However, their starters have thrown the fewest innings of any team (386.1) in the league. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, The Flying Squirrels active roster includes four of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, including RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 10 SF), OF Vaun Brown (No. 13 SF), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15 SF), and RHP Carson Seymour (No. 23 SF).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Ryan Murphy is tonight's projected starter for Richmond, Murphy's 13 home runs, 37 walks, and seven losses surrendered across 75.2 innings are all most on the Flying Squirrels' staff. He's allowed three home runs across his past two starts, while allowing a a pair of earned runs on five hits through three innings last time out in Altoona this past Sunday. This is Murphy's fourth start this season against the Baysox, going 0-2 with a 6.30 ERA (7 ER in 10 IP) through his first three, including allowing four runs through two frames at home against Bowie back on 7/8. Murphy pitched collegiately at Division II Le Moyne (NY) alongside MLB arm Josiah Gray in 2018. He features a Low-90s fastball, along with a slider, curveball, and changeup

COMEBACK KIDS

Recently, the Baysox have made it a habit of coming from behind in games. Bowie has conceded the first run in 16 of its last 19 games. In that stretch the Baysox have gone 9-10 overall. This season, Bowie is 17-35 in total when allowing the first run. Nine of the last 12 Baysox victories have come after failing to score first.

HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Top prospect Jackson Holliday has had a stellar start at the Double-A level. Friday night marked Holliday's third five-hit game of his season - the most of any player in Minor League Baseball. Holliday is also the only player to accomplish the feat at multiple levels this season. His five-hit contest was the first such game for a Baysox player since Cedric Mullins did so on 9/7/19. This season, across three different levels, Holliday ranks top five in the Orioles' organization in batting average (3rd - .342), on-base percentage (1st - .463), slugging percentage (5th - .539), OPS (1st - 1.002), triples (1st - 6), and walks (1st - 72). Holliday's on-base percentage also leads all of Minor League Baseball. He is also the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday and the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook has continued his surge in the Eastern League throughout the summer months, as his .288 average since June 1 is fifth-highest in the league amongst players with at least 200 plate appearances. The newly-named No. 28 prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline, has also brought the pop, with his 24 extra-base hits in that span sitting at third-most in the league. Cook has also shown plenty of versatility, playing in five different positions (1B, 2B, CF, RF, LF) and manning every spot in the lineup at some point this season. He currently leads active Baysox players in home runs (17), RBI (62 - fourth-most in the Eastern League), on-base percentage (.323), slugging (.464), OPS (.787), and stolen bases (23).

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers joins Bowie from High-A Aberdeen after one of the best performances across Minor League Baseball in the month of July. The No. 9 prospect in the O's system, per MLB Pipeline, hit .397 last month - second-highest in Minor League Baseball among players with at least 60 plate appearances, while his 1.185 OPS was fourth-best and led the Orioles' minor league system. Beavers also led the Baltimore farm with his .494 on-base percentage in the month of July. He's opened his time in Double-A with hits in six of eight games, including three multi-hit contests, and a 10-for-34 (.294) start overall.

CAREER AGAINST THE YANKEES: Making his 14^{th} career appearance (eighth start) against the Yankees tonight...Did not factor into the decision in his last assignment July 3 at Yankee Stadium...Allowed two runs on five hits (2 HR) with two walks and four strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Threw 86 pitches, 56 strikes...Has pitched to an 0-4 record with a 4.95 ERA(24 ER/43.2 IP) and one save in 13 career appearances (seven starts) against the Mstarts) against the AL East foe.

WATCH ME WHIP: Wells enters play leading MLB in WHIP (0.99) and opponent on-base percentage (.257), and ranks tied for third in batting average (.198)... Has allowed 113 baserunners (80 H, 30 BB, 3 HBP) across 20 appearances (111.0 IP) this season, the fourth-fewest in MLB (min. 90.0 IP)...His 80 hits surrendered this season are the rourth-rewest in MLB (min. 90.0 IP)...HIS 80 nits surrendered this season are the tied for the sixth-fewest among pitchers who have thrown at least 90.0 innings... LOVING LEFTIES: Opposing left-handed batters are slashing .193/.232/.336 (81-for-420) against Wells through his first 87 career games (42 starts)...He has recorded more career strikeouts against lefties (124) than hits allowed...Among pitchers with at least 400 left-handed batters faced in that span, Wells ranks second in opponent on-base percentage, fourth in opponent OPS (.568), and sixth in opponent batting

RACKING UP STRIKEOUTS: Wells has recorded 110 strikeouts this season, the most by an 0's pitcher through his first 20 games of the season since Dylan Bundy tallied 123 punchouts in his first 20 outings in 2018...His 110 strikeouts are a career high, surpassing his season total from last season (76)...Wells struck out at least seven batters in five straight starts from May 13 to June 4, tied with Erik Bedard (2007) for the second-longest streak by an Orioles pitcher since the franchise moved to Baltimore in 1954, trailing only an eight-game streak by Connie Johnson in 1957.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his widily and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Hermann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bulipen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving on to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
